A CLOSER LOOK AT THE BOILERMAKERS

- Michigan and Rutgers mark the fifth and sixth nationally ranked opponents for the Boilermakers this season, all of which hail from the Big Ten ... Friday's dual at Michigan and Sunday's dual vs. Rutgers mark the end of the Big Ten dual season for all three teams.
- Assistant coach Tyrel Todd returns to his alma mater Friday ... he was a three-time All-American and 2009 Big Ten champion for the Wolverines.
- Michigan will be Chad Welch's 60th career dual and Doug Welch's 95th career match ... Drake Stein's 80th and Tyler Kral's 60th career matches would come against Rutgers ... Danny Sabatello is seeking career win No. 75.
- Seventeen of C. Welch's 24 wins this season are with bonus points (9 MD, 2 TF, 6 F) ... eight of his nine dual victories have also been with bonus points (5 MD, 1 TF, 2 F).
- Kyle Ayersman is second on the team with nine bonus point wins (2 MD, 3 TF, 4 F) ... Jacob Morrissey and Stein are tied for third with seven ... Morrissey has one major, two techs and four falls ... Stein has one major, one tech and five falls.
- Purdue wrestlers have combined record of 234-176 (.571) ... 124 matches have been won via decision, 35 by major decision, 19 technical falls have been registered and they have pinned 42 opponents.

- The Boilermakers have combined to outscore their opponents 2,308 to 2,020 (+288) in 410 matches this season ... they are averaging 5.6 points/match while the opposition is averaging 4.9.
- Purdue scores first in half of its matches ... the Boilermakers own scoring advantages in all three periods and overtime ... the first period is the most offensive with a +102 scoring advantage (840-738) ... they are +25 in the second (598-573) and then they surge in the third at +92 (701-609) ... in overtime matches they are +16.
- The Boilermakers have shutout 34 opponents ... a dozen of those shutouts have come in dual action ... Purdue has only been held scoreless in three dual bouts and 13 times overall throughout the season.
- In 28 matches wrestled, C. Welch has only been taken down a dozen times ... he has scored 194 points and is averaging 6.9 points per match, both of which are career highs.
- Tanner Lynde is posting career highs across the board, including dual and Big Ten dual victories, bonus point victories, pins, takedowns, total points scored and dual points scored.

When it comes to duals...

- Two of Purdue's probables own Big Ten dual marks of 5-2 marks ... four of C. Welch's five wins have been by major decision, the fifth by decision ... Alex Griffin has a pair of technical falls, two decisions and a major decision ... Lynde, Morrissey and D. Welch also carry winning conference records of 4-3.
- C. Welch leads the team in dual points scored with 43 ... the top-five dual point scorers are rounded out by Lynde (36), Morrissey (35), D. Welch (34) and Griffin (33).
- Although six different lineups have been used, the starters at 141 and 157 have not changed with Sabatello and D. Welch, respectively ... Sabatello and D. Welch have started 31 consecutive duals for the Boilermakers since the start of the 2014-15 season ... during the stretch, Sabatello has posted a 22-9 dual record and D. Welch is 24-7.
- Purdue has a combined Big Ten dual record of 32-38 with three different lineups ... 19 matches have been won via decision, six by major decision, four by technical fall and two by pin ... overall the Boilermakers own a 76-54 dual record.
- Luke Schroeder (125) entered the dual lineup against Ohio State ... it was his first dual start since Feb. 7, 2014.
- Twelve of the 13 duals have started at 125 ... the lowa dual is the only one in which the starting weight has been drawn (157).
- The Boilermakers have put 30 points on the board in six duals and they have won at least one bout with bonus points 11 times
- \bullet The Welch Trio (Luke 133; Doug 157; Chad 165) have started 19 duals together dating to last season ... they have won together six times this season and eight times overall.

• Michigan is coming off a 27-16 win at Rutgers on Sunday ... the Wolverines opened with upset decisions at 125 and 133 and registered a major decision at 149 before the Scarlet Knights won three straight ... Michigan's big three, Domenic Abounader, Max Huntley and Adam Coon, closed out the dual with a tech fall and back-to-back pins.

More on the Wolverines...

- Michigan has won its last two duals after suffering its only Big Ten loss 35-7 to No. 1 Penn State (1/31) ... Wolverines other loss this season was to No. 14 Oklahoma (11/22) ... they are 6-2 against ranked teams.
- Michigan is 6-1 in Cliff Keen Arena and has outscored their opponents 185-43 ... the trio of top-10 upperweights for the Wolverines combine for a 40-0 dual mark with 28 bonus point victories.
- The Wolverines have lost just two bouts in four of their eight Big Ten duals ... Michigan State, Indiana, Northwestern and Maryland were only able to win a pair of decisions when they went up against Michigan ... in 80 conference bouts, Michigan has only given up seven losses with bonus points (3 TF, 2 F, 1 injury default, 1 forfeit).

