

First-year head coach Scott Hinkel ushered the Purdue wrestling program into a new era in 2007-08, leading the squad to a 10-8 season, a 2-6 mark in Big Ten duals, one of the best performances in recent history at the Big Ten Championships and a 30th-place finish at the NCAA Championships. Hinkel became just the third coach in school history to post a winning dual record in his first season, joining former coaches Don Corrigan and Fred Miller. He also led the Boilermakers to more conference-dual victories than in the previous two seasons combined.

The Old Gold and Black saw several new additions to the career and single-season record books, highlighted by junior standout Jake Patacsil breaking both the single-season and career marks for back points, while climbing the career lists in three other categories.

November

The Boilermakers got off to a roller-coaster start in 2007, placing nine wrestlers among the various weight classes at the Eastern Michigan Open, but stumbling as they posted a 1-2 start at the second-annual ACC/Big Ten Clash and placed 21st at the 26th annual Cliff Keen Las Vegas Invitational. Jake Patacsil and sophomore teammate Nick Bertucci highlighted the Eastern Michigan Open, winning the 149- and 157pound championships, respectively. Freshman Luke Manuel captured second-place at 165 pounds, while junior Jake Murphy, sophomore Nick Corpe and freshman Logan Brown grabbed respective bronze medals at 157, 174 and 197 pounds. Sophomore Sam Patacsil finished fifth at 157 pounds, and sophomore Justin Fraga and freshman A.J. Kissel took sixth at 165 and 184 pounds.

Purdue traveled to Chapel Hill, N.C. for the ACC/Big Ten Clash, where the Boilermakers picked up their first dual win of the season against North Carolina State, but suffered narrow losses to Virginia and the host Tarheels of North Carolina. Purdue opened the day with a 16-15 loss to the Cavaliers, bounced back with a 25-15 victory over the Wolfpack and closed out the day with a 22-16 loss to UNC. Corpe was the lone Boilermakers to earn a trio of wins on the day, while junior Mark Powell and freshmen Logan Brown, Matt Hemry and A.J. Kissel each posted a pair of wins.

The Boilermakers headed to the desert of Las Vegas without two of their starters in tow, but still managed a 21st-place finish with 36.5 team points. Bertucci and Kissel had solid tournaments, each pinning a trio of foes, including a fall of then-ranked Kurt Brenner of West Virginia. The Old Gold and Black took a

major hit in the second round of the tournament as Jake Patacsil suffered a rib injury which took him out of the lineup for a month.

December

Purdue got back on track in December, evening their dual record with a home-opening victory over visiting Mount Saint Joseph and posting their best-ever finish at the 45th annual Midlands Championships. The Boilermakers routed the visiting Lions before the holiday break, posting a 39-3 win with nine individual wins on the day. The bonus points came in bunches as Purdue scored a pair of pins, two technical falls and two major decisions.

The Boilermakers posted a ninth-place showing in Evanston, Ill., riding Jake Patacsil's second-place showing to 58 team points. Patacsil racked up a series of bonus points, notching a fall, three technical falls and a major decision. Manuel was the only other Purdue grappler to place, posting a 5-3 record in the tournament to take home eighth. Other highlights of the tournament included 125-pound freshman Akif Eren toppling 14th-ranked Luke Smith of Central Michigan and 165-pound sophomore Jason Martin defeating 2008 All-American Moza Fay of Northern Iowa.

January

The Boilermakers picked up the new year where they left off in 2007, posting a 7-1 dual record in the month, including their first Big Ten Dual victory since 2006. They opened the month with a grueling trip to Philadelphia and New Jersey, where they posted a 24-18 win over Rider and 35-6 victory over Drexel. The trip included Kissel's 10th and 11th falls of the season and Jake Patacsil's 391st career back point, tying him for the school record with Hinkel.

Patacsil broke the record in their following dual, a repetitive 35-6 win over the visiting United States Air Force Academy. He rolled up 13 back points on five nearfalls, en route to his third straight technical fall. Kissel hit a three-of-a-kind, as well, sticking his third straight foe and 12th opponent of the season.

Season Review

The streak continued at the Wendy's Duals, hosted by Ashland University in Ashland, Ohio. There the Old Gold and Black posted wins over the host Eagles, Northern Illinois and Liberty. Kissel ran his pin streak to six consecutive matches and tied the Boilermakers' single-season record for falls with his 15th of the season. Patacsil and Brown were the only other Purdue wrestlers to notch 3-0 marks on the day, while Sam Patacsil and Manuel notched 2-0 records and Eren and senior Sean Schmaltz tallied a pair of wins apiece.

Purdue's lone hiccup of the month came in its Big Ten opener at Michigan, where the Boilermakers suffered a hard-fought 24-12 defeat, but they bounced back in full force with an 18-16 victory at Michigan State. Jake Patacsil and heavyweight Chris Kasten both took home a pair of wins on the weekend as Kasten's win at Michigan was the first conference win of his collegiate career.

February

Purdue wrapped up the Big Ten dual season with just one win in its final six matches, but that victory was huge as the Boilermakers defeated archrival Indiana University for the first time since 2004. The win gave Purdue a point in the coveted Crimson and Gold Cup and guaranteed the Boilermakers a winning dual season. The two biggest wins of the match came at heavyweight and 133 pounds as Kasten battled back from a late deficit to pin sophomore Nate Everhart in the final 15 seconds, while Schmaltz toppled 12th-ranked Andrae Hernandez in what Schmaltz called the biggest win of his career.

Purdue nearly scored another huge upset in its home finale but dropped a narrow 21-17 loss to highly-ranked Northwestern on Senior Night. Kissel highlighted the night by breaking the Boilermakers' single-season fall record as he stuck Northwestern's Adil Kolovic for his 16th pin of the season. Patacsil scored a big win as well, upending two-time All-American Ryan Lang of Northwestern with an 18-6 major decision.

March

The Boilermakers wrapped up the 2007-08 season with a solid postseason showing, posting one of their best Big Ten Championship performances in recent history and nearly advancing a pair of wrestlers to the national podium at the NCAA Championships. Although they finished 10th at the conference championships for the second straight year, the Boilermakers amassed 51.5 team points on the strength of Manuel's third-place showing and Patacsil's fourth-place finish. The total is their most since the 2004 season, and just the fourth time in the last 14 years they've surpassed the 50-point plateau. Brown managed a fifth-place finish and Kissel took home seventh place to give Purdue four automatic bids to the national tournament. Kasten and Bertucci fell just shy, finishing eighth in their respective weight classes: however. Bertucci was named one of two alternates for the national tournament. Major highlights of the tournament included a pair of wins over 2007 NCAA Runner-Ups. Patacsil topped Michigan's Josh Churella by decision, 7-6, in the 149-pound quarterfinals, while Bertucci prevented Wisconsin's Craig Henning from returning to the national tournament with a 6-3 tie-break victory in the wrestlebacks.

Patacsil and Manuel led Purdue at the NCAA Championships as both made the Round of 12, but fell just one win shy of All-America status. Patacsil earned the No. 8 seed at 149 pounds and posted a 3-2 record in the tournament with both losses coming to eventual All-Americans, and Manuel bounced back from an openinground loss to reel off three straight wins before bowing out. Patacsil picked up several bonus points with a pair of technical falls and a major decision, while Kissel capped his season with a pin of ninth-seeded former Boilermaker Brent Chriswell for his single-season Purdue record 19th fall of the season. The Boilermakers wrapped up the tournament in 30th place with 14.5 team points.
