• Purdue's final road trip of the Big Ten season doubles as the Boilermakers' biennial trek to Bloomington for a series at Indiana as the rivals meet in the all-important month of May for the third consecutive season.

• Both teams are playing well entering the penultimate weekend of the regular season. The Boilers have won five of their last six dating back to the 20-run outburst in Champaign on April 27. That's their best stretch since also winning five of six from March 12-22. They're 5-1 vs. in-state rivals after rolling past Ball State 14-4 Tuesday.

• A year ago, the Hoosiers scored four times in the ninth inning to steal the rubber game at Alexander Field, becoming the first road team to win a series between the rivals since Purdue took two of three in Bloomington in 2010. The teams also squared off at the Big Ten Tournament for the first time since 2012, with IU scoring eight unanswered runs across the fifth and sixth innings to advance 8-6.

• The Boilermakers are 2-17 at Bart Kaufman Field since the ballpark opened in 2013, a mark that includes two neutral-site games at the 2017 Big Ten Tournament. Seventeen of the 28 meetings in the series since 2013 have been played in Bloomington.

HEAD COACH GREG GOFF

Greg Goff joined Purdue baseball as an assistant coach in July 2017 and was promoted to head coach in June 2019. The 2025 season is his 20th as a collegiate head coach.

Previously a head coach at four universities, Goff succeeded his friend and longtime colleague Mark Wasikowski, who returned to the University of Oregon as the Ducks' new head coach in June 2019.

Goff has previously served as the head coach at Campbell University (2008-14), Louisiana Tech University (2015-16) and the University of Alabama (2017) as well as Division II University of Montevallo (2004-07). He also helped lead the Boilermakers to a memorable 38-win season in 2018, punctuated by the program's third NCAA Regional bid in program history. Purdue finished second in the Big Ten standings and was also the runner-up at the Big Ten Tournament in Goff's first year with the program.

The Boilermakers enjoyed a record-breaking campaign in 2024, eclipsing team records for home runs (75), runs scored (457), runs per game (8.02), RBI (427), on-base percentage (.406) and hit by pitch (113). Purdue's record-breaking 11-game win streak in Big Ten play, the longest in the league since 2018, was another program benchmark and propelled the team into first place in the conference entering the month of May. Purdue returned to the Big Ten Tournament, Luke Gaffney was named the Big Ten Freshman of the Year after coming to Purdue as a recruited walk-on and Team MVP Connor Caskenette was selected in the 12th round by the Miami Marlins.

A national-best 15-0 start, program records for strikeouts and stolen bases, and a return to the Big Ten Tournament highlighted Purdue's resurgent and successful 2022 season. The Boilermakers raced out the best start in program history as the final unbeaten team nationally. Purdue eclipsed its program benchmark in steals behind the first trio of Boilermakers ever with 20-plus steals each. Curtis Washington Jr. (31), Mike Bolton Jr. (28) and Evan Albrecht (22) teamed up to account for 81 of the 116 stolen bases (70%) as Purdue led the Big Ten and ranked sixth nationally in steals per game. Bolton went on to break the program's all-time record, which had stood since 1991, in 2023.

Along with bringing an upbeat personality to the dugout and contagious energy to his role as the first-base coach, Goff helped numerous Boilermakers develop offensively in 2018 and 2019 as an assistant coach. He played a leading role in coaching the base running and outfield defense.

In his first two years at Purdue, Goff helped develop and organize new community events for the program like the Preseason Fan Fest and First Pitch Dinner. Both events have proved very popular and are well attended, helping generate preseason interest going into a campaign.

The Boilermakers also continue to expand their community outreach, exceeding 750 combined hours of service for the 2024 fall semester. The community outreach includes an annual visit to the Riley Hospital for Children in Indianapolis, contributing to Purdue University Dance Marathon's annual 24-hour fundraiser and an on-field team up and family meal with the Tippy Stars, a local special needs sports group.

Goff and his wife, Tina, are the parents of four daughters: Kara, Kiley, Kolby and Kenzie. Kara (LSU, Louisiana Tech) and Kiley (Purdue, Maryland, Louisville) both played collegiate softball.

SIX 40-WIN SEASONS

- As a head coach, Goff's teams have won over 40 games six times. Campbell was one of only eight Division I programs to win 40-plus games for three straight years from 2012 to 2014, posting 131 total victories during that span. The Camels enjoyed a historic 49-10 campaign in 2013.
- He also won 42 games in his final season at Louisiana Tech, helping lead the Bulldogs to an NCAA Regional bid.
- Montevallo was a DII College World Series qualifier in 2006 under his guidance. As an assistant coach at Delta State, the Statesmen also qualified for the DII College World Series in 1994 and 1996.

