THE OPENING TIP

Purdue (10-7, 3-3) looks for a significant road win Saturday as the Boilermakers visit No. 17-ranked Maryland (13-4, 3-3) in College Park. Jason Benetti and Dan Dakich will handle the broadcast on ESPN2, beginning at 2 p.m. ET. On the radio, Rob Blackman and Larry Clisby will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 1 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on PurdueSports.com.

Purdue owns a 5-3 series lead in a rivalry that dates all the way back to 2015. The two teams never met before the Terrapins joined the Big Ten before the 2014-15 season.

Purdue is looking for its first Big Ten road win of the season, having already fallen to Nebraska, Illinois and Michigan.

Maryland enters the contest unbeaten at the Xfinity Center with a 10-0 record. In fact, Purdue's next two road games come against teams with a combined home record of 22-0 (Rutgers on Jan. 28).

SOMETHING TO WATCH: Purdue is looking for its first road win against a nationally-ranked team since Feb. 4, 2017, against Maryland -- a span of six games. A freshman named Carsen Edwards made two free throws with 2.1 seconds left to give Purdue a 73-72 decision.

Purdue's sophomore class has started to emerge as offensive leaders. The class is averaging 42.3 points per game over the last four games, accounting for 62.8 percent of Purdue's scoring during that span.

Eric Hunter Jr. and Sasha Stefanovic are two of the Big Ten's most improved scorers this year.

Purdue has now scored 70-plus points in four of the last five games. In the season's first 12 games, it reached 70 points just three times.

Purdue has held five opponents to 49 or fewer points this year, the third-highest total in the country (Liberty, Virginia - 9).

Purdue is 8-0 this year when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. The Boilermakers are 2-6 when allowing 60-plus.

Purdue is 9-0 this year and 29-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The lone loss came to Virginia in last year's Elite Eight.

BIG WINS OVER RANKED TEAMS

- The win over Michigan State tied for Purdue's largest ever against a nationally-ranked team. Four of the six largest margins have come in the last 26 months.

TREVION WITH A HISTORIC NIGHT AGAINST MICHIGAN

- **Trevion Williams** came to Purdue in part because of the success that former All-American **Caleb Swanigan** had in West Lafayette. Having a similar build and wearing No. 50, Williams made his mark in a big way Thursday vs. Michigan.

- Williams posted career highs of 36 points and 20 rebounds and nearly willed the Boilermakers to an upset of the Wolverines in a double-overtime setback.

- Williams became Purdue's first 35-20 player since **Bob Ford** (36 & 20) against Minnesota on Jan. 16, 1971 -- a span of 17,891 days.

- Williams became the sixth player nationally (and first player this year) since the 2010-11 season to post a game of 35 points, 20 rebounds and two assists. He is the only player to do so with zero turnovers in the same game. In addition, Williams and Daum (5 blocks) were the only ones to add a block to their statline.

THE UNICORN

- We know this is high-level stat manipulation, but **Matt Haarms** became just the second high-major conference player this year to have at least 26 points, nine rebounds, three assists and a block in the same game, doing so vs. Minnesota.

BIG MAN THAT CAN DO IT ALL

- At 7-feet, 3-inches, **Matt Haarms** is one of the most-unique players in America with his ability to step out and hit the 3-pointer. He is one of four players in America to shoot at least 57.0 percent from the field, block 30 shots and make at least seven 3-pointers.

UNDERCLASSMEN PICK UP THE SLACK

- Purdue's freshmen and sophomores are starting to show that Purdue will become a force this year and beyond.
- The two classes have scored 704 of Purdue's 1,172 points this season, accounting for 60.1 percent of Purdue's scoring.
- Over the last seven games, the group has scored 298 of Purdue's 427 points, or 69.8 percent of the points.

GOING THE EXTRA MINUTE

- Purdue has now played a pair of double-overtime games in its last three contests, the second time in school history it has played two double-overtime games in a three-game span.

- Coincidentally, the last two opponents that Purdue has gone to overtime with (Minnesota and Michigan) are the two-most frequently-played overtime opponents in series history. Purdue and Minnesota have played 11 overtime games, while Purdue and Michigan have played 10.

- Purdue's three overtime games already are tied for the third most in a season in school history (1974 - 5; 2019 - 4). Purdue has played seven overtime games in its last 52 games since the start of last year.

THE SERBIAN SHARPSHOOTER

- **Sasha Stefanovic** has had several big games, being one of two players in the Big Ten this year to have made at least five 3-pointers in a game three times. Minnesota's **Gabe Kalscheur** is the other.

MORE ON STEFANOVIC'S STORY

- **Sasha Stefanovic** has had quite a story to get where he is today. As a high school senior at Crown Point High School (Crown Point, Ind.), he visited Purdue on Feb. 1, 2017, for the Boilermakers' game vs. Northwestern, where he received an offer.
- Prior to that point, his offers had been from Valparaiso, Evansville, Northern Iowa and Loyola. However, he was holding out hope for the Purdue offer, not committing in the early period and waiting for Purdue. On Feb. 3, 2017, he committed to Purdue, just two days later.
- After a redshirt season in 2017-18, he played in every game last year, averaging 2.5 points per game. He has worked himself into the starting lineup and is a big factor in Purdue's perimeter attack.

A DEEPER LOOK

- In five games against ranked teams, **Trevion Williams** is averaging 16.0 points and 10.2 rebounds per game.
- During the last three games, **Trevion Williams** is averaging 19.3 points and 11.3 rebounds per game while shooting 54.3 percent (26 of 49) from the field.
- In three Big Ten road games, **Trevion Williams** averages 20.0 points and 14.3 rebounds per game in just 28.3 minutes per contest.
- Purdue is shooting 39.2 percent from 3-point range against four ranked opponents, while holding its foes to 21.9 percent from deep.

CLOSING OUT THE DECADE

- Purdue had a pretty nice decade from Jan. 1, 2010, to Dec. 31, 2019. Here is a closer look at the numbers.

- ... nine first-team All-Big Ten honorees.
- ... seven players earning 10 All-America honors.
- ... ten players that scored 1,000 career points.

- Purdue has won 100 straight games and is 38-0 under Coach Painter when scoring 90 or more points.
- Purdue hasn't lost when scoring 90 points since Nov. 24, 1987 (104-96 vs. Iowa State), a span of 11,744 days.
- It is believed to be the longest streak in America.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 331-166 (.666) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 356-171 (.676) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
