Remember to keep your hands relaxed and free of tension throughout the entire performance. Continue working on your right hand technique - add more flexibility and fluidity, especially during the moments when you change the strings and the bow. Overall it was a very nice performance! Keep up the good work!

2. Let us know if you need an official invitation letter from the Competition to apply for the visa. The letter may be provided to you after you complete the registration for the recital.
3. The competition does not provide a piano accompanist. If you bring your own accompanist, please, send us the name of your accompanist, so we can add him/her to our backstage security list. We can provide you with a list of local piano accompanists, if needed. However, it will be your responsibility to contact the accompanist and make all the arrangements. If your accompanist doesn't show up for the performance, you will not be allowed

onto the stage.

In addition, Pulsar Music is happy to invite all Award Ceremony participants, their teachers, and family members to join us at other social events after the ceremony date, such as a trip to Niagara Falls and the Toronto Aquarium on August 10th and 11th, 2023.
