THE OPENING TIP

• Purdue (14-14, 7-10) looks for a season sweep of Indiana on Thursday as the Hoosiers visit Mackey Arena. **Tim Brando** and **Steve Lavin** will handle the broadcast on FS1, beginning at 7 p.m. ET. On the radio, **Rob Blackman**, **Larry Clisby** and **Ralph Taylor** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 6 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on PurdueSports.com.

• Purdue owns a 121-89 series lead with Indiana, having won six straight in the series, including a 74-62 decision 19 days ago in Bloomington (box score available later in packet). The Boilermakers have won four straight in Mackey Arena against Indiana, coming by a combined 60 points.

• When Purdue holds Indiana to 69 or fewer points during the **Matt Painter** era, the Boilermakers are 13-1 having won 13 straight games. When allowing 70 or more points, Purdue is 2-8.

• Purdue has played one of the toughest schedules in America. Purdue has played 15 quad-1 opponents (second nationally to Iowa State's 16) and the Boilermakers schedule is No. 1 in the country according to ESPN. Purdue's 10 games against nationally-ranked teams are the most in the country (tied with Iowa) and Purdue's four wins are the sixth most. For comparison purposes, Purdue has won as many games against ranked teams that Duke, Gonzaga, Maryland, Virginia and others have played.

• **SOMETHING TO WATCH:** Things have been different when Purdue has played at home and Indiana has been on the road. The Boilermakers are hopeful Mackey Arena serves up some home cooking Thursday.

• Purdue is 13-2 this year and 33-3 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The lone losses came to Virginia in last year's Elite Eight and in its last two games against Wisconsin and Michigan. The Boilermakers are 1-12 when shooting a lower field goal percentage than its opponent (win vs. VCU).

• Head coach **Matt Painter's** next victory will tie him with Michigan State legend **Jud Heathcote** on the Big Ten's all-time wins list (336).

• Over the last two games, Purdue has forced just 12 total turnovers for an average of 6.0 per game. The Boilermakers are minus-9 in turnover margin the last two games (12-21).

• Purdue freshmen and sophomores have combined for 1,127 points this year (40.3 PPG), accounting for 58.9 percent of Purdue's scoring this year. In games that the two classes score at least 35 points, the Boilermakers are 12-8 overall. When they don't, Purdue is 2-6.

• Purdue is 9-2 when scoring at least 70 points this year (losses to Michigan and Penn State), but is just 5-12 when being held under 70 points.

• The magic number for Purdue is 45 percent. When the Boilermakers shoot at least 45.0 percent from the field, Purdue is 10-1. When holding foes under 45.0 percent, Purdue is 14-6.

PAINTING NO. 500

- The Jan. 24 game vs. Wisconsin was the 500th game coached by head coach **Matt Painter** at Purdue, becoming the third Purdue mentor to reach that mark (**Ward "Piggy" Lambert**, **Gene Keady**). Only age 49, Painter is entering his prime as a basketball coach.
- ... 11 NCAA Tournaments as a Big Ten coach are the sixth most in league history.
- ... 335 career wins in the Big Ten are the 10th most in league history.
- ... 165 Big Ten Conference wins are the 10th most in league history.
- ... 4 Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history.
- ... his 360 wins are the third most nationally of any coach under the age of 50 (**Mick Cronin** - 382, age 48; **Scott Drew** - 362, age 49). They are the 11th most of any coach under the age of 55.
- ... of coaches under the age of 55 on the above-mentioned wins list, Painter is one of six to reach an Elite Eight and his five Sweet 16 appearances are the second most.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

- **Record at Purdue:** 335-173 (.659) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 360-178 (.669) / 16th year
- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his resumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
 - He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
 - Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
 - Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
 - Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
 - Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
 - Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
 - Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
 - Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
 - Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
 - Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
 - Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
 - Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
 - Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
 - Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
 - Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
 - Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
 - Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
 - Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
