GAMEDAY STORYLINES

► **SCENE SETTER:** The 22nd-ranked Purdue Boilermakers return home for its annual T-shirt game as well as the "Hammer Down Cancer" contest on Thursday night against Ohio State at 9 p.m. ET. **Rece Davis** and **Jim Calhoun** will provide expert commentary for ESPN, while **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will do the same on the radio dial for the Purdue Radio Network. Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com and as always, Twitter updates will be available on Purdue basketball's official account (@BoilerBall).

► **HAMMER DOWN CANCER:** Thursday's contest is being billed as the "Hammer Down Cancer" game where Purdue Athletics will hand out 15,000 t-shirts to create a stunning visual display for a nationally-televised ESPN audience. The color **volt** is the Purdue Center for Cancer Research's color to honor ALL cancer survivors. Since 1978, the Purdue University Center for Cancer Research has been a National Cancer Institute-designated basic-research cancer center. Only seven institutions in the United States have earned this title.

► **HOME SWEET HOME:** On pace for its largest attendance average since the 2010-11 season, Mackey Arena has been transformed into one of the most-intimidating venues in the country. Purdue has won 17 of its last 18 games in the facility with 13 of the wins coming by at least 12 points. Since the start of last year, the Boilermakers are 25-4 in the facility and since the start of Big Ten play a year ago, are 19-2.

► **UNDERCLASSMEN LEADING THE WAY:** Purdue's freshmen and sophomores have combined to score 896 of Purdue's 1,515 points, accounting for 59.1 percent of the Boilermakers' scoring. Over the last two games, the group has scored 178 of Purdue's 251 points (70.9 percent), including a whopping 73 points against Rutgers (33 by freshman; 40 by sophomores). In each of the last two games, the talented sophomore class has reached 40 points (41 vs. Penn State; 40 vs. Rutgers).

► **BENCH PRODUCTION:** Purdue's bench production has been sensational this year, as the group has outscored the opposing bench by an insane 414 points, an average of 21.8 points per game while outscoring the opposing bench in every game this year. The group is averaging 36.1 points per game and is shooting 47.1 percent from the field and 36.9 percent from 3-point range, while boasting an assist-to-turnover ratio of 150:80 (1.89). In Big Ten play, the group has scored 217 of Purdue's 462 points (47.0 percent of the scoring).

► **CAN I ASSIST YOU WITH THAT?:** Purdue has dished out at least 15 assists in each of the last five games and ranks 12th nationally in assists per game (18.2). The Boilermakers are 11th nationally in assist rate, despite the fact that it has no player among the Big Ten's top 15 in assists. Purdue has seven players averaging between 1.6 and 2.8 assists per game. All 10 "regulars" have dished out at least 11 assists.

► **POLL POSITION:** The Boilermakers entered this week ranked No. 22 in the AP Top 25 poll. It marks the 319th week (10th straight) that Purdue has been ranked in the AP poll and with its No. 9 ranking on Dec. 14, Purdue has been ranked in the top 10 in 116 weeks all-time.

► **ABOUT OHIO STATE:** Ohio State enters the contest with a 12-7 record and is tied for fourth with Purdue in the Big Ten with a 4-2 mark. The Buckeyes have had an interesting season, opening the campaign with a 2-4 record. After a loss to Connecticut on Dec. 12, the Buckeyes were 4-5, but then managed to win seven games in a row, including their first three Big Ten games. The Buckeyes are led by junior **Marc Loving** (13.9 points) and freshman **JaQuan Lyle** (10.5 points, 4.3 rebounds, 5.2 assists). The Buckeyes average 71.9 points per game and shoot 45.0 percent from the field.

► **SERIES HISTORY:** The only Big Ten team (sans Maryland; 1-0) to hold a series advantage against Purdue, the Buckeyes lead the all-time series 89-84. The Buckeyes are 17-26 in Mackey Arena, the most wins by a visiting team in Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers are just 1-7 against the Buckeyes since the 2011-12 season. This marks the 20th time in 23 meetings under **Matt Painter** that one of the teams will enter the contest nationally-ranked. A team in the series hasn't reached 70 points in the last four meetings and in the last 22 contests, 80 points has been reached just seven times.

► PURDUE BASKETBALL HISTORY

• Purdue is in its 118th season of basketball, owning a 1,728-989 (.636) all-time record. The Boilermakers rank 19th all-time in victories (1,727) and their 63.6 winning percentage is 20th all-time.

• Purdue has had just two head coaches, **Gene Keady** and **Matt Painter**, since the start of the 1980-81 season, a span of 35 years.

• Since the **Ray Eddy** era began in 1950, Purdue has had just six head coaches in 66 years and just eight head coaches in the last 99 years.

► RECORD-BREAKING NIGHT AT THE RAC

• Purdue defeated Rutgers, 107-57, on Monday night at The RAC in Piscataway, setting many program standards during the game.

