THE OPENING TIP

- The Boilermakers hit the road for the third time in the last four games on Thursday night when they travels to Rutgers for a 7 p.m. tip. - Purdue is coming off three straight games against ranked opponents, which included wins over No. 22 Illinois and No. 2 Ohio State. - Abbey Ellis has finished in double figures in five of her last six games, averaging 16.7 points per game during the stretch. Ellis has moved up to second on the team in scoring with 11.8 points per game and sits second in the Big ten with an 88.9% clip at the line. · With wins at Northwestern, No. 22 Illinois and No. 2 Ohio State, the Boilermakers are riding a three-game road winning streak for the first time since 2017-18. Purdue has held opponents to 57 points per game, 37.8% shooting and 23.3% from distance in those games. • Fifth-year Lasha Petree will make her only trip to Rutgers after playing for the Scarlet Knights during the 2021-22 season. Graduating last spring with a degree in marketing, Petree averaged 8.3 points per game with 26 starts last season. · With 173 boards and 147 helpers, Jeanae Terry joined Caitlin Clark as the only players from the Big Ten to lead their teams in

Abbey Ellis started the week ranked 19th in free throw percentage at 88.9%, which sits second in the Big Ten.

rebounds and assists. Terry sits 10th in the nation in assists per game at 6.7 and ninth in total dimes.

Following 13 points against No. 4 Indiana, Lasha Petree needs 41 points to join the 2,000-point club for her career.

Cassidy Hardin sits ninth in program history with 134 games played, six short of Danielle Campbell's (2006-09) record of 140.

- Born Oct. 26, 1984 (38 years old)
- Second season as head coach at her alma mater
- · Hired as associate head coach on March 26, 2021
- Elevated to head coach on Sept. 16, 2021
- 10th season as a head coach, second at Purdue

AT PURDUE (2021-PRESENT)

- Went 17-15 in opening campaign, posting a 10-win improvement, the best jump by a first-year head coach at Purdue
- Head coach just 47 days before the 2021-22 season began
- Announced as the associate head coach on March 26, 2021, as part of a succession plan that, originally, would see her take over the head seat for the 2022-23 campaign

AT MARIAN (2013-2021)

- Went 228-50 (82%) over eight seasons at Marian in the NAIA
- Won back-to-back NAIA National Championships in 2016 and 2017
- Named NAIA National Coach of the Year three times (2016, 2017, 2020)

PROFESSIONAL CAREER (2007-2013)

- Played six professional seasons across the WNBA, Spain, Greece, Portugal and Slovakia
- Went 7th overall to the Seattle Storm in the 2007 WNBA Draft, the highest pick in program history.

AT PURDUE (2004-07)

- 2007 All-America, 4-time All-Big Ten selection, 2007 Big Ten champ
- Tallied 1,974 points, 238 3-pointers and 103 wins at Purdue
- Four NCAA Tournament appearances and a 2007 Elite Eight

AT BEECH GROVE HIGH SCHOOL

- 2003 3A Indiana State Champion, Indiana Miss Basketball
- 2,521 career points, sixth in state history, averaging 30.1 points

AST TIME OUT

- After a solid first half against No. 4 Indiana, the Boilermakers ran out of steam in the final 20 minutes falling 69-46.
- Purdue trailed by five at the break, before being outscored 19-2 in the third, while shooting 1-for-17 in the frame.
- Lasha Petree led Purdue in scoring with 13 points, and Abbey Ellis tacked on 10 points.
- The Boilermakers shot a season-low 32.8% from the field and went 3-of-16 from behind the arc.

BOILER NOTES

BOILERMAKER BASKETBALL

Purdue Women's Basketball is in its 48th season in 2022-23 with an all-time record of 919-533. Last season, Purdue became the 40th program in NCAA Division I history to reach 900 wins and ranks fifth in all-time victories among current Big Ten teams.

• The Boilermakers are the only team from the Big Ten to win a national championship, hoisting the title in 1999.

- The program has reached the NCAA Tournament 26 times with 12 Sweet 16s, eight Elite 8s, three final fours and a trio of national championship game appearances.
- In addition to its NCAA success, Purdue owns the Big Ten record for most tournament titles with nine.

