Guard P.J. Thompson, Junior:

On teammate Vincent Edwards...

"He had a huge second half for us. Actually, it was special, he had a special second half. In the first half, he was struggling a little bit. He was down on himself, but we told him he's been doing this since he was a little kid. He steps up in big moments."

On the coaching staff's message at halftime...
