THE OPENING TIP

- After a big win over No. 20-ranked Ohio State on Wednesday, Purdue looks to keep the momentum going in its final non-conference game of the season, coming against Notre Dame in the Crossroads Classic in Indianapolis.
- Purdue is looking to sustain its success in its final Big Ten tuneup entering a difficult stretch. Purdue's next five opponents are Notre Dame (2-3), Iowa (6-0), Maryland (4-2), Rutgers (5-0) and Illinois (5-2) with four of the games coming away from Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers have won two straight and are looking to avenge two previous losses this year (Clemson, Miami) to ACC foes.

THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- Purdue is 2-7 in the Crossroads Classic and looking for its second win against Notre Dame (1-3) in the event.
- Head coach **Matt Painter** won his 50th game against a nationally-ranked team on Wednesday against Ohio State. He is 50-83 against ranked teams, including a 20-19 record since the start of the 2016-17 season. Of his 50 wins against ranked teams, 20 have come in the last 4+ seasons.
- According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 299th in experience (1.11 years). Indiana is the next least-experienced team in the Big Ten (1.26).
- In its five wins, Purdue is shooting 50.4 percent from the field and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.36 (98 / 72). In its two losses, Purdue is shooting just 39.8 percent from the field, has attempted 21 free throws and has an assist-to-turnover ratio of 0.61 (22 / 36).
- Purdue's junior class is averaging 55.5 points per game over the last two games, accounting for 75.5 percent of Purdue's scoring.
- Trevion Williams** is averaging 23.5 points, 10.0 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game over the last two games, shooting 19-of-30 (.633) from the field.
- Purdue is 32-7 (.821) in the month of December since the 2015-16 season.
- Purdue has outscored every team in the paint except one (Miami) this season. Purdue is averaging 32.3 points in the paint.
- Purdue has held its opponents to just 48 offensive rebounds (6.9 per game), resulting in 32 second-chance points (4.6 per game).
- Over the last five games, opponents are shooting just 25-of-110 (.227) from long distance. No opponent has made more than eight triples.
- Purdue is 44-1 since the start of the 2017-18 season when shooting at least 48 percent from the field (Virginia; 2019 Elite Eight).
- Purdue has won 102 straight games when scoring at least 90 points, spanning over 33 years (last loss: Nov. 24, 1987, to Iowa State).
- Sasha Stefanovic** has made at least four 3-pointers nine times during his career. Purdue is 7-2 when he reaches that mark.
- When **Eric Hunter Jr.** leads the team in assists during his career, Purdue is 11-3; when **Aaron Wheeler** scores 10+ points, Purdue is 9-1.

- This marks just the sixth meeting in the last 50 years despite the two teams being just 110 miles away from each other. The two squads met in the 2004 NIT and then four previous Crossroads Classics.
- Purdue is just 1-4 against the Irish in the last 50+ years, winning the 2016 Crossroads Classic, 86-81.

- After playing Ohio State on Wednesday, the team that had the fifth-best winning percentage against Purdue, the Boilermakers look to narrow the gap against the team that has the fourth-best winning percentage against them.

- Purdue enters the Crossroads Classic with a 5-2 record with both losses coming to ACC opponents (Clemson, Miami). The Boilermakers lost the first two games against ACC opponents in Florida and hope a change of venue to get the Boilermakers back on track vs. the ACC.
- Purdue pieced together one of its best performances of the season in Wednesday's 67-60 win over No. 20-ranked Ohio State. The Boilermakers held the Buckeyes to 29.0 percent from the field in the second half and Purdue placed four players in double figures to earn the Big Ten-opening victory.
- The Boilermakers have six players averaging at least 8.0 points per game and are outrebounding foes by almost 10 rebounds per outing. Turnovers have been the killer for the Boilermakers, averaging 15.4 miscues per contest.