• Last season Doug Welch and Michigan's Brian Murphy met three times within a month ... D. Welch defeated Murphy in his second match at the Big Ten Championships ... Murphy took the dual meeting and won in the fifth-place match at Big Tens.

More on the Scarlet Knights...

- Rutgers will wrestle at Indiana on Friday before making its first-ever trip to West Lafayette for Sunday's dual ... it is the third consecutive two-dual weekend for the Scarlet Knights ... in addition to Michigan, they also hosted and lost to Wisconsin 18-15 last weekend.
- The Scarlet Knights are 5-3 against ranked teams, including a pair of wins over top-10 teams, No. 7 Cornell (11/29) and No. 4 Nebraska (12/12) ... when wrestling on the road they are 2-2, with both of the losses coming in their only Big Ten road duals at No. 2 lowa and at Minnesota.
- It will be a battle of top-10 wrestlers with Purdue's No. 7 Chad Welch vs. No. 8 Anthony Perrotti ... Perrotti will be the fifth top-10 opponent C. Welch has faced during the season and his second top-10 battle ... Perrotti owns a 6-1 record against Big Ten foes with five decisions, one major decision and one technical fall ... their only common opponent in conference duals is Michigan State's Dean Vettese ... C. Welch posted a 13-4 major decision, compared to Perrotti's 5-1 decision.
- Four other probables for Rutgers boast Big Ten winning records: Anthony Ashnault (6-1), Richie Lewis (5-1), Nicholas Gravina (4-1) and Billy Smith (5-2).

PURDUE RANKINGS NOTES

- After slipping out of the top 25 last week, the Boilermakers return to the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll at No. 23 thanks to their upset of then-No. 20 Indiana on Sunday ... Purdue has appeared on eight of the 14 polls issued this season ... the team ranking is the 15th while under the direction of head coach Tony Ersland.
- Purdue also made its first appearances on FloWrestling and InterMat's team dual rankings this week at Nos. 19 and 21, respectively.
- For a fifth straight week, Chad Welch checks in at No. 7 on InterMat's 165-pound rankings ... it is his ninth consecutive appearance among the top 10, which stands as the longest a Purdue wrestler has been ranked among the top 10 since Cashé Quiroga, who was ranked among the top 10 at 133 for the entire 2011-12 season ... C. Welch's career-best ranking of No. 5 in the Jan. 4 edition from InterMat was the highest individual since A.J. Kissel was listed fifth at 184 on Nov. 23, 2010.
- Despite falling out of the InterMat rankings this week, Alex Griffin earned his first-ever ranking by Amateur Wrestling News, checking in at No. 20.
- Purdue has five wrestlers included on the Gregg Henry list ... the rankings include 33 individuals at each weight, the same amount of wrestlers selected for the NCAA Championships.
- On Jan. 21, the NCAA released its first of four coaches' panel rankings ... the coaches' rankings are compiled by a vote of coaches representing each qualifying tournament ... in order to be eligible for the rankings, wrestlers must have participated in at least five matches against Division I opponents in the weight class and have wrestled within the last 30 days ... the final rankings will be one of the tools used as part of the selection process to determine the qualifiers for the 2016 NCAA Championships ... the second set of coaches' panel rankings is scheduled to be released Thursday, along with the first RPI.
- When ranked, Purdue wrestlers are 19-9 vs. unranked competition and 6-3 vs. ranked opponents.
- Of the Boilermakers 15 wins vs. ranked competition, five have come from C. Welch ... his 2:25 pin of No. 4 Cooper Moore of Northern Iowa (12/4) stands as the highest ranked opponent a Purdue wrestler has defeated this season ... Danny Sabatello has defeated a trio of ranked foes, including a 15-4 major decision over Nebraska's 17th-ranked Anthony Abidin at Midlands (12/29) ... Griffin and Doug Welch also have a pair of wins over ranked opponents.

• Chad Welch's next pin will earn him a spot on the list ... he has pinned six opponents this season, which is a career best, pushing his career total to 16 ... Drake Stein notched his 16th career fall by pinning Garrett Wesneski of Maryland in 3:14.

Career Takedowns

Michigan State

53rd Ken Kraft Midlands Championships

- Chad Welch became Purdue's second-ever Midlands Championships titlist and the program's first since Dave Gibson in 1963 ... Welch is the third 165-pound Boilermaker to place at Midlands and the first since Luke Manuel's back-to-back eighth-place finishes in 2007 and 2008 ... Welch is the sixth Purdue wrestler to make the Midlands' finals, marking the seventh time a Boilermaker has been in the title match.
- Welch outscored his competition 47-8 in five matches, including points scored in his two pins ... his other wins included one decision, one major decision, one tech and he received one medical forfeit.
- Ben Thornton became Purdue's first 125-pounder to place at Midlands, upsetting 11th-seeded Brandon Jeske of Old Dominion with a 6-4 decision for seventh place ... the seventh-place showing is the sixth overall for the Boilermakers at the tournament ... it's the second tournament placing for Thornton in his redshirt freshman season, he also placed fifth wrestling unattached at the Michigan State Open.