KG ERA YEAR 2

- With a full offseason to prepare for the 2022-23 campaign, head coach Katie Gearlds is in her second year at her alma mater.
- The Boilermakers already posted a 9-1 record in non-conference play, the best mark since 2003-04 and tied for the third best in program history.
- Taking over the reins of the program a mere 47 days ahead of the season last year, Gearlds converted Purdue into a fast-paced, let-fly offense that smashed the program record for 3-pointers made and attempted.
- After the program won just seven games in 2020-21, Gearlds guided the Boilermakers to 17 wins in her initial campaign, marking the biggest win improvement by a first-year head coach at Purdue.
- In the second game against a ranked opponent under Gearlds, Purdue snapped a 19-game skid against AP Top 25 teams with a 66-61 win over No. 17 Florida State at the St. Pete Showcase.
- Gearlds took the Boilermakers back to the postseason for the first time since 2017-18, reaching the second round of the WNIT.
- Purdue's 10-2 mark in the non-conference in 2021-22 was the second best by a first-year head coach in program history.

MILESTONE WATCH

- Lasha Petree needs 41 points to join the 2,000-point club.
- Abbey Ellis is 66 points away from 1,500 for her career.
- Cassidy Hardin is 3 3-pointers away fro 200 for her career, which would make her the fifth Boilermaker to join that club.
- Currently at 134, Hardin needs to play seven more games to break Danielle Campbell (2006-09, 140) for Purdue appearances.
 With 10 points against Illinois, the Caitlyn Harper crossed the 1,500-point plateau for her career.
- Jeanae Terry joined the 500-assist club for her career with a pair of dimes against Nebraska.

OUR AUSSIE, ABBEY

- After coming off the bench for the majority of non-conference action, Abbey Ellis has picked up her output in Big Ten play.
- Ellis sits second on the team with 11.9 points per game, with 12.5 as a starter and 11.3 points per game coming off the bench.
- The Australian international is 19th in the nation and second in the Big Ten with a 88.9% free throw mark on the year.
 She has finished in double figures in 12 games with four outings of 20 points or more.
- Ellis dropped a season-high 29 points against SIUE.
- She earned a spot on the Big Ten Honor Roll with 21 points and four rebounds per game, while shooting 60% overall and 58% from three in the wins over No. 22 Illinois and No. 2 Ohio State.
- Ellis was one of three players in the nation to average 15 points per game and shoot 70 FG% , 60 3PT% and 90 FT% (17 ppg, 71.4% fg, 66.7% 3pt, 100% ft) in the first two weeks of the season.

- Jeanae Terry is in elite company as one of a select group of players with over six points, rebounds and assists per game.

NATIONAL NAE

- Jeanae Terry opened the season with two non-point double-doubles, the first in Purdue history.
- Terry was the first player in the country to reach 100 assists and rebounds this year.
- Terry has tallied five or more assists in 15 games and 10 or more rebounds six times.
- The Detroit native is 17th in Purdue history with 328 assists.
- With a pair of dimes against Nebraska, Terry crossed the 500-assist plateau for her career.
- Terry has grabbed seven or more rebounds in 16 games.
- Terry has dished out eight or more assists in eight games this season, the most by a Boilermaker in the last 15 seasons.
- Terry is tracking to finish in the Purdue single-season top-10 for assist-to-turnover ratio for the second year in a row, chasing the record of 2.57 held by Katie Gearlds in (2005-06).
- Terry finished her junior year ranked sixth in the Big Ten in assist-to-turnover ratio, third in assists (per game), 11th in rebounds per game and second in triple-doubles.

JT THE STAT STUFFER

- Jeanae Terry continues stuff the stat sheet every night as one of the nation's top passers and best rebounding guards.
- Terry has recorded five rebounds and five assists in 14 games, second only to Caitlin Clark's 19 this season.
- Terry is one of six players in the nation to record five points, five assists and five rebounds in 11 or more games this year.
- Terry is on pace to become just the fourth Boilermaker in program history to dish out 150 or more assists in multiple seasons, accomplished by Stephanie White, MaChelle Joseph and Jennifer Jacoby.