- Purdue enters Indiana's premier basketball showcase with a 2-7 overall record in the event, having lost two straight games by a combined 17 points.
- The Boilermakers started the event 0-5, then won two straight against Notre Dame in 2016 (86-91) and Butler in 2017 (82-67). Both were significant wins for Purdue in that the Boilermakers overcame a 17-point deficit against Notre Dame in 2016, then defeated Butler for the first of two wins against the Bulldogs during the 2017-18 season, also defeating Butler in the NCAA Tournament second round.
- It can be stated that despite Purdue's struggles in the event, the 2018 loss to Notre Dame turned around the season. The Boilermakers were 6-5 after the loss and left for Christmas to do some soul-searching. Purdue came back and went 20-5 after that setback, winning the Big Ten title and reaching the Elite Eight.

- With the win over Ohio State on Wednesday, head coach Matt Painter has now won 50 games over ranked teams while at Purdue. His record is 50-83 (.376) during his career at Purdue against ranked teams, but since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue is 20-19 in such games.
- Purdue is ninth nationally with 20 ranked wins over the last five years.

- Head coach **Matt Painter** has had a lot of great freshmen come through the ranks, but the performance by this group of freshmen in their first career games may be unmatched.
- The group scored **44 points** in the season opener against Liberty, producing the most points for a freshman class at Purdue since March 20, 2013, vs. Western Illinois (46), and the eighth-most points scored by a freshman class under Painter.
- It then followed it up with **44 more points** against Oakland, just two games later.

- Through seven games, Purdue's freshman class has accounted for 206 (29.4 PPG) of the team's 509 points (40.5 percent). It has accounted for over 50.0 percent of the team's scoring in three of Purdue's seven games (Liberty, Clemson, Miami).
- The group has played 478 minutes (39.8 percent).
- The group has shot a combined 79-of-153 (.516) from the field. The remainder of the team is 106-of-239 (.444) from the field.
- The quartet of **Zach Edey** (3rd), **Brandon Newman** (6th), **Jaden Ivey** (9th) and **Mason Gillis** (14th) all rank in the top 14 among Big Ten freshmen in scoring. The duo of Newman (2nd) and Gillis (5th) are among the top five in 3-pointers made. **Ethan Morton** (2nd), Newman (3rd) and Gillis (7th) are among the top seven in assists.

- **Trevion Williams** has had a slow start to the season, but if the last two games are any indication, the junior big man might be ready to break out again.
- In the win over Indiana State last Saturday, Williams came off the bench to score 30 points, grab 11 rebounds and dish out two assists on 13-of-18 shooting from the field. He is just one of three players nationally to reach those marks this season.

- Among current players, Williams' two career 30-point, 10-rebound, 2-assist games are tied for the most nationally.
- Then in the win over Ohio State, he became the first Purdue player since **Brad Miller** (23, 10 & 8) vs. Michigan on March 8, 1998, to have at least 16 points, nine rebounds and eight assists in the same game. So far this year, he is one of five players nationally to reach those marks.

EDEY MAKES INSTANT IMPACT

- **Zach Edey** has had a strong start to the season, which is somewhat surprising given his story.
- He's played basketball for about three years after playing hockey and baseball in Canada and spending last year at powerhouse IMG Academy in Florida, averaging about five points per game.
- He was ranked No. 429 among high school seniors a year ago and the 94th-ranked center in America.
- Edey's 19 points in the season opener was the third most for a true freshman in the season opener in school history.

SPECIAL MEANING

- **Jaden Ivey** grew up in the shadows of Notre Dame and will now be competing against the team for the first time. His nother, **Niele Ivey**, is the head coach of Notre Dame Women's Basketball team and his father is **Javin Hunter**, a former standout on the Irish football team who was drafted by the Baltimore Ravens in 2002.
- Jaden and Niele are part of four duos nationally to have a student-athlete's mother serve as a Division-I head coach. The Iveys are the only pair to both be in the Power-5 conferences.

