HOW WE DO IT

Scholarships: The Foundation honors athletes, not only for their ability as football players, but also for their academic and civic leadership. Today the Foundation, with its chapters, annually awards nearly \$1,000,000 in scholarships to over 3,000 high school and college student-athletes for continuing education.

The Play It Smart Program is gaining national visibility



for its efforts in bringing greater academic support to football players at high schools in under-served communities. Because of the NFF's unique chapter structure and support from the NFL, this program continues to experience rapid growth and success. The key to the program is the introduction of an academic coach, who specializes in providing ongoing academic support, personal development initiatives and community involvement.

The NFF Center for Youth Development Through Sport

at Springfield College serves as a multidimensional resource for enhancing the efforts of the NFF and Springfield College, working primarily with the Play It Smart program to ensure that the academic coaches are the best trained and most effective in the field.

NFL/NFF Coaching Academy

provides necessary training for football coaches to ensure that our youth and high school football programs are staffed with individuals who are qualified and prepared to focus on providing a safe and positive learning environment for its participants. This program was designed and is taught by some of football's most innovative minds.
