#### – AROUND THE HORN –

• Purdue visits Northwestern for the first time since a three-game series in Evanston in April 2012. The Boilermakers have played 147 road/neutral-site games at 43 different fields since last playing at the Wildcats' Miller Park. First-year NU head coach Spencer Allen was a Purdue assistant from 2008 to 2009.  
• The Boilermakers were swept by OSU after scoring just four runs over the three games. Purdue batted .191 in the series while going 3-for-25 with runners in scoring position and 2-for-28 with two outs. Coincidentally, Purdue scored first in all three games. The four runs were the Boilers' fewest in a Big Ten series since also being held to four by OSU in March 2013.  
• Led by **Shane Bryant's** nine strikeouts, which matched his career high and the most Ks by a Purdue pitcher this season, the Boilermakers struck out 15 OSU batters in the series finale. It matched the third most strikeouts in program history. Bryant struck out 9 of the 20 batters he faced over five scoreless innings.  
• The 15 Ks Sunday also led to a statistical oddity for Purdue defensively. First baseman **Kyle Wood** had just one putout and the only defensive assists recorded by Purdue came from catcher **James Jewell** and the pitchers.

- Active career leader in games started and innings pitched; three-time Academic All-Big Ten and 2015 Big Ten Distinguished Scholar honoree.
- Posted his second career quality outing against Maryland, working eight innings of one-run ball in the longest outing of the year by a Purdue pitcher; followed that up with quality start (7 IP, 3 R) in tough-luck loss vs. Ohio State.
- Had a strong start at GSU during 2016 opening weekend but moved to bullpen after rough outings at Cal & ETSU; 4.03 ERA in 22 1/3 innings as a reliever.
- Joined the weekend rotation for the first time in March 2014 and has made 22 of his 32 career starts on weekends.
- Started the 2015 season opener at Western Carolina but did not make another weekend start until Maryland series in April (8+ IP, 1 run allowed entering 9th).
- Led the way in Purdue's 2-1 pitcher's duel win in the middle game at Nebraska last year, inducing 13 ground ball outs over seven innings of one-run ball.
- Worked Purdue's first true complete game since February 2013 in tough-luck loss vs. Ohio State in April 2014, giving up runs in only one inning.
- No. 4 LSU did not score while he was on the mound in first start of 2014.
- True walk-on has been a part of the program since the fall of 2011, but red-shirted in 2012 after not making the official 35-man roster.
- Worked 4 1/3 innings of scoreless two-hit relief in his team debut, a 2013 midweek game vs. Indiana State.
- Helped Carroll High School win back-to-back 4A IHSAA state titles and was the winning pitcher in 2011 title game; all-conference & all-area honoree went 12-1 to tie the CHS wins record as a senior.

- Struck out a career-high seven over five innings of one-run ball at Indiana, leaving the game with Purdue up 5-1. Fanned 6 over 6 1/3 vs. Michigan State.
- Pitched at least seven innings of relief against ETSU and Ohio, helping Purdue win both games; closed out shutout win vs. North Dakota with four innings.
- Gave Purdue back-to-back quality starts against Top 25 teams (Illinois & Iowa) last year, but only received 2 runs of support combined.
- Did not give up a legit hit vs. NIU until the 6th inning last year after retiring 13 of the first 14 batters he faced; did not issue a walk over 6 innings.
- Shined vs Bakersfield in 2015, retiring 15 of 16 batters during one stretch en route to 7 shutout innings of 3-hit ball.
- Enjoyed a strong summer of 2014 in Midwest Collegiate League, where he was named an All-Star & pitched 8 innings of 3-hit ball in a playoff win that sent his DuPage County Hounds to league championship series.
- Took the mound in each of the first 6 weekends as a freshman.
- His father Mike played baseball at Illinois State.

- Led the team in innings pitched, strikeouts and strikeout-to-walk ratio (2.84) in 2015, starting 4 Big Ten games and 4 midweek contests.
- Led Purdue to both of its shutout victories in 2015, midweek home wins vs. Valparaiso and Ball State.
- Shined at home in 2015, going 3-1 with a 2.45 ERA, .262 batting average against and 32 strikeouts in 33 innings over 6 starts at Alexander Field.

## HEAD COACH DOUG SCHREIBER

Since Doug Schreiber was named Purdue's head baseball coach on May 29, 1998, the Boilermakers have become a major force in the Big Ten Conference and have made big strides on a national level.