HARPING ON HARPER

- Purdue's second transfer commitment out of the portal landed the 2022 WAC Player of the Year from Cal Baptist.
- She sits third on the team with 10.9 points per game.
- Harper is 1-of-8 players in the Big Ten averaging over 10 points per game while shooting 55% or better from the field.
- The redshirt senior has made her mark on the outside with 15 triples at a 39.5% clip.
- Harper paced Purdue with a season-high 20 points on the road at Penn State to top her 13 games in double figures.
- With her 10 points against Illinois, Harper joined the 1,500-point club for her career, following 1,286 points at Cal Baptist.
 The redshirt senior was named the 11th best transfer from a
- mid-major to a high-major this offseason by HerHoopsStats.com.
 The Hartland, Wisc., native came to Purdue after leading the
- WAC in scoring in 2021-22 with 17.7 points per game with a 52.4% shooting clip.

BOILER NOTES

RANKED MATCHUPS

- Head coach Katie Gearlds guided Purdue to back-to-back ranked wins for the first time since 2018.
- With a 73-65 win over No. 2 Ohio State in Columbus, the Boilermakers tallied their first ever top-five win on the road.
- The Boilermakers picked up their first ranked win of the season against No. 22 Illinois in January, a 62-52 decision.
- · Purdue is 3-10 in ranked games under Gearlds.
- Purdue fell on a 3-point buzzer beater earlier this season to No. 20 Maryland at Mackey Arena, 77-74.
- Purdue snapped the program's 19-game skid to ranked teams with a 66-61 win over No. 17 Florida State last season.
- Gearlds was 23-22 against ranked teams during her playing days in West Lafayette. Her highest ranked win was over No. 5 Kansas State as a freshman in 2003.

A TOUGH STRETCH

- Purdue finished 2-1 when during a tough stretch of three straight games against ranked opponents in No. 22 Illinois (W, 62-52), No. 2 Ohio State (W, 73-65) and No. 4 Indiana (L, 69-46).
- The back-to-back ranked wins gave the Boilermakers multiple ranked wins in a season for the first time since 2018-19.
- The last time Purdue faced three straight ranked teams in the regular season came against No. 4 Notre Dame, No. 20 LSU and No. 14 Stanford.
- It is the first time Purdue has played three consecutive league games against ranked clubs.

HONOR ROLL FOR ABBEY

- Abbey Ellis garnered her first Big Ten Honor Roll appearance as a Boilermaker after leading Purdue in scoring in both its wins over ranked opponents.
- The Australian averaged 21 points and four rebounds per game, while shooting 60% from the field and 58.3% from outside, in the wins over No. 22 Illinois and No. 2 Ohio State.
- Against the Illini, Ellis went for 16 points on 6-of-9 shooting with a pair of triples.
- Ellis exploded against the Buckeyes for 26 points, including a quintet of 3-pointers.

BOUNCING THE BUCKEYES

- For the first time in program history, a phrase that's truly remarkable when thinking about the history of Purdue Women's Basketball, the Boilermakers defeated a top-5 opponent on the road when they knocked off No. 2 Ohio State.
- Purdue unleashed a barrage of 3-pointer, connecting on a season-high 13, while holding the Buckeyes to just 7-of-28 from behind the arc.
- Ohio State entered the game as the top team in the nation in steals. The Boilermakers kept that number down to five, while flipping 15 Buckeye turnovers into 22 points.
- Purdue built a 17-point lead in the third quarter, only for Ohio State to tie the game with five minutes to play in the fourth. Madison Layden and Abbey Ellis combined for a 7-0 run that put the game out of reach in the final minutes.

