# **#BOILERNOTES**

The Boilermakers enter the final game of their early-season homestand at a flawless 3-0 after defeating Western Illinois at Mackey Arena on Thursday 81-60. Sophomores Karissa McLaughlin and Tamara Farguhar led the way for the Old Gold & Black as McLaughlin had 22 points, five rebounds and five assists, while Farquhar tallied a careerhigh 12 points, seven rebounds and three steals. Junior Ae'Rianna Harris added her second straight double-double, posting 10 points, 11 rebounds and four blocked shots.

Purdue continues to be led by the three-headed monster of McLaughlin, Harris and junior Dominique Oden, who are averaging a combined 45.7 points per game, and have each led the team in scoring once. McLaughlin is adding 5.0 assists per game, Harris is chipping in 11.0 rebounds and 2.7 blocked shots and Oden is contributing 3.0 steals, 3.0 rebounds and is shooting 51.5 percent form the floor. Farguhar and sophomore Lindsey Whilby are doing damage at the "trigger" position for the Boilermakers as well, averaging a combined 15.3 points, 13.4 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game.

Purdue Fort Wayne comes to Mackey at 2-2 after a 72-63 loss at Eastern Illinois on Thursday. Senior De'Jour Young paces the Mastadons at 15.8 points per game, while sophomore Kierstyn Repp adds 11.5 points.

# **TEAM NOTES**

- Purdue is in its 44th season of women's basketball, holding a 846-466 all-time record
- The Boilermakers opened the season on the road for the third straight season and the fourth time in the last five years, earning an 80-38 win at Ball State
- Purdue is now 36-8 all-time in season openers, including a 9-6 record on the road and a 12-1 mark under Versyp
- The win was the fifth-largest road win in program history and the biggest since a 43-point win at Butler in 2006
- The opener is the 36th time Purdue has held an opponent under 40 points, remaining undefeated all-time when doing so, and the 44th time the Boilermakers have beat a team by 40 points or more
- Purdue pulled down 51 rebounds, it's most in the last two seasons, and the Boilermakers' 24 offensive boards were their most since securing 25 vs. Northwestern in 2014
- The Boilermaker bench chipped in 33 points at Ball State, its highest mark since adding 54 points vs. Incarnate Word in 2015, and followed with 28 points vs. Western Illinois, putting the season average at 23.0 bench points per game
- Purdue had 16 steals against Ball State, its most since Nov. 28, 2012 vs. Georgia Tech in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge
- The Boilermakers are now 42-2 all-time in home openers, including a 12-1 mark under Versyp
- Sunday's one-point win over Harvard marked Purdue's first since a 74-73 win over Iowa in 2014
- After shooting 55 percent at the free throw line in the opener, the Boilermakers have made 33-of-37 (.892) in the last two games
- The Crimson were the first of three inaugural opponents on the Purdue schedule this season, and the Boilermakers are now 143-54 all-time in first-ever meetings
- Purdue is averaging 18.0 offensive rebounds per game, converting them into an average of 17.0 second chance points
- The Boilermakers are outscoring opponents by 22 and 25 points in the second and third quarters, respectively, this season
- Purdue owns an active streak of 29 consecutive wins when leading after three quarters, including a 17-0 mark last season, and last surrendered a fourth-quarter lead on Jan. 15, 2017 to 11th-ranked Ohio State
- The Boilermakers' four returning starters marks their most since the 2011-12 season, when they returned four as well With Ae'Rianna Harris and Dominique Oden earning Preseason All-Big Ten honors from the coaches and media, Purdue is one-of-two schools to have two players on both teams (lowa)

# **LAST TIME OUT**

- Purdue improved to 3-0 for the 22nd time in program history with an 81-60 win over Western Illinois
- The Boilermakers are now 8-0 all-time against the Leathernecks and are 19-0 all-time against The Summit League
- Purdue dished out a season-high 21 assists, its most since 28 against Penn State on Jan. 28, 2018
- The Boilermakers had three different players with at least five assists, including career-high marks for Cassidy Hardin and Kayana Traylor, and the roster now boasts a 20-3 alltime record when an individual dishes at least five helpers

# **HEAD COACH SHARON VERSYP**

- In her 13th season on the Boilermaker sidelines, Versyp now has the longest tenure of any coach in program history
- She is the winningest coach in program history, owning 260 victories at Purdue
- Has nine 20-win campaigns in 12 seasons with the Boilermakers, and has won at least 20 games in 12 of 18 career seasons as a head coach
- Versyp is tied with Lin Dunn for the Boilermakers' career Big Ten Conference wins mark at 120 heading into 2018-19
- Her 129 career Big Ten wins are ranked eighth in conference history, are third-most among active coaches and are seven wins shy of moving up to fifth all-time (136,

Jim Foster, Ohio State)

- Her 22 career Big Ten Tournament victories are an event record, breaking the previous mark (shared by Jim Foster and Rene Portland) with Purdue's 2017 quarterfinal win over Indiana
- She's led the Boilermakers to the Big Ten Tournament championship game six times in 12 seasons (four titles)
- Versyp has guided Purdue to a program-record nine NCAA Tournament appearances in 12 seasons
- The Boilermakers are 1-of-25 schools to make at least nine tournaments over Versyp's tenure as head coach, and 1-of-5 schools in the Big Ten Conference

## **#1 KARISSA MCLAUGHLIN**

- Poured in a season-high 22 points vs. Western Illinois, hitting on 6-of-12 from the field, 4-of-7 from distance and 6-of-6 at the free throw line
- Has back-to-back games with at least five assists, improving her squad's record to 14-2 when she hits the mark
- Has a pair of games with at least four 3-pointers this season (Ball State, Western Illinois), now owning seven career games with at least four
- One-of-79 players in the nation to remain perfect at the free throw line so far this season
- Earned 2018 Big Ten All-Freshman Team honors, becoming 10th player in Purdue history, fifth under Versyp and first Boilermaker since 2013
