#### THE OPENING TIP

- Purdue (10-7, 3-3) looks for a significant road win Saturday as the Boilermakers visit No. 17-ranked Maryland (13-4, 3-3) in College Park. Jason Benetti and Dan Dakich will handle the broadcast on ESPN2, beginning at 2 p.m. ET. On the radio, Rob Blackman and Larry Clisby will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 1 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on PurdueSports.com.
- Purdue owns a 5-3 series lead in a rivalry that dates all the way back to 2015. The two teams never met before the Terrapins joined the Big Ten before the 2014-15 season.
- Purdue is looking for its first Big Ten road win of the season, having already fallen to Nebraska, Illinois and Michigan.
- Maryland enters the contest unbeaten at the XFinity Center with a 10-0 record. In fact, Purdue's next two road games come against teams with a combined home record of 22-0 (Rutgers on Jan. 28).
- SOMETHING TO WATCH: Purdue is looking for its first road win against a nationally-ranked team since Feb. 4, 2017, against Maryland -- a span of six games. A freshman named **Carsen Edwards** made two free throws with 2.1 seconds left to give Purdue a 73-72 decision.

- Purdue is 8-0 this year when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. The Boilermakers are 2-6 when allowing 60-plus.
- Purdue is 9-0 this year and 29-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The lone loss came to Virginia in last year's Elite Eight.

#### **HEATING UP JANUARY**

- Once the calendar turns to a new year, the Boilermakers tend to really heat up. Purdue is 18-3 during the month of January since 2018, with the losses coming at Michigan State on Jan. 8, 2019, and this year's losses to Illinois and Michigan.
- Since the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 34-12 in the month of January.

#### ANYONE, ANYWHERE

- Purdue and Illinois are the only Big Ten teams to play a road game at a team outside the "Power-6" conferences, when the Boilermakers traveled to Ohio on Dec. 17.
- Illinois played at Grand Canyon on Nov. 8.

### **#TRENDING**

- Matt Painter will coach his 500th game at Purdue on Jan. 24, 2020, vs. Wisconsin.
- Purdue is 154-16 under Matt Painter when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the field.
- Purdue is 33-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game.
- Purdue is 29-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher percentage from the field than its opponent. The lone loss was to Virginia in the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Purdue is 26-4 when Matt Haarms scores in double figures.
- Purdue is 109-10 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponent, including 24-3 since the start last season.
- Purdue is 121-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 35-2 since the start of 2017-18.

#### **SELLING OUT THE SEASON**

- Now in its 53rd season of calling Mackey Arena its home, Purdue is close to doing something only done eight previous times — selling out every game.
- Purdue has announced sellouts for all of its game this year with merely single tickets remaining for Penn State and Rutgers. A grand total of about 60 tickets remain for the season.
- Purdue has sold out Mackey Arena in the following seasons: 1969-70, 1986-87, 1988-89, 1992-93, 1993-94, 1994-95, 1997-98 and 1998-99.
- This year's average attendance will set a school record for the second straight season (14,467 a year ago).

- Purdue has sold out 17 straight games dating to last year, the longest streak since 39 straight games from Jan. 7, 1997, to Feb. 28, 1999.
- It will likely end the year with 24 straight sellouts entering the 2020-21 season

#### NEWEST MEMBER OF THE CENTURY CLUB

• Matt Painter won his 100th Big Ten game at home in Purdue's 83-78 victory over Minnesota. He now owns a 101-27 (.789) record at home against Big Ten opposition.

#### TREVION WITH A HISTORIC NIGHT AGAINST MICHIGAN

- Trevion Williams came to Purdue in part because of the success that former All-American Caleb Swanigan had in West Lafayette. Having a similar build and wearing No. 50, Williams made his mark in a big way Thursday vs. Michigan.
- Williams posted career highs of 36 points and 20 rebounds and nearly willed the Boilermakers to an upset of the Wolverines in a doubleovertime setback.
- Williams became Purdue's first 35-20 player since **Bob Ford** (36 & 20) against Minnesota on Jan. 16, 1971 -- a span of 17,891 days.

- · With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season.