Currently in his 18th season as the leader of the program, Schreiber is the program's all-time leader in overall wins and Big Ten wins. He eclipsed Dave Alexander's record for games coached (792 over 14 seasons) during the second weekend of the 2013 season. Schreiber played for Alexander at Purdue from 1983-86.

Purdue unveiled its new Alexander Field stadium and facilities during the 2012-13 school year, but the first two seasons at the new ballpark turned out to be rebuilding years for the Boilermakers after losing 15 seniors and three junior MLB draftees from the 2012 Big Ten championship team. As of July 2014, 10 members of the 2012 championship team had signed with MLB organizations at some point in their post-college careers.

In the five seasons between 2008 and 2012, Purdue went 172-110 overall (.610) and 75-51 in Big Ten play (.595). Both records represented the best marks in the league. The Boilermakers were the only conference team to qualify for the Big Ten Tournament each of those five seasons, the longest such streak in program history. Purdue has won at least one game at the Big Ten Tournament in nine of its 10 appearances under Schreiber.

The 2015 Boilermakers won their final five games and six of their last seven, posting their third longest season-ending win streak in program history. Kyle Wood won the team triple crown in 2015, becoming the first hitter to do so since 2007 and the 11th Boilermaker position player since 1970 to accomplish the feat.

After playing six NCAA Regional qualifiers throughout the season, including four opponents that were among the 16 Regional hosts, Purdue's strength of schedule in 2014 ranked among the Top 25 nationally for much of the year. The Boilermakers' eight extra-inning affairs were the most in Schreiber's tenure as well as the most in the Big Ten. Purdue also played in 17 one-run games, but managed just a 5-12 record in those contests.

During its historic 2012 season, Purdue won a program-record 45 games, captured a pair of Big Ten titles, earned the right to host an NCAA Regional and closed out Lambert Field in thrilling fashion. Schreiber was named the Big Ten Coach of the Year after leading the Boilers to the most wins by a Big Ten team since 2008. He won his 400th and program-record 408th career games at Lambert in the spring of 2012. His 408th victory as the leader of the program, April 15 in the finale of a series sweep of Illinois, made him Purdue's all-time wins leader.

The Boilermakers began the 2012 season 14-1, won 10 consecutive games twice, posted their 20th win before April 1 for the first time, reached the 30-win mark at the earliest date (April 20) in program history and won their first Big Ten title since 1909.

Headlined by Kevin Plawecki's selection 35th overall by the New York Mets, Purdue had a program-record seven players picked in the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft. Juniors Plawecki, Cameron Perkins and Nick Wittgren were each selected in the first 10 rounds to give the Boilers three players drafted in the first 300 picks for the first time. Six times since 2006 multiple Boilers have been selected in the same draft. Highlighted by Big Ten Player and Pitcher of the Year honors for Plawecki and Joe Haase, Purdue had a program-high eight all-conference honorees in 2012.

Schreiber has coached 62 All-Big Ten Conference selections, including 22 who were named to the conference's First Team, and has had players selected in the MLB First-Year Player Draft on 32 occasions.

Prior to becoming the head coach at Purdue, Schreiber spent four seasons (1995-98) as the top assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under Pat Murphy at Arizona State University. Schreiber helped guide Arizona State to the College World Series and the national championship game in 1998. All four of Schreiber's recruiting classes at ASU were nationally ranked, including the 1995 class which was ranked No. 1 in the country and the 1996 class, which was tabbed the third best in the nation.

Before going to ASU, Schreiber served as an assistant coach for Murphy at the University of Notre Dame in 1994. That season, the Fighting Irish finished 46-16 and ended the season just two wins shy of Omaha. He began his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Ball State (1991-92) and spent 1993 as an assistant at Butler.

A native of LaPorte, Ind., Schreiber was a four-year starter (1983-86) at second base for the Boilermakers. During his career, Purdue posted a 120-112-2 mark and established a school-record 37 victories his senior season when he was a Second Team All-Big Ten selection. Schreiber still ranks among Purdue's career leaders in a variety of categories, including first all-time in walks (132) and games played (226), sixth in runs scored (159) and tied for eighth in triples (9). He earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in communications and has completed some course work towards a master's in education.

# DOWNES HAS BACK-TO-BACK QUALITY STARTS, BRYANT SHINES AT HOME AGAIN

• Gavin Downs followed up his stellar performance at Maryland (8 IP, 1 R) with another strong outing against Ohio State (7+ IP, 3 R). He became the first Purdue pitcher to record consecutive quality starts this season, working a combined 15 innings of four-run ball in the two Friday outings. The senior will become the first Boilermaker since Robert Ramer (2010-13) to surpass the 200 career innings benchmark this weekend. Downs has pitched 199 1/3 innings over 57 career appearances (32 starts). He has made two career starts against both Maryland and Ohio State, allowing only five runs over 16 innings pitched against both Big Ten rivals.

