



NOT REALLY PURE MICHIGAN

- The two Michigan schools have not been kind to Purdue this season and even further back. The Boilermakers have lost four straight games to Michigan and Michigan State.
- Since Feb. 1, 2018, Purdue is 0-4 against the Michigan schools, but 21-7 against all other schools.
- It should be noted that none of the four games vs. the Michigan schools were played in Mackey Arena (three on road; one neutral).

RANKED TEAMS IN MACKEY ARENA

- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 12-2 against nationally-ranked teams in Mackey Arena. The lone losses came to No. 3-ranked Villanova on Nov. 13, 2016 (76-73) and No. 14-ranked Ohio State on Feb. 7, 2018 (64-63).
- Michigan State will be the highest-ranked team to visit Mackey Arena since that Villanova game over two years ago. Purdue's last win over a top-10 team in Mackey Arena came against No. 10-ranked Maryland on Feb. 27, 2016 (83-79).

SHOOTING WINS

- Purdue is 142-15 under Painter when over 48.0 percent shooting, including 6-1 this season. The lone loss came to Virginia Tech (50.8 percent). It was Purdue's first loss when shooting 48-plus percent from the field since a Feb. 2017, loss to Michigan, a streak of 27 straight victories.

ONE OF THE NATION'S TOUGHEST SCHEDULES

- Purdue has played one of the nation's most-difficult schedules to date and could rise even higher thanks to a rigorous Big Ten slate.
- According to ESPN BPI, Purdue's schedule is currently the hardest in the nation. The Boilermakers are followed by Kansas, Penn State, Michigan State, Illinois and Wisconsin, showcasing the Big Ten's strength this year.
- In Big Ten play only, Purdue will face a team that was ranked at the time of the game or ranked in the Dec. 31, poll in eight of its first nine league games.
- Purdue has played 14 teams ranked in the KenPom top 100, posting an 8-6 overall record.
- The strength of schedule has helped Purdue to a No. 10 NET rating. The next closest six-loss team not in the Big Ten is Florida (37th; 11-7).
- During the Painter era, the highest that a schedule has ever been ranked (KenPom) is eighth in 2012; the lowest is 2008 (62nd).

EFFICIENT OFFENSE

- Purdue is one of just three teams to currently boast a top-10 offense in each of the last two seasons.

EFFICIENT OFFENSE, PART TWO

- After ranking No. 2 in last year's offensive efficiency ratings via KenPom.com, Purdue has picked up where it left off last year, ranking sixth midway through this season.
- Purdue is one of five teams to rank in the top 25 of the offensive efficiency ratings in each year since 2015-16.

THE TURNING POINT

- Purdue's turning point may have been the Notre Dame game. The Boilermakers fell 88-80 in Indianapolis and sat with a 6-5 record.
- Since that game, Purdue is 7-1 with the lone loss at Michigan State.

THE POWER OF MACKEY ARENA & THE PAINT CREW

- Mackey Arena has been a special place to play basketball and Sunday's atmosphere should rival anything it has ever seen. Consider the following facts about the nation's loudest basketball arena.
- With the Paint Crew in attendance, Purdue has won 49 of its last 51 games (losses to Villanova in Nov. 2016, and Ohio State in Feb. 2018).
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue's .934 winning percentage (57-4) in Mackey Arena is the second-best home winning percentage in America, behind just Kentucky (.937).
- Purdue is 36-4 at home against Big Ten opponents since the start of the 2014-15 season (losses to Maryland, Iowa, Minnesota, Ohio St.). The record is the best in the Big Ten during that stretch by three games (Michigan State - 33-7).
- Purdue has won 11 straight games in the arena by an average of 19.4 points per game. Just three games have been decided by single-digits during that span (Penn State last year - 3; Ball State - 9; Maryland - 2).
- The arena reached 115.7 decibels in the win over Indiana last Saturday. The reading did not crack the top six (since readings started in 2009-10). The record is 122.3 dB set against Indiana on Feb. 28, 2017 -- equivalent to a chain saw or oxygen torch. The average human pain threshold for sound is 110 dB.

THE CHANGING OF PHILOSOPHIES

- When **Matt Painter** arrived at Purdue in 2005-06, he carried over **Gene Keady's** mantra of "Defense Lives Here". While still a formidable defensive squad, the Boilermakers have become one of the top offensive teams in America over the last few years.
- In Painter's first 10 years at Purdue, the Boilermakers were in the top 25 of offensive efficiency just twice (2010-11, 2011-12). Over the last four years, Purdue has been in the top 25 all four years and its average ranking is 12.8.

► ROAD WARRIORS

- Since the start of the 2007-08 season, Purdue owns a 61-58 record, the third-most wins in the Big Ten during that span. Only four teams (Wisconsin, Michigan State, Ohio State, Purdue) have even won at least 40.0 percent of their road games during that span (not counting Maryland).
- Over the last 12 years, there have been just 10, 8-win road seasons by all the teams in the Big Ten (MSU - 3; Wisc. - 3; Purdue - 2; OSU - 1; Md. - 1).

BOILERS TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

- Despite turning the ball over 18 times against Ohio State, Purdue has taken care of the ball this year, averaging just 11.1 turnovers per game, which would rank as the sixth-lowest average in school history (2012, 2011, 2018, 2010, 1985).
- However, over the last 10 games, Purdue is averaging just 9.4 turnovers per game, while boasting an assist/turnover ratio of 1.61.
- Purdue is 34th nationally in turnover percentage (16.4 percent) and 26th nationally in turnovers per game (11.1).
- Over the last 10 games, Purdue has a plus-5.00 turnover margin.

THE LIMIT IS 60

- Purdue is 138-5 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the five losses came during the 2012-13 season.

THE EXTRA POSSESSION GAME

- During the Painter era, Purdue is 111-9 when committing fewer turnovers and outrebounding its opponents in the same game.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 27-4 when that happens, having won 27 of its last 28 games when doing so (lone loss: Notre Dame).

USUALLY AUTOMATIC

- Purdue is 91-9 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.

CLINE JOINS ELITE DUO

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 308-155 (.665) / 14th year | **Career Record:** 333-160 (.675) / 15th year

- With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 13 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year, the average balloons to 23.8 wins per year over the last 12 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