• Purdue's 50-point margin of victory was its largest in a Big Ten game in school history, surpassing a 48-point (64-16) margin against the University of Chicago on Jan. 14, 1929.

• The victory was the largest margin in a road game in school history, surpassing the previous record of 43 points (70-27) against the University of Chicago on Jan. 7, 1944.

• The 50-point victory was the 10th-largest margin of victory in a game in school history.

• The 33-point (59-26) halftime lead was the ninth largest in a game in school history and the second largest in a Big Ten game in school history (35 vs. Wisconsin on Feb. 16, 1974).

• The 59 points in the first half are the most in a half against a Big Ten foe since scoring 61 against Minnesota in the second half on March 8, 1975.

• Purdue's 63 rebounds were the most of the **Matt Painter** era and were the most since having 65 against Iowa on Jan. 6, 1975.

• Purdue's 27 offensive rebounds were the second most in a game in school history (28 vs. James Madison; Dec. 3, 1993).

• Purdue's +40 (63-23) rebound margin is the largest margin in school history. It equals the best rebound margin between Division I foes this year and the fifth-best total nationally since the 2010-11 season.

• Purdue's four turnovers equaled the fifth fewest in a game in school history. Purdue's assist-to-turnover ratio (19:4; 4.75) was the fourth-best ratio in school history.

• Purdue scored 1.57 points per possession, the highest total in school history.

• Purdue surpassed 100 points in a Big Ten game for the first time since Feb. 7, 1998, against Ohio State (107-75). It equals the most in a Big Ten game since scoring 111 against Minnesota on Jan. 3, 1976 (two overtimes).

• Purdue has scored 100 points twice this season, the first time with multiple 100-point games since the 1997-98 season (5).

► PURDUE EQUALS BEST START IN 22 YEARS

• Through 19 games, Purdue has equaled its best start since the 1993-94 squad started 17-2. A win over Ohio State will match Purdue's best start in the last 28 years since the 1987-88 team started 18-2.

► PAINTER ERA STARTS IN BIG TEN PLAY

• With a win on Thursday night against Ohio State, Purdue will be 5-2 (or better) in Big Ten play for the fourth time under head coach **Matt Painter**. The previous three teams all finished no worse than second.

► CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD

• Purdue has dominated the glass all season long and it was never more evident than on Monday against Rutgers.

• Purdue outrebounded the Scarlet Knights by a 63-23 margin, the largest rebound margin in school history (+40). Purdue has now boasted the top-two rebound margin totals in school history this year (+37 vs. Incarnate Word).

• Purdue's +40 rebound margin was the fifth-largest margin nationally in a game since the 2010-11 season and tied for the highest this year.

• Purdue had more rebounds (63) than Rutgers had points (57).

• Purdue had more offensive rebounds (27) than Rutgers had rebounds (23). Purdue's 27 offensive rebounds were the second most in a game in school history and the most for a team against a Division I foe this year.

• The Boilermakers have outrebounded all 19 foes this year and rank first nationally in rebound margin (+12.6).

► BALANCED ATTACK

• Purdue has showcased its balance all season long and the numbers bear that out.

• Purdue has six players averaging between 7.5 and 13.4 points, led by **A.J. Hammons** at 13.4 points per game.

• Purdue has four players averaging at least 4.7 rebounds per game.

• Purdue has six players averaging between 2.0 and 2.8 assists per game and two more players averaging at least 1.0 assists per game.

• Purdue has seven players with at least 15 3-point field goals.

■ 50-POINT WINS IN BIG TEN PLAY

• Purdue became the first team in 16 years to win a Big Ten game by at least 50 points. It has been accomplished just six times, and just twice on the road, in 120 years of the league's existence.

■ DEFENSE LIVES HERE

• Purdue continues to lead the country in defensive points per possession (0.85) and is fourth in field goal percentage defense (.364).

• The Boilermakers are also ninth in scoring defense and 29th in blocked shots per game.

• According to Ken Pomeroy, Purdue is first in effective field goal percentage defense (.410), fifth in adjusted defensive efficiency (89.4), fourth in 2-point field goal percentage defense (.394) and 16th in 3-point percentage defense (.296).

• Obviously there are many games left this year, but Purdue's effective field goal percentage defense (.410) currently is the second-best percentage since the 2001-02 season.

• The Boilermakers have held 16 of a possible 18 opponents under their pregame scoring average. Ohio State enters the game averaging 71.9 points per game.

• Purdue has forced 10 shot clock violations already this year, one year after forcing 19 in 34 games. If you're counting, that 29 in 53 games.

■ SUCCESS UNDER 60

• Purdue has now held 11 teams this year to 59 points or less. The Boilermakers are 114-4 under Painter when holding teams to 59 points or less, including 11-0 this year.

• Purdue has held two straight foes to 59 points or less and doing so against Ohio State would mark the first time since Feb. 24 - March 3, 2013, that Purdue has held three straight Big Ten foes under 59 points.

