GAME NOTES

- The Boilermakers improved to 189-82 all-time in December, including a 99-21 mark in Mackey Arena and a 13-5 record on Dec. 21
- Maine was the 190th opponent in Purdue women's basketball history, and the Boilermakers are now 137-53 all-time in inaugural matchups
- Purdue has held 32 opponents in school history under 40 points, including two this season, and are undefeated when accomplishing the feat
- The Boilermakers held Maine to a season-low 33 points, including single-digit scoring in the first three quarters and single-digit scoring from all 14 players who checked in the game
- Purdue held the Black Bears to 31.3 percent shooting (15-48), including a 1-for-15 clip from 3-point range (.067), which is the second-lowest by a Purdue opponent (with at least 10 attempts) in school history
- The Boilermakers converted 48.1 percent from the floor (26-54), including a 70 percent clip (7-10) in the fourth quarter
- Purdue posted a 36-27 rebounding advantage, but tied a season-low with just six offensive rebounds
- The Boilermaker bench outscored Maine 23-2
- Purdue assisted on 18 of its 26 field goals, while committing 13 turnovers
- Maine's eight personal fouls ties the fewest by a Purdue opponent in school history (last vs. Ohio State, 2/18/08)

HIGHS AND LOWS

- Bridget Perry finished with 10 points, eight rebounds, five assists and three steals, hitting 4-of-7 from the floor
- April Wilson was the only other Boilermaker in double-figures, chipping in 10 points, five assists, four rebounds and a blocked shot
- Torrie Thornton had six points, six rebounds and three assists, shooting a perfect 3-of-3 from the field and committing no turnovers in 17 minutes
- Bree Horrocks had four points and tied a career-high with four rebounds
