HEAD COACH JEFF BROHM

- Is now 50-35 in his eighth year as a head coach overall
- Is now 20-25 in his fifth year as Purdue's head coach
- Is now 12-13 in games played at Ross-Ade Stadium
- Is now 2-3 in season-openers and 4-1 in home-openers at Purdue
- Is now 1-0 against Oregon State as Purdue's head coach

PURDUE RECORDS

- Is now 621-579-48 in its 134th season
- Is now 78-50-6 in season openers
- Is now 92-37-4 in home-openers
 - ... Purdue has won 22 of its last 24 home openers
- Is now 384-240-25 in home games all-time
- Is now 291-196-13 all-time at Ross-Ade Stadium
- Is now 1-1-0 all-time against Oregon State

SERIES HISTORY VS. OREGON STATE

- The all-time series is tied 1-1-0
- The Boilermakers are 1-1-0 at Ross-Ade Stadium vs. OSU
- The lone previous meeting was a 22-14 Oregon State win on Oct. 21, 1967, at Ross-Ade Stadium

PURDUE TEAM NOTES

- Today marked the beginning of the 134th season of Purdue Football and the 97th campaign at Ross-Ade Stadium
- Today was the 500th game in Ross-Ade Stadium history, and Purdue boasts a 291-196-13 record at their home that opened in 1924
- Purdue had at least two 100-yard receivers (David Bell, 134, and Payne Durham, 120) for the 38th time in program history and for the 11th time since 2016
 - ... David Bell has been a part of the last six 100-yard receiving duos
- Purdue held Oregon State to 5-of-15 on third down and 1-of-4 on fourth down

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

OFFENSE

David Bell

- Led the team with 134 receiving yards on eight catches
- Has 11 career games with 100-plus yards receiving, tied for No. 3 in program history
 - ... Taylor Stubblefield also had 11 100-yard receiving games, while Brian Alford had 12 and John Standeford holds the Purdue record with 14
- Had at least 100 receiving yards for the 11th time in 19 career games and has reached triple digits in eight of the last 10 games
 - ... His 11 career 100-yard receiving games is the most by an active player in the country since 2019
- Had at least seven catches for the 13th time in 19 career games and for the 10th time in the last 11 games
- Moves into 14th place all-time with 147 career receptions
 - ... Passes five players on the list, and Isaac Jones, with 154 receptions from 1995-98, is next at No. 13
- Moves into 20th place all-time with 1,794 career receiving yards
 - ... Passed Isaac Jones, who had 1,763 yards from 1995-98, and currently sits behind Rodney Carter, who had 1,814 yards from 1982-85

Jack Plummer

- Was 29-for-41 for 313 yards with two touchdown passes and no interceptions
- Has passed for at least 300 yards in five career games and in three of his last four
 - ... Five career 300-yard passing games is tied for No. 8 in program history with Billy Dicken
- Earned first career win

Payne Durham

- Had seven catches for 120 yards with two touchdowns, all career-bests
 - ... Eclipsed previous highs of four receptions, 52 yards and one TD
- Both touchdown catches were in the fourth quarter, a five-yard reception followed by a 50-yarder
 - ... Has nine career touchdown catches
- Had a career-long touchdown catch of 50 yards, besting his previous career-long reception of 29 yards

Zander Horvath

- Ran for a team-best 81 yards on 21 carries with a touchdown
- Touchdown run was for 11 yards in the first quarter

DEFENSE

Cam Allen

- Had one interception, in the second quarter
 - ... The interception is the fourth of his career and third in his last six games
- Was second on the team with five tackles, all solo

Kieren Douglas

- Had a career-high-tying five tackles, three solo

Jalen Graham

- Had a team-best six tackles, five solo, with one sack, a career-best three pass breakups and one forced fumble
 - ... The three pass breakups bests his previous high of one, set in 2019
 - ... The forced fumble was the second of his career

SPECIAL TEAMS

Mitchell Fineran

- Scored 12 points, three field goals and three PATs
 - ... Is the first Boilermaker to score at least 10 points kicking since Spencer Evans had 14 in 2018 vs. Wisconsin (Nov. 17)
- Was three-for-three in field goal attempts
 - ... Had a 48-yard field goal in the 2nd quarter, his first as a Boilermaker and the 2nd-longest of his career (made a 50-yard field goal in 2020 for Samford)
 - ... Had 39-yard field goal in the 2nd quarter
 - ... Had 22-yard field goal in the 3rd quarter
- Was a perfect three-for-three on PAT attempts.
- Made his Boilermaker debut after transferring from Samford
