### THE OPENING TIP

• Purdue (6-3, 1-0) looks to remain unbeaten in Big Ten play when it takes to the road for the first time in league competition Sunday at Nebraska (4-6, 0-1). The contest will tip at 4 p.m. ET, on BTN with **Cory Provus** and **Shon Morris** on the call. On the radio, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 3 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on Huskers.com.

• Purdue owns a 16-5 record against Nebraska having won six of its last seven games against the Huskers. Purdue has scored at least 75 points in each of its last three visits to Pinnacle Bank Arena.

• This marks the third straight year that the Big Ten has played league games in December. The Boilermakers are now 4-1 in those games, going 2-0 (at Maryland, Northwestern) in the 2017-18 season, 1-1 (at Michigan, Maryland) during the 2018-19 season and are 1-0 this year after defeating Northwestern last Sunday.

• A win would give Purdue a 7-3 record through 10 games, marking Purdue's 12th 7-3 start (or better) during **Matt Painter's** 15 years at Purdue. The only years the Boilermakers did not start 7-3 or better were in 2005-06, 2012-13 and 2018-19.

• Purdue is looking for its sixth 2-0 league start during the **Matt Painter** era. In five previous years that Purdue started Big Ten play with a 2-0 record, the Boilermakers finished T-1st (2009-10), 2nd (2010-11), 6th (2011-12), T-3rd (2014-15) and T-2nd (2-0). It advanced to the Sweet 16 in two of those seasons (2009-10, 2017-18).

• **SOMETHING TO WATCH:** The offensive glass. Purdue has attacked the offensive glass, while also not allowing opponents to have much success.

• Purdue has held two straight opponents under 45 points (Virginia - 40; Northwestern - 44) for the first time since Dec. 10 and 15, 1947 (Marquette - 44; Pittsburgh - 29).

• Over the last two first halves, opponents have scored just 33 points and shot 13 of 44 (.295) from the field and 5 of 23 (.217) from 3-point range.

• Purdue has won 17 straight games when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Its last loss came on Feb. 15, 2018, at Wisconsin (57-53).

• Purdue has had five different players lead the team in scoring this year, coming in just nine games. Last year's team had four different players lead the team in scoring in 36 games.

• Purdue has won 16 straight games when attempting more free throws than its opponent.

• Purdue owns the second-best road record in the Big Ten (27-19) and the best overall league record (70-23) since the 2014-15 season.

• Purdue has won 99 straight games when scoring 90 or more points in a game. Its last loss came on Nov. 24, 1987, vs. Iowa State (104-96).

• **Jahaad Proctor** has scored in double-figures in 25 straight games.

• With Sasha Stefanovic scoring 20 points vs. Virginia, just three active Purdue players have ever scored 20 points in a game (Stefanovic, **Matt Haarms**, **Jahaad Proctor**).

## INSIDE THE SERIES

- Purdue leads the all-time series with Nebraska by a 16-5 margin, including a 10-3 advantage during the **Matt Painter** era.
- Purdue has won six of the last seven games with Nebraska. The lone loss came during Purdue's 2016-17 Big Ten-title season, an 83-80 setback in Lincoln. Five of the six wins during that span have been decided by 12 points or more.
- Eight of Purdue's 10 wins during the Painter era have come by at least nine points.
- Purdue has scored at least 74 points in eight of the 13 games during the Painter era, including six straight contests. Nebraska has reached 74 points just twice during the Painter era and has been held under 65 points in nine of the games.
- Sunday's meeting marks the first time in seven meetings that Purdue is not nationally ranked at the time of the game.

## A BOILERMAKER WIN OVER NEBRASKA WOULD...

- ... improve Purdue to 7-3 on the season.
- ... improve Purdue to 2-0 in the Big Ten standings.
- ... be Purdue's sixth 2-0 Big Ten start during the **Matt Painter** era.

- ... be the fourth straight victory over Nebraska.

