#BOILERNOTES**Season Opener Notes**

- The Boilermakers are 33-7 all-time in season-opening games and 38-2 in home openers
- Last season Purdue lost its first home opener since 1995, falling in double-overtime to Green Bay 81-78 and snapping a streak of 19 straight
- Purdue is 94-28 all-time in November, including a 57-6 record at home
- The Boilermakers are 3-0 all-time on Nov. 16, last defeating IUPUI at home 80-44 in 2008

Opponent Notes

- Jacksonville State is the 187th opponent in Purdue history, the Boilermakers are 133-53 in inaugural meetings
- The Gamecocks finished their season 19-10 in 2014-15, falling in the opening round of the Ohio Valley Conference tournament
- JSU returns four starters from last year's squad, however second-leading scorer and leading rebounder, Destany McLin, is out with an injury
- Rick Pietri is in his third season with JSU, and has a career record of 253-195 entering 2015-16
- Purdue is 17-3 all-time against teams from the Ohio Valley Conference: defeating visiting Belmont 76-46 on Nov. 22, 2013
- The Boilermakers are 5-1 all-time against schools from Alabama: earning a 62-54 win at Auburn on Dec. 18, 2011
- JSU opened its season with a 70-55 loss at Memphis on Friday

Last Time Out

- The Boilermakers topped Marian 78-37 in exhibition play on Nov. 8
- Bridget Perry led the way with 17 points, 13 rebounds and two blocks, converting 7-of-10 from the floor
- April Wilson was on the floor for 68 of our 78 points in the game (33 minutes), finishing with 15 points, nine assists and four steals
- Andreona Keys and Nora Kiesler reached double-figures with 12 and 10 points, respectively, while Kiesler grabbed five rebounds as well
- Boilermakers outrebounded Marian 47-23 and outscored them in the paint 42-16
- Purdue improved to 42-3 all-time in exhibition games, including 37 wins in a row

Head Coach Sharon Versyp

- Enters the 2015-16 season six wins shy of her 200th at Purdue and 12 wins shy of tying Lin Dunn for the most coaching victories in Purdue history (206)
- Going into her 10th season at the helm, which at season's end will match her for the longest head coaching tenure in school history (Dr. Ruth Jones)
- Versyp is 9-0 in season-openers with the Boilermakers and 8-1 in home-openers

#1 Ashley Morrisette

- 2013 Ohio Miss Basketball
- Our leading returning scorer at 11.0 points per game last season
- One of 10 sophomores in school history to dish out 100 assists in a season
- Ranked seventh among Big Ten returners in assist:turnover ratio (1.4)

#2 Abby Abel

- First walk-on player in Purdue head coach Sharon Versyp's 10 years with the Boilermakers
- Active volunteer w/ Special Olympics, including attending the 2015 world summer games in Los Angeles
- One of two sets of boy/girl twins on the team (Bridget Perry), both of which attend Purdue with their twin

#3 Tiara Murphy

- Attended the same high school as three-time NCAA All-American Skylar Diggins (South Bend Washington)
- Scored over 1,000 points in high school, was the No. 31 ranked overall recruit on ESPN HoopGurlz and the No. 10 ranked point guard nationally

#4 Torrie Thornton

- Father, Donald Thornton Jr., competed in track & field at Eastern New Mexico, mother, Dierdre Thornton, played basketball at Louisville, and sister, Melanie, played basketball at Butler

#5 Justine Hall

- One of two Boilermakers (Erica Moore), who's father played in the NFL. Darryl Hall played for the Denver Broncos and San Francisco 49ers from 1993 to 1995, and won a pair of Grey Cups in the Canadian Football League with the Calgary Stampeders
- Only player in school history to hail from Colorado

#10 Hayden Hamby

- Fourth pre-med major student-athlete under Versyp (Lauren Mioton, Chelsea Jones, Drey Mingo)
- Two-time Academic All-Big Ten honoree and 2015 Big Ten Distinguished Scholar
- 2015 Allstate Good Works Team and Senior CLASS Award nominee

#12 Nora Kiesler

- At 6'6", she is tied with two others (Summer Erb, Michele VanGorp) as the tallest player in Purdue women's basketball history
- Her older brother, Peter, played basketball at NCAA Division III, Wittenberg College
- She is the shortest of her siblings, with three brothers all standing taller

#13 Bridget Perry

- Biomedical engineering major and 2015 Academic All-Big Ten honoree
- One of two sets of boy/girl twins on the team (Abby Abel), both of which attend Purdue with their twin
- Leading returning rebounder, pulling down 105 boards last year

#20 Dominique McBryde

- Played on a pair of Indiana High School State Championship teams at Bedford North Lawrence (2013 & 2014)
- Set her high school's career records for scoring (1,672) and blocked shots (229)
- Qualified for the Indiana High School State Track & Field Championships in the long jump
- Was ranked No. 30 overall in the Class of 2015 by ESPN HoopGurlz, No. 8 forward in the class

#21 Erica Moore

- One of two Boilermakers (Justine Hall), who's father played in the NFL. Eric Moore played for the New York Giants, the Cincinnati Bengals, the Cleveland Browns and the Miami Dolphins from 1988 to 1995

#22 Bree Horrocks

- Invited to and attended the 2015 Nike LGBT Sports Summit in Portland, Oregon
- Played the upright bass in high school (Buford, Georgia)
- Had the eighth-best field goal percentage among Big Ten freshmen with at least 50 attempts last season (.442)

#24 Andreona Keys

- Learned to play the cello and speak Japanese in high school (Roswell, Georgia)
- Appeared in all 31 games last season as a freshman, and is the team's No. 4 returning scorer and No. 2 returning rebounder
- Ranked eighth among Big Ten freshmen with 3.2 rebounds per game last season
- Posted 13th-best scoring average for a freshman in the Big Ten last year at 5.8 points per game
- Owns the fourth-best free throw percentage among returning Big Ten sophomores with at least 50 attempts last season
- Her 702 minutes played last year were the most by a Purdue freshman since Courtney Moses in 2010-11 (1,030)

#25 April Wilson

- Has been on three international mission trips during her tenure at Purdue, going to South Africa twice (2013 & 2015) and Haiti (2014)
- Is 263 points from becoming the 29th 1,000-point career scorer in Purdue history
- With 336 career assists she ranks 13th all-time at Purdue and is 82 shy of matching head coach Sharon Versyp (418)
- Her 146 career steals are 22nd all-time at Purdue and 48 short of matching Versyp
- Four steals from becoming the 12th player in school history to record at least 300 assists and 150 steals
- No. 3 returner in the Big Ten in assists per game (4.8) and No. 4 in assist:turnover ratio (1.6)

Schedule Notes

- The Boilermakers will play at least five teams ranked in the preseason polls this season (Ohio State, Maryland, Northwestern, Michigan State, Iowa), with a potential sixth opponent in Louisville at the Gulf Coast Showcase
- Seven of their 11 non-conference games will be played in the friendly confines of Mackey Arena, while all four road contests will be played in an 11-day swing to Florida over Thanksgiving
- Purdue is slated for five Big Ten Network appearances in 2015-16, playing Boston College on Dec. 3, at Ohio State on Jan. 17, vs. Iowa on Jan. 24, vs. Maryland on Feb. 2 and at Wisconsin on Feb. 8
- There are three potential TV games at the end of the season as Purdue's final three games have been marked as wild card appearances and may be shown live on the BTN