- Ninth-seeded Alex Griffin (149) bounced back from his first loss of the season, a 6-5 decision to the No. 8 seed, Geordan Martinez of Boise State, by shutting out Virginia Tech's third-seeded and 13th-ranked Sal Mastriani with an 8-0 major decision ... it was the second dominating upset of his career ... last year he posted an 8-1 upset of No. 11 Alexander Richardson of Old Dominion in dual action.
- Doug Welch, who was seeded second at 157, advanced to the quarterfinals, but was edged by seventh-seeded Russell Parsons of Army 6-4 ... D. Welch went 2-2 with a fall and a decision.

- The Boilermakers have put 30-or more points on the board in five of their first six duals this season ... the 2006-07 season saw Purdue score 30+ in five duals during the season ... the season with the most duals where the Boilermakers scored 30+ was in 2002-03 with 10.
- The 37-12 win in their first-ever trip to Bloomsburg was the Boilermakers' third straight in the series.

During his 18 years as a Division I wrestling coach, Tony Ersland has played an integral role in developing student-athletes that are accomplished on the mat and nationally recognized. He has had 94 wrestlers qualify for the NCAA Championships, with 28 earning All-America honors and four finishing at the top of the podium. Two of his pupils, Jordan Burroughs and Jake Herbert, earned the highest honor a collegiate grappler can receive in the Dan Hodge Award. Ersland continued to develop

Burroughs on the international stage as he claimed the 2011 and 2013 World titles at 74 kg. In 2012, Burroughs claimed Olympic gold in London.

In his first season at Purdue, Ersland qualified eight to the 2015 NCAA Championships, the most among 13 Division I coaches that were spending their first season at the helm of their respective program. Five of his wrestlers earned a spot on the podium at the B1G Championships. His squad spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Five of his grapplers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Ersland's Boilermakers win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Ersland came to Purdue after serving as an assistant coach at Nebraska for eight seasons. While on staff, the Huskers tallied a 102-41-2 dual record, recorded seven top-20 team finishes at the NCAA Championships and grapplers earned 17 All-America honors.

Prior to his post at Nebraska, Ersland coached the Cyclone Wrestling Club in Ames, Iowa. Ersland worked with Iowa State NCAA champions Trent Paulson (157) and David Zabriskie (285) among other multiple NCAA qualifiers and All-Americans.

His familiarity with the Big Ten extends beyond his time at Nebraska. From 2000-05, Ersland was the head assistant wrestling coach at Northwestern, and he also served as a coach and board member for the Wildcat Wrestling Club.

He was the head assistant wrestling coach at Northern Illinois in 1999 and 2000 after getting his start as a graduate assistant at Central Michigan from 1997 to 1999.

On the mat, Ersland wrestled for the University of Iowa under legendary coach Dan Gable and was a part of three-straight NCAA team championships (1995-97) and four Big Ten Championships (1994-97). During his senior season in 1997, Ersland finished one match shy of All-America honors at 177 pounds.

The Humboldt, Iowa, native excelled in the classroom as a four-time Academic All-Big Ten selection and Board of Control Athletics Award winner, and was bestowed with lowa wrestling's J. Donald McPike Award, given to the senior on the team with the highest grade-point average.

Ersland earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in psychology from Iowa (1997) and a Master of Arts in athletic administration from Central Michigan (1999).

Ersland and his wife, Carolyn, have twin sons, Mason and Jaxon.

During his first season as an assistant coach, Zach Tanelli coached eight Boilermakers to the 2015 NCAA Championships and five to podium finishes at the Big Ten Championships. Purdue spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Individually, five Boilermakers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Purdue win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Tanelli joined the Boilermaker wrestling program after a five-year coaching stint at Hofstra. During his tenure, Tanelli worked his way up the coaching ranks and most recently served as interim head coach. He was the head assistant coach for the two previous seasons after spending his first three years as an assistant coach with the Pride.

The former Badger made an impact throughout Hofstra's lineup, particularly in the lower weights. Tanelli coached four All-Americans in Steve Bonanno (125), Lou Ruggirello (133), Justin Accordino (149) and P.J. Gillespie (165). The Pride won threestraight Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) team titles (2011-13) before moving to the Eastern Intercollegiate Wrestling Association (EIWA) in 2013-14, where they placed fourth with two finalists, including the 165-pound champion, Joseph Booth.