DOWN GO THE RANKED ILLINI

- Opening a stretch of three straight games against a ranked opponent, the Boilermakers put on a masterclass on defense and the glass to defeat No. 22 Maryland 62-52.
- •The Boilermakers earned their first road ranked win since 2018 against No. 10 Maryland.
- Purdue's defense held the hottest 3-point shooting team in the Big Ten to just 15.4% from distance.
- Abbey Ellis (16 points) and Jeanae Terry (10 points, 14 rebounds) teamed up on countless plays to stifle any Illinois comeback and silence the State Farm Center.
- Strangely enough, Purdue did not attempt a free throw until the final minute of the game. The Boilermakers finished 5-of-6 at the line to seal the win.

NUMBERS TO KNOW IN THE GEARLDS ERA

- Purdue is 26-5 when leading after the first quarter and 30-4 when taking a lead into the fourth quarter.
- The Boilermakers are 21-13 when knocking down seven or more 3-pointers.
- Purdue is 13-9 when shooting 35% from distance or better and 26-7 when shooting 40% or better overall, including 12-1 with a field goal clip above 50%.
- The Boilermakers are 20-3 when outrebounding opponents.
- Purdue is 17-9 when forcing 15 or more turnovers.
- The Boilermakers hold a 23-3 record when scoring 70 or more points, while also posting a 27-5 mark when holding opponents below that mark.

SPLASH ZONE

- Following a record-breaking 3-point barrage last season, head coach Katie Gearlds has an even deeper roster to shoot the 3-ball.
- Purdue obliterated the single-game and season marks for 3-pointers made (239) and attempted (738) during 2021-22.
 Hardly surprising, when you consider that Gearlds won the 2007 College Slam 3-Point Contest on the men's and women's side.
- Gearlds would also not hesitate to tell you that she could still out shoot all of them today.

- Junior Madison Layden continues to be an all-around producer with 7.0 points, 3.2 assists and 4.2 rebounds per game.
- The second-year captain has recorded a steal in 59 of her 72 career games.
- Layden moved into the program's top-15 for career 3-pointers, currently 15th with 134 triples.
- The junior stepped up in the fourth quarter against Ohio State to score seven of her 10 points, including five straight after the Buckeyes tied the game at 58-58 with five minutes to play.
- Layden connected on a quartet of triples against Michigan to score a season-high 16 points.
- She went 5-of-8 from outside against Florida State for 15 points.

- Fifth-year senior Lasha Petree wasted no time cementing herself as one of Purdue's go-to options on offense.
- Petree was named the No. 9 transfer this season by ESPNW.
 Petree leads the team with 13.8 points per game, while shooting 42.8% with 31 triples.
- She has scored in double figures in 16 games this season.
- She has gone for 20 or more points in five outings, including a season high of 31 against Syracuse.
- The Detroit native is 17th in Division I among active career scorers.
- Petree was tabbed as one of the top transfers this year by HerHoopStats.com
- At Rutgers, the Detroit native totaled 8.3 points per night and hit 38 3-pointers at a 37.6% clip.
- Her final season at Bradley saw her average 18 points per game with 53 triples to earn All-MVC honors for the second straight year and appear on the Naismith Award Watch List.
- Petree joined Purdue out of the transfer portal following three years at Bradley and last year at Rutgers.

- Head coach Katie Gearlds wants her team to run and shoot before turning the ball over.
- Led by Jeanae Terry's 147 assists, Purdue is averaging 16.3 helpers per game to rank 31st nationally and sixth in the Big Ten.
 Madison Layden sits second on the team with 63 helpers.
- Terry is sixth in the Big Ten with a 2.23 assist-to-turnover ratio.
- The Boilermakers have made it an emphasis to make the extra pass recording five games with 20 or more assists and two games with an assist-to-turnover ratio better than 2-1.

ELLIS' ENERGY

- In her second season in West Lafayette, Abbey Ellis has brought Mackey Arena to its feet countless times with her circus shots and impact 3-pointers.
- She quickly became a fan favorite in West Lafayette last year, earning All-Big Ten honorable mention in her first campaign.
- Purdue's first Australian rocks a ribbon in her hair during games from a selection that her mother sends her to wear.
- The senior has also gained a sizeable following on TikTok \ @abbeye_22 with videos shared by Barstool Sports, Slam and more.

