GAME NOTES

- Sharon Versyp hit her 200th career win at Purdue and just six wins shy of tying Lin Dunn for the most coaching victories in Purdue history (206)
- Purdue is now 5-0 when leading at halftime and 4-1 when having three players in double figures
- The Boilermakers held Dayton to its lowest scoring half of the season (21 points)
- Purdue has now held all eight opponents to 60 points or fewer through regulation
- The Boilermakers grabbed 15 offensive rebounds and had 12 second chance points
- In the third quarter, Dayton was one point shy of tying Purdue opponents' season-high points in a quarter (24)
- Purdue forced 19 TOs, a season-high for Dayton, who averages 14.4 per game
- The Flyers' seven points in the second quarter were the fewest by a Purdue opponent this season (previous nine by UIC, 11/19/15)
- Purdue's attempted 66 FGs were a team-high for the season
- The Boilermakers allowed an opponent season-high in defensive rebounds (29), blocked shots (8) and steals (9)

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- April Wilson scored a team-high 15 points, including 13 in the second half and six in the midst of a 9-0 run in the fourth quarter
- Wilson added seven assists, four rebounds and a season-high three steals as well
- Ashley Morrisette scored 13 points, 11 in the first half, and the go-ahead bucket with 28 seconds to play
- Bridget Perry finished with 11 points, a career-high 14 rebounds and three steals, notching her second double-double of the season and fourth of her career
- Hayden Hamby matched a season-high with seven points
- Nora Kiesler matched a career-high with three blocks
