

THE OPENING TIP

- The No. 7-ranked Boilermakers look to move to 2-0 on the young season when in-state rival Indiana State visits Mackey Arena for an 8:30 p.m. tipoff. It marks the second straight season that the Sycamores will visit Mackey Arena, after Purdue topped ISU 80-68 a year ago.
- The Boilermakers improved to 103-21 (.831) all-time in season openers, including 16-1 under head coach Matt Painter, with an 96-67 win over Bellarmine on Tuesday night, Indiana State is 1-0 following a come-from-behind 81-77 victory at Green Bay.
- · The contest will be televised by the Big Ten Network with Jeff Levering and Rapheal Davis on the call. On the radio waves, Rob Blackman and Bobby Riddell will be courtside (Wes Scott producing) on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on PurdueStats.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

THE NOTES TO KNOW

- 1) Purdue owns a 30-4 all-time record against Indiana State, including a 26-2 margin in West Lafayette. The Boilermakers are 51-3 all-time in games played against Missouri Valley Conference teams in West Lafayette.
- 2) Friday's contest marks the 26th straight sellout, dating to Jan. 15, 2019, vs. Rutgers.
- 3) Since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue is 17-2 against in-state opponents (Notre Dame Dec. 2018; Butler Dec. 2019).
- 4) Purdue is looking for its first 2-0 start since the 2018-19 season (2019-20 loss to Texas; 2020-21 loss to Clemson).
- 5) Purdue's preseason AP ranking of No. 7 matches the highest preseason rank of the Painter era (2009-10; 7th).
- 6) Purdue's two preseason All-Americans of Trevion Williams and Jaden Ivey combined for 15 points in the season-opening win over Bellarmine. The Boilermaker still managed 96 points and a 1.43 points / possession.
- 7) Purdue's 16 3-pointers made against Bellarmine were the most in a season opener in school history.
- 8) Purdue is 51-3 at home during the month of November during the Matt Painter era, with losses coming to Bucknell (2012), Villanova (2016) and Texas (2019).
- 9) Purdue has finished in the top four of the Big Ten standings in 10 of the last 14 seasons under Coach Painter.
- 10) Matt Painter needs two wins in Big Ten play to tie Jud Heathcote for seventh on the Big Ten's all-time wins list (182).
- 11) Purdue has won 991 Big Ten games in school history, needing nine league wins to become the first school with 1,000 Big Ten victories.

SEASON OPENER NOTES

 Purdue opened its season with a 96-67 win over Bellarmine in front of 14,804 fans at Mackey Arena. It was the first series meeting hetween the two teams.

- The win was Purdue's ninth straight in a season opener by a total of 254 points (28.2 points per game). The Boilermakers are now 103-21 all-time in season openers and 16-1 under head coach Matt
- Purdue is 49-6 in home openers played at Mackey Arena.
- · Caleb Furst became the first true freshman to start a season opener since Caleb Swanigan in the 2015-16 season.

BROKEN OPENER RECORDS

- Purdue's 16 3-pointers against Bellarmine tied for the seventh most in a game in school history and the most in a season opener in school history. Purdue's 36 3-point attempts tied a school record (set two other times).
- · Purdue's 1.43 points per possession were the most in a season opener in school history and the seventh-highest number in school history.

· Sasha Stefanovic scored a career-high 23 points making 5-of-6 from distance to lead Purdue to a 96-67 win over Bellarmine in the season

- · Purdue has won by at least 25 points in 12 of Matt Painter's 16 seasononening victories.
- · In each of the previous 11 seasons that Purdue won by at least 25 points or more, the Boilermakers advanced to the NCAA Tournament.
- · Going even further back, in the last 16 occurrences dating to the 1982-83 opener that the Boilermakers won their opener by 25 or more points, Purdue reached the NCAA Tournament.

· Purdue's two-headed center monster of Zach Edey and Trevion Williams dominated in Tuesday's win over Bellarmine. The pair totaled 20 points on just six field goal attempts in 36:27 of action.

SOMETHING TO THINK ABOUT

· Purdue's two preseason All-Americans, Jaden Ivey and Trevion Williams, combined for just 15 points in Purdue's win over Bellarmine, showcasing the Boilermaker depth. Purdue still managed to score 96 points at a 1.43 points / possession clip and shoot 50.0 percent from the field with 16 3-pointers.

REGION RATS

- Sasha Stefanovic (Crown Point) and Brandon Newman (Valparaiso) are lovingly referred to as Region Rats - players that hail from the Northwest Region of the state.
- The duo combined for 37 points, six assists against zero turnovers, and went 8-of-15 from 3-point range and 11-of-13 from the free throw line.
- · It marked the fourth time that the duo has each reached double figures in the same game - Purdue is 4-0 now when that happens.

SUCCESS FROM DEEP AND THE LINE

• For just the sixth time in school history, Purdue made at least 10 3-pointers and 24 free throws in the same game when it did so against Bellarmine on Tuesday night.

SENIORS ON THE BOARD

- For the first time in 29 games, the Purdue senior class scored a point, when it tallied 33 points vs. Bellarmine.
- · Purdue had no seniors on the roster a year ago, obviously failing to score a point during the entire 2020-21 season.

RIGHT WHERE THEY LEFT OFF

- •The talented sophomore class picked up right where they left off last year, scoring 46 points to lead Purdue to a 96-67 win over Bellarmine.
- As freshmen last year, the group accounted for 44.5 percent of Purdue's scoring, the fourth-highest percentage in America. In the win over Bellarmine, Purdue's sophomores accounted for 47.9 percent of the points.

MILESTONE WATCH

- Eric Hunter Jr. 11 assists for 200 in career.
- Sasha Stefanovic 6 3-pointers for 150 in career (17th all time).
- Trevion Williams 29 points for 1,000 in career (54th all time).
- Trevion Williams 13 rebounds for 650 in career (16th all time).

INSIDE MORE NUMBERS

- Purdue is 123-15 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- Purdue is 160-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season.
- Purdue is 129-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 43-2 (losses to Notre Dame and Virginia Tech in 2018-19 season) since the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Purdue is 40-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game, winning 11 straight games.
- $\,$ Purdue is 133-14 under Painter when winning the rebound and turnover battles in the same game.
- Purdue has won 13 straight games when wearing its gold uniforms, dating to a New Year's Day loss vs. Minnesota in 2017.
- Purdue has won 17 straight games when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent.

OUICK STARTS ARE THE KEY

- Purdue has started 3-0 or better in 20 of the last 41 seasons dating to the 1979-80 campaign. Nineteen of those 20, 3-0 starts have resulted in a postseason tournament, 16 of which were NCAA Tournament trips.
- The Boilermakers have started 3-0 or better 10 times (in 16 seasons) under head coach Matt Painter, making the NCAA Tournament in all but one of those 10 seasons (2013-14).

RETURNING STARTS EQUALS SUCCESS

- Purdue will return 135 starts (of a possible 140), the fewest starts the program is losing from the previous season in the Painter era.

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments the seventh-longest active streak in COACHING EXPERIENCE America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