• **Shane Bryant** has struck out 16 of the 40 batters he faced over his last two starts at Alexander Field. For his career, he has 48 Ks in 46 innings at Purdue's home field. Bryant struck out seven over five innings against Michigan State in the April 17 win and fanned nine over five scoreless innings in the finale of the Ohio State series. Purdue's 15 strikeouts in the game were its most since also fanning 15 in a February 2015 win at East Carolina. Coincidentally, the Boilermakers lost for the third time in the six all-time games in which their pitchers struck out 15-plus hitters.

# MORE PLAYING TIME TURNS INTO MORE PRODUCTION FROM CARLSON, JEWELL

• **Brett Carlson** and **James Jewell** were among Purdue's hottest hitters over the second half of April. Carlson has started 18 of the last 20 games, making 17 of his 27 starts this season in April, a month in which he batted .344 (21-for-61). Jewell has started 10 of the last 11 games and 12 of the last 17. Jewell hit safely in six straight games in which he started from April 17 to 26, going 9-for-22 with four extra-base hits during that stretch. Both players homered twice from April 17 to 22.

• Carlson was batting under .200 for the season entering the April 2 series finale at Penn State, a game in which he delivered a two-out, two-run single in the 12th inning to highlight a three-hit effort. But he really jumpstarted his campaign during the six-game homestand; the senior raised his batting average nearly .100 points from .208 the morning of April 12 to .307 entering the Ohio State weekend. A 16-for-35 showing at the plate over the 10 games from April 12 to 26, a hot stretch that has featured three games with at least three hits, will do that. He became the 12th player in program history with at least three doubles in a game in the series finale at Maryland, and the first since current big leaguer Kevin Plawecki did it in May 2011 at Michigan State.

• Jewell joined **Kyle Johnson** as the only Boilermakers to hit safely in all three games at Maryland. His first three-hit game as a Boilermaker helped lead Purdue to a series-opening win in College Park and he has now homered in both of the team's Big Ten victories this season. His batting average jumped over .100 points from .182 the morning of April 17 to .295 entering the Ohio State series.

# JOHNSON CONSISTENTLY ON BASE

• **Kyle Johnson** reached base safely in 15 consecutive games from April 5 to 29. His reached safely streak matched **Cody Strong** (March 11-April 8) for the longest run on the team this year. Johnson's career-long reached safely streak of 18 straight games was set late last season.

• For the season, Johnson has reached base safely at least once in 37 of Purdue's 41 games. **Harry Shipley** (95 straight games), Johnson (50) and Kyle Wood (47) have all started every game this year and are riding notable consecutive games started streaks dating back to 2015.

# LOTS OF QUALITY LONG RELIEF OUTINGS

• Entering the weekend, Purdue relievers have combined to pitch 203 1/3 of the 358 2/3 innings (57 percent). There have been 19 total relief outings in which a Boilermaker gave up one earned run over or fewer over at least three innings of relief. **Tanner Andrews**, **Eddie De LaRiva**, **Matt Frawley**, **Gavin Downs** and **Brian Ghiselli** each have three such outings. **Tanner Schumacher** has done it twice. Frawley (twice), Andrews and De LaRiva also have what amounts to a quality start in relief this year, working at least seven innings while giving up one run or fewer.

• Meanwhile, there have been four other outings in which a reliever surrendered just two earned runs over at least four innings of relief. In those 23 combined outings that could be deemed quality long relief appearances, Purdue pitchers have combined for a 1.43 ERA, 0.96 WHIP and 2.7 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

# LOSING STREAKS FINALLY SNAPPED

• In April, Purdue ended a pair of losing streaks that reached double figures in length. The Boilermakers' April 17 win vs. Michigan State snapped a program-long 16-game losing streak. Their April 22 win at Maryland ended an 11-game skid in true road games that extended back to March 5.

• During the 16-game losing streak, Purdue dropped four straight games all in one-run fashion (April 8-12) for the first time since May 1956. Seven of the 16 straight losses overall came in one-run affairs, including two in extra innings after the Boilermakers had the lead entering what could have been the final frame. Altogether, Purdue is 2-15 in games decided by two runs or fewer this year.