While in the CAA, seven Hofstra grapplers claimed tournament crowns under the guidance of Tanelli, including a pair of two-time champs in Bonanno and 184-pounder Ben Clymer. Jamie Franco (133), Luke Vaith (141), Gillespie (165), Ryan Patrovich (174) and Paul Snyder (HWT) were also titlists for Tanelli.

Tanelli wrestled the first three years of his Badger career at 133 pounds and bumped up to 141 for his senior campaign in 2009. He was a two-time NCAA qualifier at 133 and earned a spot on the 141 podium with a fourth-place finish for All-America accolades. During his senior season, Tanelli went on a blaze, owning a 31-6 record. including a spotless 7-0 mark against Big Ten foes. He was ranked No. 1 at his weight for the second half of the 2008-09 season after winning the 141-pound Midlands Championships title and was bestowed with the Champion of Champions Award.

Tanelli was a three-time Big Ten Championships placewinner and improved upon his finish each year. As a sophomore, he placed eighth at 133, followed by a fifth-place finish as a junior. Tanelli then took second at 141 as a senior.

During his career at Wisconsin, Tanelli compiled an 88-31 record with a blistering .967 winning percentage. He won 44 percent of his matches with bonus points, registering 15 major decisions, 13 falls and 11 technical falls.

A native of Millburn, New Jersey, Tanelli earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology from Wisconsin in 2009 and his master's degree in higher educational leadership and policy studies from Hofstra in 2012.

Tyrel Todd brings a standard of excellence into the Boilermaker wrestling room. The decorated collegiate wrestler with high caliber national and international freestyle experience enters his second season as an assistant coach at Purdue.

During his first season on staff, Todd coached eight Boilermakers to the 2015 NCAA Championships and five to podium finishes at the Big Ten Championships. Purdue spent seven weeks on the USA Today/NWCA

Division I Coaches Poll, finishing the season ranked 23rd. Individually, five Boilermakers were ranked by InterMat during the course of the 2014-15 season, two of which pushed into the top 10 at their respective weight.

The 2014-15 dual season saw Purdue win 10 duals, including six at home and three over ranked teams. The six duals won in Holloway Gymnasium were the most since the 2005-06 season.

Todd came to Purdue after serving as an assistant coach at Cal Poly (2010-11) and Arizona State (2013-14). While on staff at Cal Poly, Todd coached four NCAA qualifiers (141, 157, 165, 197), including a runner-up finish from Borislav Novachkov at 141. The following season Ryan DesRoches earned All-America honors at 174.

In July 2013, Todd was named an assistant coach at Arizona State where he worked hands on daily with the upper-weights, including Blake Staffer, who earned All-America honors at 184 pounds with a third-place finish at the 2015 NCAA Championships. Todd's work at ASU focused on recruiting, coordinating practices, developing training schedules and organizing team travel.

From August 2011 - July 2013, Todd trained alongside his former teammates, while also mentoring and aiding in their individual development, at the Cliff Keen Wrestling Club in Ann Arbor, Michigan. His position allowed him to spend extensive time training alongside the top freestyle wrestlers in the country and to tour and compete in Russia, Chechnya and Ukraine.

A three-time All-American and 2009 Big Ten champion at Michigan, Todd made his mark on the Wolverine program wrestling at 184 and 197 pounds. In his first three seasons at 184, Todd posted an 82-24 record while placing fifth, third and second at the Big Ten Championships and earning as many trips to the NCAA Championships. Todd earned a spot on the podium his sophomore and junior campaigns, placing fifth and third, respectively.

Bumping up to 197 pounds in his final season, Todd registered a 25-3 record en route to a Big Ten title and a fourth-place showing at the NCAA Championships. He finished with a career record of 121-30, with his 121 wins ranking 16th all-time at Michigan. In four NCAA appearances, Todd compiled a 16-7 mark, which ranks seventh in program history. He is also tied for third all-time with a 13-4 career record at the Big Ten Championships.

Todd's pursuit of excellence extended beyond the mat and into the classroom. He was an All-Big Ten Academic selection and Athletic Academic Achievement Award winner in 2006, received the Snip Nalan Scholarship for Wrestling in 2008-09 and was named the team's Distinguished Scholar in 2009.

Todd also found success wrestling freestyle at 84 kg. He took fifth at the 2007 ASICS U.S. National Championships, eighth in 2008 and was seventh in 2011. In 2008, Todd placed fourth at the Olympic Trials, narrowly missing a bid for the Olympic Games in Beijing.

Todd is a native of Bozeman, Mont., and hails from a six-generation dairy farming operation. He received his bachelor's degree in secondary education from Michigan in 2009, majoring in history and minoring in psychology. He and his wife, Loni, have a daughter, Jacy Clair.