BOILER NOTES

- Purdue will take a seven-game non-conference home winning streak into next season after posting a 3-0 record this season.
- With the win over Indiana State, Purdue is now 15-2 (losses to Notre Dame & Butler) against in-state opponents since the start of the 2016-17 season.
- Purdue has shot at least 55.0 percent from the field in three games already this year; last season, it shot 55.0 percent just twice all season.
- Purdue is just 22-of-84 (.262) from long distance over the last four games. In the first three games, Purdue was 35-of-71 (.493) from deep.
- Purdue has shot 13 or fewer free throws in five of seven games this season (Oakland - 37; Indiana State - 24).
- Purdue is 114-13 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- Purdue has had at least 16 turnovers in four of seven games this season.
- Purdue is 156-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season. One of the losses came to Miami last Tuesday in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge. Conversely, the Boilermakers are 12-55 when scoring 59 or fewer points.
- Purdue is 35-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game. Under Painter, Purdue is 80-17 overall, having won six straight games.
- Purdue has won 102 straight games and is 40-0 under Coach Painter when scoring 90 or more points.
- Purdue hasn't lost when scoring 90 points since Nov. 24, 1987 (104-96 vs. Iowa State), a span of 12,080 days.
- Purdue is 124-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 38-2 (losses to Notre Dame and Virginia Tech in 2018-19 season) since the start of 2017-18.

• Purdue is 129-13 under Painter when winning the rebound and turnover battles in the same game.

- Purdue is 159-16 under Painter when shooting at least 48 percent from the field. Since the start of the 2017-18 season, Purdue is 44-1 when doing so, losing to Virginia in the 2019 Elite Eight. Purdue has won 10 straight games when shooting at least 48 percent from the field.
- Purdue has won 11 straight games when wearing its gold uniforms, dating to a New Year's Day loss vs. Minnesota in 2017.
- Purdue has held five straight teams to 0.94 points / possession or less (Oakland - 0.78; Valparaiso - 0.88; Miami - 0.88; Indiana State - 0.94; Ohio State - 0.90).
- Currently, **Trevion Williams** (13.7 PPG, 10.1 RPG) is one of 11 players nationally that have played at least six games this year and average a double-double. Williams and Michigan State's **Joey Hauser** (13.3 PPG, 10.0 RPG) are the only Big Ten players to average a double-double.
- **Zach Edey** ranks ninth nationally in fouls drawn / 40 minutes (8.8).
- Among Power-6 (Big Ten, ACC, SEC, PAC-12, Big East, Big 12) programs, Purdue has the fifth-best home winning percentage since the start of the 2014-15 season.

- The "4" position was a question mark entering the season, but **Aaron Wheeler** and **Mason Gillis** have combined to average 10.6 points, 8.7 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game while splitting time there (46.3 field goal pct.).
- Four of Purdue's five freshmen are shooting at least 46 percent from the field.
- **Brandon Newman** is one of six freshmen nationally to make at shoot at least 44.0 percent from long distance, make 10 3-pointers and average at least 2.0 assists per game.
- Purdue has 21 dunks this season in just seven games (3.00 per game). Last year, in 31 games, it finished with 45 dunks (1.45 per game).
- Purdue is among the cream of the crop in the Big Ten, posting the Big Ten's second-best record over the last six-plus years (Michigan State 81-31; **Purdue 79-34**; Wisconsin 75-37; Maryland 72-41).
- The Boilermakers will have 10 underclassmen (sophomore or younger), will have the fewest amount of upperclassmen (5) in the Big Ten and will be the only league team to have fewer than two seniors on its roster, sporting a grand total of **ZERO** seniors on its roster. The only high-major programs with zero seniors on its rosters are Auburn and Florida.
- Purdue is the only Big Ten school and one of four schools nationally (Kansas, Duke, Gonzaga) to rank in KenPom.com's final top 25 in each of the last five years.
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, 28 of Purdue's 129 wins have come by 30 or more points, the third-highest total nationally (Gonzaga - 52; Duke - 30; **Purdue - 28**).
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, 45 of Purdue's 129 wins have come by 20 or more points, the fifth-most nationally (Gonzaga - 86; Duke - 55; Villanova - 53; **Purdue & Michigan State - 52**).
- With the addition of freshman **Zach Edey** to the roster, Purdue has had a 7-footer on the roster for nine straight years. If Edey stays all four years, that streak will extend to 12 years.
- Florida State is the only program in America to have a longer 7-footer streak, as this will mark the 14th straight year with a 7-footer for the Seminoles.

► **Record at Purdue:** 342-176 (.660) / 16th year | **Career Record:** 367-181 (.670) / 17th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 16th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2020-21 season third on the school's all-time wins list (337) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 15 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 14 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 16 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.1 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just four active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 14 years are the eighth most in the country.