ENDED NCAA REGIONAL DROUGHTS AT CAMPBELL & LOUISIANA TECH

- In Goff's final season at Campbell (2014), the Camels qualified for their first NCAA Regional in 24 years. Two years later, he led Louisiana Tech to its first Regional bid in 29 years. The 2014 Camels and 2016 Bulldogs both won at least one game in their Regionals, with La Tech coming through the loser's bracket to reach a Regional final at Mississippi State.

HISTORY OF TURNAROUNDS

- Goff's teams have had a losing record only five times in his 14 years as a head coach. Four of those five seasons were his first at a respective university. He has led his teams to some impressive turnarounds.
- In just two seasons, Louisiana Tech went from 15-35 the year before Goff's arrival to 42-20 in 2016, ending a 29-year NCAA Regional drought in the process. At Campbell, he inherited a team that was 11-45 in 2007. But under Goff, the Camels posted a winning record (27-24) in his second season and won 40 games by his fifth year (2012).
- Purdue's win total also jumped from 29-27 in 2017 to 38-21 in Goff's first year on the staff in 2018.

COACHING HONORS

- Goff was named the South Central Region Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association at both Louisiana Tech (2016) and Montevallo (2006). He was the 2013 Big South Coach of the Year at Campbell after leading his team to a school-record 49 wins and a conference title. Montevallo won a combined 100 games over his final two seasons, posting a new single-season record both years.

BEFORE BECOMING A HEAD COACH

- Goff has coached 10 future big leaguers and over 50 MLB Draft picks, highlighted by Cy Young award winner Brandon Webb while he was the pitching coach at Kentucky (2000-03). Longtime big leaguer and World Series champion Joe Blanton also pitched for Goff at Kentucky.
- Along with his years as the pitching coach at Kentucky, Goff served as an assistant at Southeast Missouri State (1998-99) and his alma mater Delta State (1994-97) before becoming a head coach for the first time in the summer of 2003 at Montevallo. It was at SEMO in the late 1990s where he first worked with Wasikowski. They helped lead the Redhawks to an NCAA Regional in 1998.

