- Seven of the top-30 golfers in the World Amateur Golf Rankings will be playing in the West Lafayette Regional (Gordon Sargent 2; Jackson Van Paris 15; Matt Riedel 17; Cole Sherwood 18; Herman Sekne 21; William Moll 25; Ian Gilligan 29).
- Florida and New Mexico are returning to West Lafayette for their second straight regional appearance. The Lobos advanced out of West Lafayette to Nationals in 2017, but the top-seeded Gators failed to qualify. Purdue also advanced out of Regionals in 2017.
- Three teams that have won National Championships, including last year's National Champion Florida, will be in the West Lafayette Regional.
