GAME NOTES

- The Boilermakers are now 42-3 all-time in exhibition play, including a 12-0 mark under head coach Sharon Versyp.
- The exhibition victory is the 37th in a row for the Old Gold and Black.
- The Boilermakers are surrendering just 44.7 points per game in 12 exhibition contests under Versyp.
- Marian was held to a 27.8 field goal percentage (15-52) and only nine assists.
- Five Boilermakers scored would-be career-high totals.
- Purdue outrebounded the Knights, 47-23, including 14 offensive rebounds.
- The Boilermakers never lost the lead and held their largest margin at 42 points with 35 seconds left in the game.
- Purdue made 26 points off of the 20 turnovers they forced.
- The Boilermakers scored 42 of their 78 points in the paint (.538), outscoring the Knights down low, 42-16.

GAME HIGHS AND LOWS

- Perry had a double-double with 17 points and 13 rebounds, leading the team in both categories and would have posted a new season/career high in both. This would have been her third career double-double.
- Andreona Keys' 12 points tied her career best and was 6-6 from the free throw line.
- Nora Kiesler made her college debut with 10 points and five rebounds, leading all freshmen.
- Purdue outscored Marian 42-16 in points in the paint.
- April Wilson's nine assists and four steals lead the team. She scored the team's second highest 15 points and played 34 minutes.
- April Wilson had a hand in the 14 straight points Purdue scored to open the third quarter, scoring three baskets and assisting with the other four.