• The Boilermakers are allowing just 60.8 points per game, which would rank as the third-lowest average in school history.

■ LIMITING CHANCES

• Opponents have scored just 125 second-chance points this year, an average of 6.6 per game.

• Over the last four games (Michigan, Illinois, Penn State and Rutgers), the four teams have grabbed just 21 offensive rebounds for a total of 25 second-chance points.

• Illinois' two offensive rebounds were the fewest allowed in a game since 1986-87, when offensive rebounds became a statistic.

• Purdue has held 9-of-19 opponents to nine or fewer offensive rebounds, including 5-of-6 Big Ten opponents. Purdue leads the Big Ten during league games only in defensive rebound percentage (.812) and offensive rebound percentage (.384).

• Just four teams (Pittsburgh, Howard, Butler and Iowa) have managed to score at least 10 second-chance points against the Boilermakers.

■ DIALING LONG DISTANCE

• After shooting just 35.3 percent from long distance in non-conference play, Purdue has turned it around in Big Ten play, connecting on 37.5 percent of its 3-point attempts, ranking fifth in league games only in 3-point percentage.

• Over the last four games, Purdue has connected on 35-of-90 (.389) of its 3-point attempts.

• Purdue has made at least 10 3-pointers in seven games this year, the most since having 10 games of double-digit 3-pointers in the 2011-12 season.

• In the win over Rutgers, Purdue's bench went 10-of-22 (.455) from 3-point range.

• Purdue is on pace (35-game schedule) for 295 3-pointers, which would surpass the school record of 284 set in 2011-12.

• In Big Ten play, Purdue's three sophomores (**Vince Edwards, Dakota Mathias** and **P.J. Thompson**) are a combined 24-of-47 (.511).

■ IT COMES DOWN TO TURNOVERS

• Purdue has had an issue with turnovers in its losses coming to Butler, Iowa and Illinois. If the Boilermakers can solve those issues, a special season could be on the horizon.

• In Purdue's three losses, the Boilermakers have had 48 turnovers, resulting in 67 points. The losses have come by a combined 27 points.

• Purdue has been outscored by 33 points in the "points off turnovers" category in those three games, clearly making a huge difference in the outcome of those contests.

• Purdue has won the turnover battle just four times this year (Vermont, IUPUI, Howard, Rutgers). The Boilermakers have had 15 or more turnovers five times this year, including in three of the last eight games (all losses).

• Meanwhile, Purdue ranks 124th nationally in turnovers per game (12.5), 299th in turnover margin (-2.00) and 332nd in turnovers forced (10.5).

• Purdue has shown that it can take care of the ball, registering two halves this year (first halves vs. Vermont and Rutgers) where it committed zero turnovers.

■ SHARING IS CARING

• Purdue ranks 12th in the country in assists per game at 18.2 per contest. The Boilermakers have dished out at least 20 assists in a game seven different times this year, including in four of the last 10 games.

• Purdue has assisted on 65.3 percent of its made field goals this year, a percentage that ranks 11th nationally in assist rate.

• Purdue's 26 assists against Michigan were its most in a Big Ten game since having 29 against Minnesota on Feb. 19, 2000.

• Purdue's seven "wing" players (not including Haas, Hammons, Swanigan) all have assist-to-turnover ratio better than 1.00.

• Purdue has posted the third- (Vermont), fourth- (Rutgers) and fifth- (Howard) best assist-to-turnover ratios in a single game already this year.

■ BETTER FROM THE LINE

• After starting the season 38-of-59 (.644) from the free throw line in the first two games, Purdue has turned it around at the charity stripe.

• The Boilermakers are 261-of-342 (.763) from the free throw line during the last 17 games.

• In its three Big Ten road games, Purdue is shooting 79.6 percent (39-of-49) from the free throw line.

• Purdue has had seven games this year where it has made 80.0 percent or better from the free throw line. Last year's team had just four games all season of 80 percent or better.

• The school record for free throw percentage in a season is 78.2 percent during the 1968-69 season. This year's average (.746) ranks fifth in school history.

• Purdue ranks 27th nationally in free throw percentage, a significant improvement over the last four years where the Boilermakers ranked 275th (2012), 291st (2013), 261st (2014) and 213th (2015).

• Purdue is close to making more free throws (299) than opponents shoot (310). The Illinois game swung that stat the other way (9-28).

• Purdue has won 31 straight games when shooting more free throws than its opponent, including 13 times this year.

• Seven of Purdue's 10 rotation players are shooting above 72.0 percent from the free throw line. Last year's team had five players over 72.0 percent.

■ ALMOST AUTOMATIC

• Purdue is 88-8 under Painter when it wins the rebound and turnover battles.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 11th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 148-32 (.822) record at home over the last 11 seasons, including a remarkable 82-7 (.921) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 40 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