## BIG TEN ROAD OPENERS

- Purdue is 6-8 under head coach **Matt Painter** in Big Ten road openers. The Boilermakers have won three of their last four Big Ten road openers.

## THAT 2-0 START

- Purdue is looking for its sixth 2-0 start in Big Ten play during the **Matt Painter** era. Unbeaten starts usually mean success for the Boilermakers.

## GETTING DEFENSIVE

- Purdue's defense ranks fifth nationally in KenPom's adjusted defensive efficiency ratings behind Virginia, Ohio State, Louisville and Duke, allowing just 85.9 points per 100 possessions.
- Through Tuesday's games, Purdue ranks sixth in scoring defense, ninth in 3-point percentage defense, 20th in rebound margin, 37th in field goal percentage defense and 70th in turnover margin.
- Purdue has held its first nine opponents of the season to 70 or fewer points for the first time since the 2010-11 season. That team did it in 19 straight games.
- Over the last five games, foes are just 109 of 305 (.357) from the field and 23 of 115 (.200) from long distance.

- Purdue has forced at least 16 turnovers in five of nine games this year.
- Purdue has held opponents to just 70 offensive rebounds (7.8 per game) for a total of 62 second-chance points (6.9 per game).
- Opponents have shot over 39.0 percent just twice this year (Texas, VCU) and foes have had at least 16 turnovers in five games.
- Check out how Purdue's defensive numbers compare in the last two games, at home and in Boilermaker victories vs. losses.

## OFFENSE CLICKS IN CHALLENGE

- Purdue had one of its best offensive games of the season in the win over Virginia. The Boilermakers shot 45.3 percent from the field, made a Purdue-challenge record 13 (of 25) 3-point attempts and had a Purdue-challenge low seven turnovers.
- Since the start of the 2017-18 season (a span of 81 games), Virginia has allowed 1.19 points per possession just four times. Purdue has done it twice.

## BIG TEN OPENER HISTORY

- With its win over Northwestern, Purdue now owns a 69-46 (.600) record in Big Ten openers, having won nine of its last 11 openers.
- The 44 points allowed were the fewest allowed in a Big Ten opener since the 1944-45 season, when Purdue edged Ohio State 37-36.

## THE EXTRA POSSESSION GAME

- Purdue has always stressed winning the extra-possession game and it typically means success when it wins the rebounding and turnover battles.
- Purdue is 5-1 this year 121-12 under Coach Painter when winning both the rebound and turnover battles.

## BIG MAN PRODUCTION

- There are two regulars on the roster shooting at least 50.0 percent from the field. They are Purdue's centers.
- Matt Haarms** and **Trevion Williams** are a combined 66 of 99 (.667) from the field. The rest of the team is a combined 162 of 426 (.380) from the field.
- Over the last eight games, the duo is 52 of 75 (.693) from the field.
- Per 40 minutes, the duo is averaging 18.7 points and 11.5 rebounds.

## #TRENDING

- **Matt Painter** won his 350th career game with the win over VCU.
- Purdue is 24-4 when **Matt Haarms** scores in double figures.
- Purdue is 152-16 under **Matt Painter** when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the field.
- Purdue is 25-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher percentage from the field than its opponent. The lone loss was to Virginia in the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Purdue is 106-9 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponent, including 21-2 since the start last season.
- Purdue is 31-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game.
- Purdue is 119-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 33-2 since the start of 2017-18.
- Purdue is 150-5 when holding foes to 59 or fewer points during the **Matt Painter** era.

## TOP-FIVE TEAMS START THE STREAK

- Two years ago, Purdue defeated No. 2-ranked Arizona 89-64 at the Battle 4 Atlantis. That win started the Boilermakers on a school-record 19-game win streak.
- Last week, Purdue defeated No. 5-ranked Virginia 69-40 in hopes of starting a similar streak.
- A closer look at those games reveal how similar they were.

► **Record at Purdue:** 327-162 (.669) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 352-167 (.678) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
- Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
