THE OPENING TIP

• Purdue (9-5, 2-1) begins a tough Big Ten stretch Sunday with a visit to Illinois (9-5, 1-2) for a primetime battle. **Jeffer Levering** and **Tim Miles** will handle the broadcast on FS1, beginning at 8 p.m. ET. On the radio, **Rob Blackman** and **Larry Clisby** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 7 p.m. ET. Live stats will be available on PurdueSports.com.

• Purdue owns a 102-87 series lead against Illinois, including a 17-7 mark under Coach Painter. Purdue is looking for its fifth win in a row in the series.

• The 189 previous meetings between the two teams make this the seventh-most frequently played rivalry in the Big Ten. Purdue and Indiana lead the way with 209 meetings.

• **SOMETHING TO WATCH:** The glass will have a major impact on the contest. Illinois enters the game ranked No. 1 nationally in rebound margin and is third in offensive rebound percentage.

• Purdue looks to build momentum on the road after sizzling at Mackey Arena the last two games. Purdue is 2-4 away from Mackey Arena, averaging just 60.0 points per game and shooting 36.1 percent from the field and 27.0 percent from long distance. Purdue has an assist / turnover ratio of 0.79 (68 / 86) away from Mackey (1.78 at home).

• Purdue's sophomore class has started to emerge as offensive leaders. The class is averaging 50.5 points per game over the last two games and 40.1 points per game over the last seven games. For the season, the class is shooting 43.6 percent from the field and 38.5 percent from deep.

• **Eric Hunter Jr.** and **Sasha Stefanovic** are two of the Big Ten's most improved scorers this year.

• Purdue is 7-0 this year when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. The Boilermakers are 2-5 when allowing 60-plus.

• Purdue is 8-0 this year and 28-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The lone loss came to Virginia in last year's Elite Eight.

• Purdue is 7-0 this year and has won 18 straight games when attempting more free throws than its opponent.

• Purdue won seven straight games in the month of January and is 17-1 during the month since 2018.

HEATING UP JANUARY

- Once the calendar turns to a new year, the Boilermakers tend to really heat up. Purdue is 17-1 during the month of January since 2018, with the one loss coming at Michigan State on Jan. 8, 2019.
- Since the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 33-10 in the month of January.

CLOSING OUT THE DECADE

- Purdue had a pretty nice decade from Jan. 1, 2010, to Dec. 31, 2019. Here is a closer look at the numbers.
- ... posted a 234-114 (.672) overall record.
- ... posted a 143-26 (.846) record at Mackey Arena.
- ... posted a 120-63 (.656) record in Big Ten play.
- ... posted an 11-8 (.579) record in the NCAA Tournament.
- ... advanced to four Sweet 16s (2010, 2017, 2018, 2019 - Elite Eight).
- ... won three Big Ten regular-season titles (2010, 2017, 2019).
- ... two Big Ten Players of the Year (**JaJuan Johnson**, **Caleb Swanigan**).
- ... three Big Ten Coach of the Year (**Matt Painter** - 2010, 2011, 2019).
- ... nine first-team All-Big Ten honorees.
- ... seven players earning 10 All-America honors.
- ... ten players that scored 1,000 career points.
- ... outscored opponents 25,596 to 22,812 (73.55 to 65.55).

- Purdue has won 100 straight games and is 38-0 under Coach Painter when scoring 90 or more points.
- Purdue hasn't lost when scoring 90 points since Nov. 24, 1987 (104-96 vs. Iowa State), a span of 11,731 days.

- Purdue and Illinois are the only Big Ten teams to play a road game at a team outside the "Power-6" conferences, when the Boilermakers traveled to Ohio last Tuesday night.
- Illinois played at Grand Canyon on Nov. 8.

- **Matt Painter** will coach his 500th game at Purdue on Jan. 24, 2020, vs. Wisconsin.
- Purdue is 154-16 under **Matt Painter** when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the field.
- Purdue is 26-4 when **Matt Haarms** scores in double figures.
- Purdue is 28-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher percentage from the field than its opponent. The lone loss was to Virginia in the 2019 Elite Eight.

- Purdue is 108-9 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponent, including 23-2 since the start last season.
- Purdue is 33-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game.
- Purdue is 121-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 35-2 since the start of 2017-18.

THE DEFENSE OF MACKEY ARENA

- Since the 2014-15 season, Purdue has been almost unbeatable at Mackey Arena, posting an 84-8 record in the facility. Purdue's eight losses have come to North Florida (73-70), Gardner-Webb (89-84), [11] Maryland (69-60), Iowa (70-63), [3] Villanova (79-76), Minnesota (91-82; OT), [14] Ohio State (64-63) and Texas (70-66).
- It has been 95 games since Purdue has lost by double-figures in Mackey Arena (94-79 to [13] Michigan State on Feb. 20, 2014).
- Since the start of last year, Purdue has held 17 of 23 opponents at Mackey Arena under 40.0 percent shooting.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue has allowed just four opponents to shoot at least 50.0 percent from the field. Coincidentally, Purdue is 2-2 in those four games.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 330-164 (.668) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 355-169 (.677) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his resumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
