### THE OPENING TIP

• Purdue (9-6, 2-2) looks to rebound from a loss to Illinois with another big challenge, this one coming Thursday at No. 19-ranked Michigan (10-4, 1-2). **Joe Davis** and **Bill Raftery** will handle the broadcast on FS1, beginning at 7 p.m. ET. On the radio, **Rob Blackman** and **Larry Clisby** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 6 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on PurdueSports.com.

• Purdue owns an 88-71 series lead against Michigan, including a 13-13 record under Coach Painter. Painter has obviously never faced Michigan's first-year head coach **Juwan Howard** on the sidelines, but the two did square off in the 1991-92 and 1992-93 seasons. Painter went 1-3 against Howard as a player.

• Purdue is looking to avoid back-to-back Big Ten losses for the first time since Feb. 7-15, 2018 (Ohio State, Michigan State, Wisconsin).

• **SOMETHING TO WATCH:** Purdue has had its share of struggles on the road, while Michigan has been pretty impressive at home.

• Purdue's sophomore class has started to emerge as offensive leaders. The class is averaging 40.7 points per game over the last three games, accounting for 56.2 percent of Purdue's scoring. For the season, the class is shooting 42.7 percent from the field and 37.4 percent from deep. The class is averaging 34.3 points per game for the whole season (50.2 percent of scoring).

• **Eric Hunter Jr.** and **Sasha Stefanovic** are two of the Big Ten's most improved scorers this year.

• Purdue is 5-0 this year when scoring at least 70 points and is 28-5 since the start of last year when scoring at least 70 points in a game.

• Purdue is 8-0 this year and 28-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The lone loss came to Virginia in last year's Elite Eight.

• Purdue has won nine straight games in games played on Thursday. Its last loss came vs. Wisconsin on Feb. 15, 2018.

 ... two Big Ten Players of the Year (**Jajuan Johnson**, **Caleb Swanigan**).  
 ... three Big Ten Coach of the Year (**Matt Painter** - 2010, 2011, 2019).  
 ... nine first-team All-Big Ten honorees.  
 ... seven players earning 10 All-America honors.  
 ... ten players that scored 1,000 career points.  
 ... outscored opponents 25,596 to 22,812 (73.55 to 65.55).

• Purdue has won 100 straight games and is 38-0 under Coach Painter when scoring 90 or more points.

## THE DEFENSE OF MACKEY ARENA

• Since the 2014-15 season, Purdue has been almost unbeatable at Mackey Arena, posting an 84-8 record in the facility. Purdue's eight losses have come to North Florida (73-70), Gardner-Webb (89-84), [11] Maryland (69-60), Iowa (70-63), [3] Villanova (79-76), Minnesota (91-82; OT), [14] Ohio State (64-63) and Texas (70-66).

• It has been 95 games since Purdue has lost by double-figures in Mackey Arena (94-79 to [13] Michigan State on Feb. 20, 2014).

• Since the start of last year, Purdue has held 17 of 23 opponents at Mackey Arena under 40.0 percent shooting.

• Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue has allowed just four opponents to shoot at least 50.0 percent from the field. Coincidentally, Purdue is 2-2 in those four games.

► **Record at Purdue:** 330-165 (.667) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 355-170 (.676) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
- Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
