The Starting 5 - The Top 5 Storylines For This Game

1. GOING FOR 7-0

A win at Purdue would lift the Wolfpack to a 7-0 start, the first such start for NCSU under Mark Gottfried. NC State is currently 6-0 to start a season for the first time since 2004-05, when the Wolfpack won its first eight games. If this edition of the Wolfpack beats Purdue and gets to 7-0, it would be the 10th time since the start of the ACC (1953-54) that NC State has started a season with a 7-0 mark.

2. EARLY LOOK AT NC STATE'S RESUME

Although its early, NC State is starting to build itself quite the tournament resume. **CBS Sports ranks the Wolfpack 19th in its RPI rating, ESPN.com charts the Pack 22nd.** The Wolfpack has three wins over teams in the top 100, and a fourth over Hofstra (RPI 101). NC State and Miami are the only ACC teams with two victories over current top-30 RPI teams.

4. OPPONENTS FEELING REJECTED

NC State is among the national leaders in blocked shots. The Wolfpack is currently **first in the ACC and tied for seventh in the nation (with Purdue)** with 6.83 blocked shots per game. Led by BeeJay Anya's school-record 10 rejections, NC State recorded 14 blocked shots in a 79-43 win over Jacksonville. The Pack also owns two games with seven blocks and a game with six swats. Anya leads the conference with 23 swats, which is also good for eighth in the nation. Only two teams (Kentucky and Texas) in Power 5 conferences have more blocked shots than NC State.

3. PACK IN THE ACC-BIG TEN CHALLENGE

NC State and Purdue will be reuniting in this the 16th edition of the ACC-Big Ten Challenge. The two teams met in the very first challenge in 1999, with NC State winning 61-59 at Mackey Arena. The Wolfpack also defeated Purdue in 2004. NC State is 6-8 all-time in the event, including a 69-48 rout over Northwestern last season. (NC State didn't play in it in 2008). Historically, the Pack is **113-99 vs. the current membership of the Big Ten.**

5. 3 SEASONS, 3 NCAAS

Mark Gottfried, in his fourth season at NC State, will be working toward mentoring his team into the NCAA Tournament for the fourth straight season. The Wolfpack has made the Big Dance in each of his first three seasons, making Gottfried the first Pack coach and just the fourth in ACC history to achieve that feat. It marks the first time NC State had made three straight tournaments since 2004-06.

18th Season Overall 4th Season at NC State 354-193 (76-38 at NC State)

- Has coached NC State to an NCAA Tournament berth in each of his 3 seasons in Raleigh, the Pack's first time going thrice in a row since 2004-06.
- Is third coach in ACC history to take his first three teams to the NCAA Tournament. (Bill Guthridge and Roy Williams)
- Won 70 games in 3 seasons at NC State, the most at NCSU over a three-year span since 1973-76.
- One of four all-time ACC coaches to lead his team to the ACC Tournament semifinal round in each of his first 3 seasons.
- Won more games in his first 2 seasons with the Pack (48) than any coach in school history except Everett Case (55) in 1947 and 1948.
- His 48 victories was the most for NC State over a two-year span since the early 1980s.
- Posted 24 wins and .667% winning percentage in 2011-12, which was the best all-time in the ACC for first-year head coaches.
- Is one of 14 coaches to capture a win over a team ranked No. 1 at two different schools. (3/20/04 at Alabama and 1/12/13 at NC State).
- Only seven active coaches have taken three different schools to multiple NCAA Tournament appearances
- Has signed four McDonald's All-Americans since coming to NC State.

11 Seasons at Alabama (210-132 overall)

- Coached Alabama to 8 postseason appearances, including 5 consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament (2002-06).
- Led Alabama to a No. 1 ranking during the 2002-03 season.
- Tabbed 2002 SEC Coach of the Year.
- His 2003-04 Alabama squad advanced to the NCAA Elite Eight, the longest tourney run in school history.

3 Seasons at Murray State (68-24 overall)

- Won an OVC title in each of his 3 seasons.
- Named OVC Coach of the Year 3 times.
- Led Murray State to 3 postseason appearances, including a pair of NCAA tourney berths.
- His 1997-98 team earned the highest NCAA seed in OVC history (#9 seed).

A 7-0 'MARK'

Prior to this season, Mark Gottfried had begun a season 7-0 or better four times in his coaching career. At Alabama, he started the 2006-07 season 7-0. He coach Alabama to 9-0 starts in 2002-03 and 2000-01. His last Murray State team (1997-98) also started that season 9-0.

