THE SCENE SETTER BETWEEN THE BOILERMAKERS AND THE BUCKEYES

Looking to start a new streak, the 20th-ranked Boilermakers travel to Ohio State for the only meeting between the two squads ... the game will be televised by ESPN with expert analysis from **Jason Benetti** and **Jim Calhoun** ... on the radio dial, the game will be available on the Purdue Sports Network and **Tuneln.com** as **Larry Clisby** and **Rob Blackman** provide brilliant commentary, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show one hour before tip ... live stats will be available at StatBroadcast.com.

#BOILERNOTES

- Purdue is ranked No. 20 in the Associated Press top-25 poll, dropping five spots from last week ... the Boilermakers have been ranked in the AP Top 25 in each of the last 28 polls, the seventh-longest active streak nationally ... Purdue is also ranked 20th in the coaches poll, down five spots.
- Purdue's three losses have come to teams with a combined record of 39-4 with losses to Baylor, Virginia, Michigan State and Florida State.
- Purdue has scored at least 82 points in five straight games ... the last time Purdue scored at least 80 points in six straight games came Dec. 6, to Dec. 27, 1997 (six straight games).
- Nine of Purdue's 12 wins have come by at least 21 points, including five by at least 30 points ... six of Purdue's last seven wins have come by at least 22 points ... lone win during that stretch that didn't come by at least 22 points was against No. 21-ranked Notre Dame (86-81) ... the nine 20-point wins are tied for the third most in the country (Kentucky, West Virginia - 10; Purdue, Gonzaga, Wichita State - 9).
- Following Purdue's two previous losses, Purdue rallied from a 13-point second-half deficit against Georgia State on Nov. 18 (following Villanova) to win 64-56 ... following the loss to Louisville, Purdue defeated Morehead State 90-56 ... since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue is 9-1 following a loss.
- In the first game of the new calendar year, Purdue is just 5-7 under **Matt Painter** following the loss to Minnesota, and just 2-4 in the last six games.
- Purdue ranks in the top 25 in 9-of-18 NCAA statistical categories, including in the top 10 in assists (2nd), personal fouls (5th), scoring margin (7th) and rebound margin (7th).
- Matt Painter** won his 250th career game at Purdue in last Wednesday's victory over Iowa ... his 64.6 winning percentage (250-137) is fifth best in school history (min. 40 games coached).

- Minnesota won for the first time in Mackey Arena since Jan. 21, 2004, snapping an eight-game Purdue winning streak in Mackey Arena ... the last six meetings between the two teams have come by three, three (3 overtimes), four, four, four and nine (overtime).
- Purdue saw a league-best nine-game home winning streak in conference end in the loss to Minnesota ... it had been 364 days since Purdue lost a league home game (Jan. 2, 2016, vs. Iowa).
- Purdue is 31-3 in its last 34 home games (Iowa, Villanova, Minnesota).
- Purdue's three losses have come by a combined 19 points.
- Purdue's 91 points allowed marked the first time it allowed a team to reach its pregame scoring average (Minnesota avg. 76.9 per game) ... however, Minnesota did only have 73 points in regulation.
- Purdue has now scored 80 points in five straight games for the first time since Nov. 2013.

SERIES HISTORY

- Ohio State is the only Big Ten team (min. 10 games) with a winning record against Purdue, owning an 89-85 series advantage ... Purdue, however, has tried to stem the tide recently, winning two of the last three meetings with the Buckeyes, which was preceded by six straight Buckeyes' victories.
- Since the 1998-99 season, Ohio State is 25-8 against the Boilermakers ... **Gene Keady** was 1-9 in his last 10 meetings with the Buckeyes.
- Just 12 of the last 23 meetings have been decided by single digits.

THE HOUSE OF HORRORS

- Purdue is just 1-13 all-time in Value City Arena with the lone victory coming Feb. 17, 2010, as the No. 4-ranked Boilermakers defeated the No. 9-ranked Buckeyes 60-57.
- Since that victory, Ohio State has won four straight games in the facility including a 65-61 decision in Purdue's last visit on March 1, 2015 ... **D'Angelo Russell** had 28 points and seven rebounds for the Buckeyes in that victory.