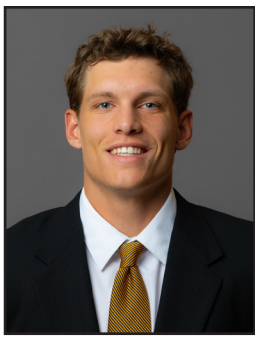

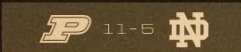

NOTABLES FROM THE FIRST HALF OF THE SEASON

- Purdue was the first team in the Big Ten to reach 20 victories, winning its 20th game on March 25 as the earliest date on the calendar the program had ever reached the benchmark.
- The Boilermakers opened the season on a 10-game win streak, finally suffering their first loss on March 1 in the nightcap of a doubleheader vs. Akron. The game went 11 innings. Purdue trailed 9-6 entering the bottom of the seventh but tied the game in thrilling fashion with three consecutive home runs from **Aaron Manias**, **Sergio DeCello** and **Brandon Rogers**. It marked the third time since 2021 Purdue hit three homers in an inning. Manias and Rogers both connected for their first home runs as Boilermakers and DeCello became the first Purdue player to homer in both games of a doubleheader since March 2022.
- The Boilermakers did not suffer their first set of consecutive losses until the final weekend of March (March 28-29), marking the latest on the calendar that had occurred in program history.
- However, after winning its first five home games, Purdue dropped five of the final six games of its season-long 12-game homestand. During that stretch, the Boilers lost 13-12 to UCLA and 2-1 to Northern Illinois. The 12 runs were the most in a loss since April 2013 at Illinois and the 2-1 defeat marked the lowest-scoring game at Alexander Field since Minnesota also won in 2-1 fashion on the final day of the 2021 season.
- **Logan Sutter** went 6-for-6 with 12 total bases in a Feb. 22 win, becoming the first Boilermaker ever with a six-hit game. He became the fastest Boilermaker (by date on the calendar) to record 20, 30 and 40 RBI as well as 10 doubles. He's the only Boilermaker this century to homer in seven consecutive weekends. His go-ahead grand slam in the eighth inning of the March 15 win vs. UIC was Purdue's fourth grand slam over the first five weekends.
- **Lukas Cook** did not open the season as the starting shortstop but quickly played his way into the lineup. He missed the 2024 season due to Tommy John Surgery. His team-high 15 multi-hit games (including 8 with at least 3 hits) have helped him take the Big Ten lead in batting average (.441 as of April 10). He's done it with a mature all-fields and base-hit approach after batting just .135 (7-for-52) in 2023. Two of those seven hits in 2023 were home runs, including a 10th-inning walk-off in a rubber game win vs. Northwestern in Purdue's first home weekend. Thirty-eight of Cook's 49 hits this season have been singles but he did hit a big home run – a go-ahead blast into the right field bullpen in the eighth inning of Purdue's 9-6 win vs. Michigan on March 22.
- **Lukas Cook** surged to the top of the Big Ten leaders in batting average thanks to a 10-for-14 weekend at the plate vs. UCLA. It is believed to be the first 10-hit showing in a three-game weekend series by a Boilermaker in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present). He also recorded hits in his first two at-bats in the next game vs. Northern Illinois, making him 12-for-16 over a stretch of 3 ½ games. Cook finished Purdue's 12-game homestand with a .490/.534/.633 slash line over 49 at-bats and did not commit an error defensively while seeing action at shortstop and second base.
- **Lukas Cook** (.463) and **Logan Sutter** (.409) entered the Washington series (April 4-6) both ranked among the top five in the Big Ten in batting average. They became just the third and fourth Boilermakers of the BBCOR bat era (2011-present) to enter the month of April batting .400 or better. Evan Albrecht (.409) did it in 2022 and Kevin Plawecki (.402) in 2011.
- **Carter Doorn** became the first four-year senior to start on Opening Day since 2021, making his first career weekend start in the process. He was Purdue's first pitcher to make his first Opening Day start as a senior since it happened three years in a row from 2011-13. Doorn enjoyed a streak of 22 consecutive innings without allowing an earned from over five straight starts, entering the weekend of March 21-23 leading the Big Ten with a 0.36 ERA.
- **Avery Cook** earned the save in both games of Purdue's season-opening doubleheader, becoming just the second Boilermaker since the start of the 2019 campaign to achieve the feat (also happened in April 2023). Cook was not charged with a run until March 28, opening the season with 14 consecutive scoreless innings over 11 appearances. He is the longest-tenured Boilermaker, joining the program in the fall of 2020. He missed the 2022 season due to Tommy John Surgery and converted to a sidearm delivery in the fall of 2023. With 10 career saves (5 this season), he's become the ninth Boilermaker to post a double-figure total.
- **Logan Sutter** and **Aaron Manias** both earned Big Ten Player of the Week honors over the first four weeks of the season, giving the Boilermakers a pair of honorees for the first time since 2018. Sutter was recognized after going 8-for-14 with 4 XBH and 8 RBI vs. Stephen F. Austin during the season-opening four-game sweep. Manias caught fire (9-for-17, 6 XBH, 13 RBI) during Purdue's first week of games in the Midwest (March 4-9), helping the Boilermakers win at Indiana State for the first time since April 2018 and take two of three vs. Minnesota – Purdue's fourth straight series win in Minneapolis – inside U.S. Bank Stadium to open Big Ten play.
- While batting leadoff in every game, **Albert Choi** reached base safely in his first 26 games as a Boilermaker. He opened the UCLA series with a leadoff home run. All-Big Ten outfielder and longtime leadoff man Mike Bolton Jr. hit a game-opening home run in consecutive weekends in April of last season. But prior to that, Purdue had gone without a leadoff home run since May 2017.
- **Brandon Rogers** was an Opening Day starter in center field but then started just one game prior to the March 12 home opener. He did play in each of the first 16 games – primarily as a pinch hitter/runner/defensive replacement. The Arizona transfer is Purdue's best defensive outfielder and with center field at Alexander Field measuring 408 feet, he was inserted back into the lineup when the home season (and a 12-game homestand) began. Rogers' all-around play earned him a full-time starting role in the process. He posted a .395/.465/.553 slash line while also stealing 9 bases during the homestand. Defensively he made a few highlight-reel catches, none bigger than robbing Michigan's top hitter (Mitch Voit) of a two-out RBI single with the game tied in the sixth inning of game 2 of the series. Purdue went on to win the game 9-6.