NC STATE ON THE ROAD

The Pack is no stranger to winning on the road. Last year's road wins were a key ingredient to getting NC State into the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Last season, NC State won at Tennessee, Notre Dame, Miami and Pittsburgh to highlight an impressive resume away from home.

PACK VS. PURDUE

NC State is **4-0 all-time vs. Purdue with a 2-0 record in the ACC-Big Ten Challenge**. The Wolfpack won at Purdue in 1999 and the 1974 national title team got 26 points from David Thompson in an 86-81 at Purdue in January 1974.

'MARK-EY' ARENA...

Mark Gottfried is quite familiar with Purdue's Mackey Arena. He took his 2001 Alabama team to Purdue for the NIT and won 85-77. That Bama team ended up in Madison Square Garden in the NIT semifinal. In Gottfried's first season as a head coach, he took Murray State to Purdue in 1995. In his third game as a head coach, he beat Drexel at Mackey before losing the next night to a Purdue team that would eventually be a Number 1 seed in the 1996 NCAA tourney.

...**MORE ABOUT 1996**

Not only did Mark Gottfried's Murray State team play at Purdue, but assistants Bobby Lutz and Orlando Early each faced that '96 Purdue team that same year. Lutz, then an assistant at Charlotte, played Purdue in the Bahamas and was edged 73-67. Early, then an assistant at Western Carolina, was a 16-seed in the 1996 NCAA taking on top seed Purdue. Early's 16-seed squad was edged 73-71.

WOLFPACK GUARD PLAY

One strength for NC State is the team's backcourt. Cat Barber, Trevor Lacey and Ralston Turner are the team's leading scorers, with the trio combining to score 43.6 points per game. Each player has at least one game with 23 points or more. Barber poured in a career-high 25 points with six rebounds and six assists against Jackson State and Turner went for a career-high 24 vs. Hofstra. Lacey scored 22 points (20 in the first half) against Jackson State and led NCSU with 21 points vs. South Florida. Barber and Lacey are also the team's primary ballhandlers.

MORE ON TREVOR

Trevor Lacey, who Mark Gottfried calls "a coach on the floor", provides leadership on and off the court for NC State. **Lacey is averaging 17.3 points and 6.5 rebounds per game** while leading State in minutes played (33.5). Lacey opened the season with 22 points vs. Jackson State and then added a double-double (16 pts, 10 rebs) vs. Hofstra. He has led NC State in scoring with 21 points vs. USF and 26 vs. Richmond.

LACEY LATE

Trevor Lacey made the three biggest plays of the game at the end of NC State's win over Boise State. Leading 55-54, NC State went to Lacey, who drove to the basket for a lay-up at the 1:05 mark. After a stop, Lacey buried a step-back jumper to put NC State up 59-54 with 29 seconds left. He then grabbed the game-icing defensive rebound on the next possession.

DEFENSIVE RESULTS

The Wolfpack is currently 24 in the nation in effective FG defense (.405) and seventh in the country in blocked shots (6.83). The Pack held its first three opponents to worse than 31 percent shooting. Jacksonville shot just .232 against the Pack, the lowest field goal percentage for an opponent since Jan. 9, 2008 vs. NC Central (.203). NC State blocked 14 Jacksonville shots while allowing just 13 made baskets.

LENNARD DOING HIS THING

Lennard Freeman has quietly been one of NC State's most productive players. Freeman, now sixth in the ACC with 8.8 rebounds per game, has **grabbed 50 rebounds over the past five contests**. He pulled in 13 rebounds vs. Hofstra, had a double-double vs. Jacksonville (10 pts, 12 rebs) and then grabbed 10 boards against USF. Freeman is ninth in the ACC in offensive rebounds and seventh in defensive rebounds.

TREVOR MOVING HIS FEET

Trevor Lacey is almost always on the court for NC State, averaging 33.5 minutes per game. He ranks third in the ACC in minutes played. Despite playing all those minutes, Lacey has been whistled for just eight personal fouls.

#CAT12

Anthony 'Cat' Barber is becoming a force for NC State as the team's starting point guard. Barber, who averaged 8.5 points per game and started 18 times last season, is scoring 12.5 points per game this season. Mark Gottfried has also called Barber "one of the best on-the-ball defenders I've coached." Barber drew a team-best 16 charges last season.

BOARD WORK

NC State is much improved on the glass. NC State ranked 326th in the nation in defensive rebounding percentage (64.3%) last season. After six games, that number has improved to 75.9%, **which ranks fourth in the ACC**. NC State currently leads the ACC in defensive rebounds per game with 33.0. Individually, NC State is led on the boards by Lennard Freeman. The 6-8 sophomore is pulling in 8.8 rebounds per game.

