

West Lafayette Regional Pre-Tournament Notes

- Cincinnati's Ty Gingerich has a big-time local connection to Purdue. His father, Rex, was a pitcher on the Purdue baseball team in the 1980s and his brother, Weston, is currently a junior on the Purdue baseball team.
- Seven of the top-30 golfers in the World Amateur Golf Rankings will be playing in the West Lafayette Regional (Gordon Sargent – 2; Jackson Van Paris – 15; Matt Riedel – 17; Cole Sherwood – 18; Herman Sekne – 21; William Moll – 25; Ian Gilligan – 29).
- Florida and New Mexico are returning to West Lafayette for their second straight regional appearance. The Lobos advanced out of West Lafayette to Nationals in 2017, but the top-seeded Gators failed to qualify. Purdue also advanced out of Regionals in 2017.
- Three teams that have won National Championships, including last year's National Champion Florida, will be in the West Lafayette Regional.

 - Purdue – 1961
- Five teams that made last year's NCAA Championships are in the West Lafayette Regional, including defending National Champion Florida.