INSIDE-OUT

- While the Boilermakers continue to light it up from the outside, Purdue's offense has worked the ball inside this year, averaging 32.5 points per game in the lane with five games over 40.
 After holding opponents to just 4.8 3-pointers per game last year, that number has ventured up to 6.8 per night, as opponents have had to find space outside the lane to score.
- Purdue's interior defense has improved to keep teams to 25.3 points per game in the paint, outscoring teams 716-556 in the lane on the year.

JAYLA'S SOPHOMORE JUMP

- Jayla has tallied 8.1 points per game this season with eight games in double figures.
- Smith joined the starting lineup for the first time this season against Wisconsin.
- Smith made significant strides during the offseason to set up a more important role during her sophomore season.
- She matched her career high in her sophomore debut with 16 points against Marshall, including a pair of clutch 3-pointers to seal the win.
- Smith scored over 1,000 points, won one IHSAA 4A State Championship (2020 over Layden's Northwestern) and was named Indiana Miss Basketball during her prep career.

DOCTOR, DOCTOR GIVE ME THE THREE

- Cassidy Hardin's final year in West Lafayette averaging 7.2
 points per game with 43 of her 54 made field goals coming from
 behind the arc.
- In her career, Hardin has made 197 3-pointers and just 34
 2-point shots. She has attempted 616 3-pointers and just 80 shots inside the arc.
- She is fifth in Purdue history in career 3-pointers. The fifth-year senior needs just three triples to become the fifth Boilermaker to join the 200-3-point club.
- Hardin returned for a final year in West Lafayette as a fifth-year senior with the extra year of eligibility by the NCAA. Hardin came back after deferring her start to IU Medical School to next fall with the goal of getting Purdue to the NCAA Tournament.
- A do-anything-for-the-program player, Hardin has one of the quickest catch and releases in the Big Ten. She also has no program playing post defense or laying her body on the line as the team's leader in charges taken. Hardin jumped into the starting lineup for the first time in her career last season and connected on a career-high 78 3-pointers at a 33.5% clip.
- The Bargersville, Ind., native graduated with a degree in honors biochemistry in May of 2022. Her current specialty she would like to pursue is anesthesiology.

IN THE NON-CON

- The Boilermakers wrapped up non-conference action with a 9-1 record, the best mark since Katie Gearlds was a freshman in 2003-04 (10-1)
- The 9-1 clip tied for the third best in program history with teams from 2001-02, 1998-99, 1990-91 and 1989-90. The program's best mark was 11-1 in 2002-03.
- Lasha Petree paced Purdue with 18.2 points per game with Abbey Ellis and Caitlyn Harper adding 11.2 points each.
- Gearlds now has an 18-3 mark in non-conference play at Purdue. Her 85.7% winning clip is second in program history behind Marsha Reall, who went 8-1 in the 1986-87 season.

- Purdue has played in two overtime games under head coach Katie Gearlds with a 1-1 mark. The Boilermakers outlasted Michigan State this season 76-71 in an extra period.

GONNA LEARN TODAY

- Learn is scoring 3.5 points in 10.3 minutes per night.
- · Learn made her first career start on the road at Northwestern.
- The sophomore gave the Boilermakers a huge spark in their come-from-behind win over Oklahoma State, scoring 12 points and going 8-of-10 at the line.
- Against Wisconsin, Learn went for 12 points on 5-of-5 shooting from the field and 2-of-2 free throws. Ten of her points came over a five-minute span in the third quarter.
- Learn added another spark against Penn State with eight points in a career-high 23 minutes of action.
- After seeing her minutes drive up at the end of her freshman season, Learn embraced her role as an all-hustle utility player on the court and electric factory on the bench.

WISE WOLTMAN

- Rickie Woltman has provided big minutes throughout the season off the bench inside.
- The senior is averaging 3.5 points and 3.3 rebounds 13 minutes per game.
- With Harper in foul trouble, Woltman fell two rebounds shy of a double-double against Minnesota, going for 10 points and eight boards in 24 minutes of work.
- Woltman, a starter in 22 games last year, completely bought into her new role off the bench during the offseason to provide a one-two punch with Harper.

