

## **PURDUE BASKETBALL POSTGAME NOTES**

**Purdue (2-0) vs. UIC (2-1)**

**November 19, 2015 • Keady Court at Mackey Arena • Attendance: 5,572**

**Purdue Boilermakers 62, UIC Flames 51**

### **GAME NOTES**

- Head coach Sharon Versyp improved to 196-108 at Purdue and remains 11 shy of the Boilermakers' all-time coaching wins record
- The Boilermakers improve to 96-28 overall in the month of November and 6-2 on Nov. 19
- April Wilson became the 12<sup>th</sup> player in Purdue history with 350 career assists and 150 steals
- Out of Purdue's 40 rebounds, 18 were offensive, including 14 in the first half
- Purdue forced 17 turnovers, seven of which were in the second period, and posted 21 points off turnovers compared to UIC's eight
- The Boilermakers never trailed in the game
- Purdue allowed three points in the first 6:05 of the second half
- The Boilermakers' 23 points in the first quarter were a season-high
- Purdue held a nine-point lead after three quarters despite making 6-of-30 field goals in the second and third periods combined

### **INDIVIDUAL NOTES**

- April Wilson made her second career double-double with 19 points and 10 assists while tying a season-high three 3-pointers and six field goals
- Wilson's 19 points were just one point shy of her career-high
- In 35 minutes of play, April Wilson had one turnover
- Wilson's two career points-assists double-doubles are tied for fourth all-time at Purdue with Cindy Lamping, Stephanie White and Katie Douglas
- Torrie Thornton tied a career-high nine rebounds (previous was five). Seven of her nine occurred in the first half in only seven minutes of action
- Hayden Hamby grabbed four rebounds, just one shy of her career-record
- Nora Kiesler hit a career-high seven points and tied her season-high two rebounds
- With five of her eight points coming in the fourth quarter, Andreona Keys is averaging seven points in the fourth quarter this season
- Ashley Morrisette was the only other Boilermaker in double figures with 11 points
