The Scene Setter

- No. 13-ranked Purdue tips off the new year by hosting Rutgers in the resumption of Big Ten action Wednesday at 7 p.m. ET, in Mackey Arena. The Boilermakers enter the contest as 1-of-3 teams with a 2-0 league record.
- The game will be televised by the Big Ten Network with **Brandon Gaudin** and **Stephen Bardo** on the call. **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will handle the radio broadcast on the Purdue Radio Network and SIRIUS / XM Satellite Radio and live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com. Fans can receive in-game updates on Purdue Basketball's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).
- Purdue is looking for its first 3-0 Big Ten start since the 2010-11 season and for its 10th straight win overall. Purdue's 13 wins are tied for the third most in the country.
- Purdue will end its four-game homestand Saturday as an improving Nebraska squad visits Mackey Arena for a 2:15 p.m. ET, tipoff. Nebraska is currently 10-5 overall.

LOOKING BACK

- Purdue improved to 13-2 with its eighth win of 25 or more points this year in a 98-66 win over Lipscomb on Dec. 30. Purdue's 13-2 start is the sixth-best 15-game start in school history and its the second 13-2 start or better in the last three years.
- Purdue improved to 11-2 under **Matt Painter** in the first game after the Holiday break.
- Purdue led by just five at halftime, but outscored the Bisons 55-28 in the second half, thanks to a 21-of-35 (.600) performance from the field. Purdue shot 52.2 percent for the game.
- Purdue's senior class scored 60 points in the victory over Lipscomb. It marked the third time this year that the senior class scored at least 60 points. Purdue had four players with 15 or more points for the second time this season (Chicago State, Lipscomb).
- **Vincent Edwards** recorded his sixth double-double of the season with 23 points, a career-high 15 rebounds and 3 assists. **Isaac Haas** added 19 points, while **Carsen Edwards** had 18.

► 2-0 Big Ten Starts are Hard to Come By

- Following its win over Northwestern on Dec. 3, Purdue is now 2-0 in Big Ten play for the first time since the 2014-15 season, and for the fifth time under Coach Painter (2017-18, 2014-15, 2010-11, 2009-10).
- Purdue had lost its second game of the conference season at home during the previous two seasons, suffering their only home conference loss of those respective seasons. Purdue lost to Iowa (70-63) in 2015-16 and to Minnesota in overtime (91-82) in 2016-17. Purdue also lost its third home game of the conference season in 2014-15 (Maryland, 69-60).
- Purdue hasn't started Big Ten play 3-0 since the 2010-11 season (4-0), the Boilermakers' best league start during the Painter era.

► After the First Week

- Related to the previous note, in league home games played AFTER January 10 during the last three seasons, Purdue is 19-0.

► Doing it on Both Ends

- Purdue has won nine straight games, using a winning recipe during that span, including five games against KenPom top-55 teams.
- During the streak, Purdue has held foes to 61.9 points per game and has allowed just one foe to score 70 points (Maryland - 75). Opponents are shooting just 37.8 percent from the field.
- Meanwhile on the offensive end, Purdue is averaging 83.6 points per game and shooting 50.4 percent from the field in that span. It has scored 80 points in five straight games.

► Striving for Six of 80

- Purdue has scored at least 80 points in five straight games coming against Valparaiso (80), IUPUI (86), Butler (82), Tennessee State (97) and Lipscomb (98).
- The last time Purdue scored 80 or more points in six straight games came on Dec. 6 to 27, 1997.
- Purdue is 97-10 under Coach Painter when scoring 80 or more points.

► We're Going Streaking

- Purdue owns a nine-game winning streak, tied for the fourth-longest streak in the country.

► Heating up December

- Purdue will carry a 16-game winning streak during the month of December into the next season. Purdue's last loss came on Dec. 19, 2015, against Butler (L, 74-68) in the Crossroads Classic.
- Over the last two Decembers, 10 of Purdue's 14 wins have been by 20 or more points.
- Purdue's 16-game December winning streak is tied for the longest in the month (West Virginia).

► Making Our Statement

- The Crossroads Classic contest with Butler on Dec. 16, marked the final contest of a three-game set against in-state, non-conference opponents (Valpo, IUPUI, Butler).
- With the win over Butler, the Boilermakers have won six straight games against in-state foes and haven't lost to a team from Indiana since Feb. 20, 2016 (675 days).
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue has defeated six different in-state teams (Butler, IUPUI, Fort Wayne, Notre Dame, Indiana, Valparaiso) and is 11-3 against in-state teams.
- Since the start of last year, Purdue is 20-4 against teams from the state of Indiana and bordering states, including 7-1 this year. The four losses are to Louisville, Western Kentucky and Michigan (twice).
- Just one Indiana school, Evansville (one game; last game in 2005), now holds a winning streak against the Boilermakers.

► Capping Off 2017 the Right Way

- Purdue Athletics was 1-of-3 teams nationally (Wisconsin, Florida) to win a bowl game and reach the Sweet 16 during the 2017 calendar year. Purdue defeated Arizona 38-35 in the FosterFarms Bowl.

► Protect This Soil

- Purdue is 12-0 in games played on American soil (1-2 in Bahamas). The Boilermakers are joined by West Virginia and Arizona as unbeaten teams on American soil.

► Boilermakers Off to Another Hot Start

- Purdue is 13-2 (or better) for the second time in three years (2015-16) straight year and the fourth time during the Matt Painter era (2017-18, 2015-16, 2010-11, 2009-10).
- Purdue has started 14-2 or better in four of those seasons.

- Last Saturday was a big day for the Boilermakers. In addition to a dominating win over Atlantic Sun favorite Lipscomb, Butler (Villanova) and Arizona (Arizona State) picked up major victories. Purdue owns a 15-point win over Butler and a 25-point victory over Arizona.
- In each of the last two years, Purdue has lost its first game of the new calendar year, both coming at home. Purdue lost to Iowa (70-63) on Jan. 2, 2016, and then lost to Minnesota (91-82, ot) on Jan. 1, 2017.
- This may be one of Painter's best defensive teams. The Boilermakers rank 10th nationally in field goal percentage defense and 28th in scoring defense. Purdue has finished in the nation's top 20 in field goal percentage defense twice during the Painter era (2016, 2009).
- The school record for scoring margin is plus-13.9 points per game in 1968-69, a year Purdue reached the Final Four. This year's team is third nationally in scoring margin at plus-23.0 points per game.
- Purdue ranks in the nation's top 50 in 11-of-17 major NCAA statistical categories.
- Purdue has shot over 52.0 percent from the field in 8-of-15 games this year.
- Purdue has made at least 14 free throws in all but one game this year (Fairfield) and ranks 10th nationally in free throws made (264).
- Purdue's 95 blocked shots this year are the sixth most in the country. The Boilermakers have 27 blocked shots in the last three games, the most in a three-game span in school history.
- Over the last 50 games at Mackey Arena, Purdue is 47-3 (.940). The stretch started Jan. 24, 2015, vs. Iowa.
- Purdue is 25-3 at home against Big Ten opposition since the start of the 2014-15 season.

- With a trio of Sweet 16 appearances, nine NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 13th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 22 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 25 victories in six seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last 10 years have seen six 25-win seasons and eight NCAA Tournament berths, three Sweet 16 appearances, two regular-season Big Ten titles and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 26 players earn a combined 49 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored a pair of Academic All-Americans in E'Twaun Moore (2010) and Caleb Swanigan (2017)
