The Scene Setter

- No. 3-ranked Purdue returns home for the first time in 10 days when it hosts Wisconsin as part of ESPN's "Super Tuesday" at 7 p.m. ET.
- **Dave Flemming, Dan Dakich and Molly McGrath** will provide the call on ESPN. **Larry Clisby, Rob Blackman and Ralph Taylor** will handle the radio broadcast on the Purdue Radio Network. Fans can receive in-game updates on Purdue Basketball's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).
- The Boilermakers' No. 3 AP ranking matches the highest ranking for the program since reaching No. 2 during the 1987-88 season.
- Purdue is trying to match that squad for the best 20-game start in school history at 18-2. Purdue has won 13 straight games, tied for the 10th-longest winning streak in school history.
- Purdue also puts an 18-game homecourt winning streak on the line Tuesday. Purdue last lost a home game on Nov. 14, 2016.
- Purdue will hit the road Saturday for a noon ET / 11 a.m. CT tip against Iowa in Iowa City. Purdue hasn't won in Iowa City since Dec. 28, 2011.

LOOKING BACK

- Purdue improved to 17-2 overall and 6-0 in the Big Ten Conference with an 81-47 win at Minnesota.
- Purdue's 6-0 Big Ten start marks just the third time in school history that Purdue has started league play 6-0. The 1968-69 (6-0) team that reached the Final Four and the 1989-90 (8-0) squad are the other teams to do so.
- The win was **Matt Painter's** 150th conference victory in his 14 years of coaching (133 - Big Ten; 17 - Missouri Valley). He entered the year averaging 11.1 wins per year in conference play.
- The 34-point margin of victory was the second-largest margin of defeat for Minnesota in Williams Arena history, behind a 90-51 setback to No. 1-ranked UCLA on Dec. 20, 1968.
- **Vincent Edwards** scored 25 points (one shy of career high) with five rebounds and two assist, making a career-high five 3-pointers. He surpassed 1,400 career points in the victory.
- **Carsen Edwards** scored 14 points with a career-high seven assists against zero turnovers.

► 3-Point Stardom

- Purdue has made at least 10 3-pointers in five of its last six games, going 69-of-153 (.451) from deep during that span. During the last two games on the road, Purdue is 26-of-56 (.464) from deep.
- Purdue has catapulted to seventh nationally in 3-point percentage (.415) and 36th in 3-pointers per game (9.8), both tops in the Big Ten.
- Purdue has five players with at least 24 made 3-pointers and all five of them are shooting at least 36.9 percent from deep.
- Purdue's senior trio of **P.J. Thompson**, **Dakota Mathias** and **Vincent Edwards** are a combined 114-of-248 (.460) from long range.

► Purdue Approaching Record Streak

- Purdue moved two spots to No. 3 in the latest AP top-25 poll, matching the Boilermakers' highest ranking since being No. 2 in the final 1987-88 poll.
- Purdue also reached No. 3 during the 2009-10 and 1993-94 seasons.
- Purdue has been ranked in the top 3 in 16 polls all-time and is 24-9 all-time as a top-3 ranked squad (15-4 as No. 2; 9-5 as No. 3).

► **The Highest Ranking**

- With its No. 3 national ranking, Purdue has matched its highest national ranking in the last 30 years.

► **Doing it on Both Ends**

- Purdue has won 13 straight games, including five games against KenPom top-40 teams, using a winning recipe during that span.
- During the streak, Purdue has held foes to 60.5 points per game and has allowed just one foe to score 70 points (Maryland - 75). Opponents are shooting just 37.5 percent from the field.
- Meanwhile on the offensive end, Purdue is averaging 81.5 points per game and shooting 49.3 percent from the field and 40.8 percent from 3-point range in that span.

► **Making Our Statement**

- With Purdue's win over Butler in the Crossroads Classic, the Boilermakers have won six straight games against in-state foes and haven't lost to a team from Indiana since Feb. 20, 2016 (691 days).
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue has defeated six different in-state teams (Butler, IUPUI, Fort Wayne, Notre Dame, Indiana, Valparaiso) and is 11-3 against in-state teams.
- Since the start of last year, Purdue is 21-4 against teams from the state of Indiana and bordering states, including 8-1 this year.
- Just one Indiana school, Evansville (one game; last game in 2005), now holds a winning streak against the Boilermakers.

► **Shooting Wins**

- Purdue has shot at least 44.3 percent from the field in each of the last 11 games, shooting over 50.0 percent from the field in five of the games.
- Purdue has made at least 10 3-pointers in six of the games during Purdue's 12-game winning streak.

► **Big Wins**

- Since the start of last year, Purdue has won 22 games by 20 or more points, the second-highest total nationally. Michigan State's 11 wins by 20 or more points this year leads the country.

- With a trio of Sweet 16 appearances, nine NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 13th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 22 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 25 victories in six seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last 10 years have seen six 25-win seasons and eight NCAA Tournament berths, three Sweet 16 appearances, two regular-season Big Ten titles and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 26 players earn a combined 49 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored a pair of Academic All-Americans in E'Twaun Moore (2010) and Caleb Swanigan (2017)