START UNKNOWN, FINISH UNFORGETTABLE

- Jeanae Terry wasted little time adding to her historic resume with the first two non-point double-doubles in Purdue history.
- Going for 10 assists and 10 rebounds against Marshall, Terry is just the fifth player from the Big Ten since 2009 to achieve such a feat
- The senior did it again against Marshall with 10 rebounds, 10 assists and nine points, becoming just the fifth player in the nation over the last 15 seasons to record multiple non-point triple-doubles.
- Terry became the 13th Boilermaker in program history to go for a double-double in the season opener.
- The senior is the first Boilermaker to record multiple tripledoubles in a season and a career with two last year.
- Terry is fueled by her personal mantra Start unknown. Finish unforgettable.
- Only five players in the nation have record two non-point double-doubles since 2009.

 Mary Ashley Groot, McKenna Layden, Rashunda Jones, Sophie
 Swanson and Emily Monson will join Purdue in the summer of 2023.
- Mary Ashley Groot is a 6-2 forward from New York City tabbed a four-star prospect and part of Prospect Nation's Elite 150 and No. 97 by ESPNW
- Rashunda Jones is a 5-8 guard from Washington, Ind., earning four stars, a 93 rating and the No. 79 player by ESPNW.
- Sophie Swanson, a 5-10 guard from Barrington, Ill., was named the 2022 Illinois Miss Basketball after leading Barrington High School to Illinois runner-up honors.
- Emily Monson was named a Prospects Nation Elite 150 member as a 6-0 guard out of Murfreesboro, Tenn.
- The Layden legacy at Purdue will continue with McKenna, a 6-1 guard from Kokomo, Ind., and the little sister of Madison also garnered Elite 150 status from Prospect Nation.

A HISTORY OF WINNING

- Despite not reaching the Big Dance since 2016-17, the Boilermakers' 26 NCAA Tournament appearances are tied with Ohio State for second in the Big Ten behind lowa's 28.
- With its last Big Ten Tournament tile coming in 2013, Purdue owns the record for most league tourney championships with nine (1998-99-2000-03-04-07-08-12-13)
- Purdue has won seven Big Ten regular season championships, good for fourth in the league, with the last one coming in 2002.

- Terry went for 8.0 points, 10.7 rebounds and 7.1 assists per game, totaling 22 of Purdue's 55 helpers on the weekend.
- Following a 22-point win over Harvard, the Boilermakers suffered their first setback of the season with a one-point loss to Florida State.
- Gearlds' fired her squad up for the tournament finale, as the Boilermakers rallied from a nine-point deficit in the second half to beat Oklahoma State 71-65, closing the game on an 11-2 run.

WBOF INDUCTEE CAROLYN PECK

- Former Purdue head coach Carolyn Peck was named a member of the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame class of 2023.
- Peck served as Purdue's head coach for two seasons and led the Boilermakers to the 1999 NCAA National Championship, the only Big Ten team to win a women's basketball title.
- Following two seasons in West Lafayette, Peck coached the WNBA Orlando Miracle and at Florida. She also served on staff at Vanderbilt under her former player and Purdue standout Stephanie White.
- Peck has also served as one of the premier women's basketball analysts for ESPN.

IBHOF INDUCTEE KATIE DOUGLAS

- Purdue legend Katie Douglas was named to the Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame Class of 2023 and will be inducted during a ceremony in April.
- Douglas is the 16th Boilermaker to earn the prestigious honor.
- The graduate from Perry Meridian was an Indiana All-Star and guided Purdue to its two national championship game appearances, including the 1999 title.
- Douglas then played in the WNBA, winning the 2012 WNBA title, reaching five All-Star Games and five WNBA All-Defensive Team honors.

NEW YEAR, NEW CULTURE

- The Boilermakers are **ALL-IN** this season under head coach Katie Gearlds. Gearlds, who took over the program a mere 47 days prior last year, had a full offseason to establish a new culture and bring back elite expectations to this storied program.
- On top of spending the full offseason implementing an overhaul of the offense and defensive principles (rather than adjusting on the fly last year), the squad spent the summer building a culture centered on leadership and excellence on and off the court.