# CUTTING DOWN RUNNERS AT THE PLATE

• Purdue threw out 18 runners at the plate over a span of 21 games from March 18 to April 20. Ten of those runners were cut down while trying to score on hits that reached the outfield. **Nick Dalesandro** had three outfield assists in the Michigan State series and now leads the team with six this season. **Kyle Johnson** and **Cody Strong** all recorded two outfield assists during that 21-game stretch as well.

## SHIPLEY AMONG TOP DEFENSIVE SHORTSTOPS IN THE BIG TEN

• Sophomore **Harry Shipley** has started 95 consecutive games at shortstop, every game since the start of last season. After leading the Big Ten in defensive assists through the end of the regular season a year ago, he's once again among the top defensive shortstops in the league. He has committed only five errors in 202 defensive chances, his .975 fielding percentage ranking second among full-time Big Ten shortstops. Iowa's Nick Roscetti (three errors, .984) is the only other full-time league shortstop with a fielding percentage above .960. Shipley's 130 defensive assists are sixth most in the conference and he has contributed to 23 of the 31 double plays turned by Purdue.

• Shipley has a career .967 fielding percentage, committing only 16 errors in 491 defensive chances – all at shortstop.

## BIG INNINGS BURNING BOILERMAKERS AGAIN

• Purdue did a decent job of avoiding big innings during the first month of the season, giving up four-plus runs in a frame only twice over the first 15 games. But while compiling a 3-20 record from March 20 to April 26, the Boilermakers witnessed a lot of big numbers go up on the scoreboard against them. Purdue surrendered 173 runs over that 23-game stretch (7.5 per game) and gave up four-plus runs in a frame 13 times. And it actually got worse over the final 9 games of that stretch (7 big innings against).

• Of the 173 runs allowed in the 23 games from March 20 to April 26, 70 (or 40 percent) were scored in the first three innings. And early deficits have been something the Boilermakers have not been able to overcome this season. Purdue is 1-21 when the opposition scores the game's first run.

• Starting pitchers have not been able to go deep for the Boilermakers. Only six times (**Matt Frawley** accounting for three of the outings) has a Purdue starter worked six innings. Conversely, in eight of the Boilers' 34 weekend games, their starter failed to make it through the third inning. Purdue is 1-7 in those eight games where it had to go to the bullpen before the fourth inning.

## SHIPLEY ON BASE SAFELY NINE TIMES IN BLOOMINGTON

• **Harry Shipley** reached base safely nine times in 11 plate appearances in the Indiana series (April 8-10). He was walked, hit by a pitch and scored a run at least once in all three games. He also recorded three hits in the series, driving in the game-tying run with two outs in the eighth inning Sunday for his first RBI of the year. The sophomore became the first Boilermaker to reach base safely nine times in a standard three-game weekend since **Kyle Wood** (11 times) in March of last season at Oklahoma. **Kyle Johnson** and Wood have both done it twice in their careers, earning Big Ten Player of the Week honors once each in the process.

• Dating back to the start of the 2011 season, on 18 occasions a Boilermaker has reached base safely nine times in a three-game weekend. However, among players with a minimum 10 plate appearances for the weekend, only David Miller and Shipley (.818) were able to post an on-base percentage of .800 or better for the series. Miller reached base safely in eight of his 10 plate appearances in a three-game sweep at Lipscomb in March 2011.

• **Kyle Wood** hit his Big Ten-leading 10th home run of the season in the opener of the Indiana series (April 8). He has become the first Boilermaker to post a double-figure home run total since Dan Black hit 15 in 2009. That also makes Wood the first to do it in the BBCOR bat era (2011-present).

• Six of Wood's 10 home runs have been hit to the opposite field (left) plus one additional long ball to straight away center. Wood's nine home runs in March were the most by a Purdue player in a month since Black hit nine in April 2008.

• Wood had an extra-base hit in 10 straight games from March 12 to April 1, matching the longest standard hit streak of his career along the way. He also had an RBI in seven straight games from March 12 to 25, racking up 14 total during that stretch.

• Wood homered nine times in a 14-game stretch in March, including four games in a row from March 19 to 23. He became the first Boilermaker since at least the beginning of the 2005 season to homer in four straight games. Black hit four homers over the course of four consecutive games on three occasions. The week of March 22 to 27, Wood hit a three-run homer at Ball State, a grand slam vs. No. 7 Louisville and another three-run homer vs. Nebraska. He hit for the cycle over the course of the Nebraska series and finished the week 8-for-19 with six extra-base hits and 14 RBI.

• Wood has become just the 16th player in program history to reach the 20 career homers benchmark. He's currently tied for 10th all-time. (24 career).
