Congratulations! We are delighted to inform you that you are awarded **Second Place** at the Red Maple Keyboard Competition, Junior Category, 11 - 12 years old, General (Less competitive) difficulty level, for Helen Hopekirk, Air No. 3 from Suite.

Here are the comments from our judges:

Your performance was very musical and demonstrated a great sense of touch and phrasing. As you continue to explore the piece, I recommend experimenting with the damper pedal. While the piece may require a lot of pedaling, try to use half pedal or clean the pedal slightly more to avoid too many mixed harmonies on one pedal. You build phrases very nicely, and now it's time to think about how to connect them all together to build bigger sections in the form. Consider how these bigger sections connect to each other to create the clear form of the entire piece. Overall, your work is very nice, and I encourage you to keep exploring and developing your musicality. Well done!