THE OHIO CONNECTIONS

- Purdue has two significant players from Ohio as **Dakota Mathias** (Elida) and **Vincent Edwards** (Middleton) will be returning to their home state for just the second time as a Boilermaker.
- Mathias' hometown of Elida is about 105 miles northwest of Columbus, while Edwards' hometown of Middleton is 93 miles southwest of Columbus (near Cincinnati).
- In addition, Purdue point guard **P.J. Thompson** and Ohio State point guard **Jaquan Lyle** were AAU teammates on Indy Spiece Heat.

EFFICIENT BOILERS

- Purdue currently ranks 19th in the country in offensive efficiency according to KenPom.com, the same place it ended last year in the offensive efficiency ratings.
- The ranking is the second-best ranking of the Painter era, as it finished 13th during the 2011-12 season.

HOLDING FOES BELOW THEIR AVERAGES

- Purdue has held 13-of-14 possible foes below their pregame scoring averages, including nine opponents to 12 or more points under their respective average.
- Minnesota, the only team to reach its pregame average, needed 18 points in overtime to reach that ... Purdue has held all 14 opponents under their average in regulation play.

TIS THE SEASON TO GIVE

- The Boilermakers have recorded at least 20 assists in 8-of-15 games this year, ranking second nationally in assists per game (20.3).

- The Boilermakers have assisted on 68.1 percent (305-of-448) of its made field goals, good for second nationally in assist rate (A / FGM) ... Michigan State leads the country at 71.0 percent.

- Eight of Purdue's nine regulars average at least 1.0 assist per game and four players average at least 2.5 assists per game.

SETTING THE STANDARD

- Purdue's 12 3-pointers against Iowa were the most in a Big Ten game since having 13 against Nebraska on Feb. 22, 2012.

PICK YOUR POISON

- In last Wednesday's win over Iowa, Purdue had four points at halftime from its two leading scorers, **Caleb Swanigan** and **Isaac Haas**, yet led by 24 against the Hawkeyes thanks in large part to 10 3-pointers.
- In the second half, Purdue made just two 3-pointers, but got 23 of its 40 points from Swanigan and Haas.

UP AND DOWN FROM THE ARC

- Purdue has been mostly good from 3-point range this year, but is slowing down a bit from its record pace earlier this year.
- The Boilermakers are just 37-of-112 (.330) from 3-point range in the last five games, and that includes a 12-of-29 (.414) showing against Iowa in the Big Ten opener.
- The Boilermakers now rank 15th in the country in 3-point percentage (.406) after leading the country on Dec. 11 (.443).

HOT AWAY FROM MACKAY ARENA

- Purdue is shooting 52.6 percent (60-of-114) from 3-point range in five games away from Mackay Arena ... in home games, Purdue is shooting just 35.0 percent (85-of-243) from deep.
- Purdue is averaging 85.6 points away from Mackay Arena against teams from the ACC (Louisville, Notre Dame), SEC (Auburn), Mountain West (Utah State) and PAC-12 (Arizona State).

CLOSE LOSSES TO GOOD TEAMS

- Purdue's three losses have come to opponents with a combined 39-4 record (.907) and rank first (Villanova), eighth (Louisville) and 10th (Minnesota) in the NCAA RPI rankings.
- The four losses those three teams have suffered are to Baylor (2nd), Virginia (15th), Florida State (12th) and Michigan State (34th).

CLEANING THE GLASS

- Purdue ranks seventh nationally in rebound margin at +10.1 rebounds per game, one year after ranking third in the country.
- Over Purdue's last seven games, Purdue has outrebounded foes by 13.3 rebounds per game and has outscored opponents in second-chance points 102-45 (14.6 to 6.4 per game) during that span.

PLAY WITHOUT FOULING

- Purdue ranks fifth in the country in fewest personal fouls per game, averaging just 15.0 whistles per game.
- In the last 10 games, Purdue has had 50 fouls called in the first half, resulting in just 27 opponent free throws.
- Purdue ranks second in the country in the category of defensive free throw rate (FTA / FGA), which measures how often an opponent gets to the free throw line.

MAKING MORE THAN OPPONENTS SHOOT

- Purdue has made 226 free throws this season, while opponents have shot just 177 ... Purdue has outscored its opponents by 96 points from the free throw line.
- Purdue owns a 181-26 (.874) record under Painter when attempting more free throws than its opponent, including 31-3 (.912) since the start of the 2015-16 season.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 250-137 (.646) / 12th year | **Career Record:** 275-142 (.659) / 13th year

- With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, eight NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 12th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in eight seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 24 players earn a combined 44 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