NO LOSS NOVEMBER

The Wolfpack finished 6-0 in November, raising its mark to **19-6 in the month under Mark Gottfried.** The Pack, now 6-0 this season, went 4-2 in November 2013 and 2012 and 5-2 in November 2011. NC State owns a 36-9 record in November games dating back to 2007.

LENGTH AND (LESS) WIDTH

BeeJay Anya is one of the largest players in college basketball. He's actually trimmed down considerably, having **lost nearly 60 pounds** since last season. But it's his wingspan that sets him apart. He has a measured wingspan of 7-9, **the longest wingspan recorded in the NBA Draft Express database** for basketball prospects.

RALSTON PASSES 1,000

Fifth-year senior Ralston Turner passed the 1,000-point mark for his career in the season opener. He enters Tuesday's game with 1,075 career points, 456 of which have come at NCSU. Turner has made 360 field goals in his career (153 at NC State), 185 of them from 3-point range. He's made 90 treys at NC State. Turner struck for a career-best 24 points against Hofstra and made five 3-pointers. Turner, in his fifth year after playing two seasons at LSU before coming to State, averaged 10.5 points per game last season.

SCHEDULE TOUGH

Mark Gottfried will tell you last year's tough schedule was the difference in NC State playing in the NCAA Tournament instead of the NIT. **NC State's 2013-14 schedule was ranked 21st toughest in the nation.** Mark Gottfried has adopted a similar philosophy this season, scheduling nine teams who played in the 2014 NCAA Tournament.

LOOK AT THIS SCHEDULE!

It's possible NC State won't have another "easy" game for the rest of the season. After playing at Purdue this week, it hosts league rival Wake Forest. Charleston Southern already won at Ole Miss and Wofford is a 2014 NCAA tourney team, as are Tennessee and Cincinnati. Louisiana Tech won 29 games last season as well. And that's before NC State starts play in the ACC.

TREVOR 3RD ON THE BOARDS

In addition to his scoring, ballhandling and leadership, Trevor Lacey is a great rebounder from the guard position, averaging 6.5 boards per game. He is third among ACC guards in rebounding, behind Notre Dame's Pat Connaughton and FSU's Montay Brandon.

ACC's KING OF TWITTER

Last season, The Sporting News evaluated the prominent college basketball coaches related to their presence on Twitter. TSN named Mark Gottfried (@Mark_Gottfried) the ACC's King of Twitter. As of this week, Gottfried has 33,684 followers. He ranks 14th among college coaches in Twitter followers.

@PACKMENSBBALL RANKING

As a team, the NC State Twitter account boasts 34,134 followers. That total ranks 15th in all of college basketball.

CHIP OFF THE OLD BLOCK

There's a familiar name on NC State's bench this season. Chris Corchiani, Jr., is a freshman guard on this year's team after walking on to the squad over the summer. He is the son of former Wolfpack standout Chris Corchiani, who played at State from 1987-91. The elder Corchiani graduated as the NCAA's all-time leader in assists and is NC State's all-time leader in steals.

In addition to the third-year NC State coach, the Wolfpack are mentored by three other former head coaches. Associate coach Bobby Lutz won 399 games as a head coach at Charlotte and Pfeiffer, Orlando Early was the head coach for five seasons at Louisiana-Monroe and Dereck Whittenburg ran the programs at Wagner and Fordham.

COME TO STATE. STAY AT STATE

Mark Gottfried was hired at NC State in April of 2011, and he built his staff. That staff has stayed in place now going into its fourth season, with that continuity playing a part in NC State's success. In the ACC, only Miami, Syracuse and Notre Dame join NC State as schools that have had their head coach and three main assistants together the last four years.

ALL-TIME TOP 25

NC State is 25th on the all-time winningest programs list for NCAA Division I. In its 105th season, NCSU has won 1,645 men's basketball games. The ACC boasts six of the top 25 teams on the victories list (North Carolina 2,119; Duke 2,034; Syracuse 1,906; Notre Dame 1,769; Louisville 1,734; **NC State 1,645**).

TERRY'S GOT NEXT

In recent years, college basketball has seen hundreds of players transfer schools each offseason. NC State continues to play that game well, picking up a third impact transfer in three years. Terry Henderson, a Raleigh native who scored 11.7 points per game at West Virginia last season, has come to NC State and will be eligible next season. Henderson joins current starters Ralston Turner and Trevor Lacey as impact transfers for Mark Gottfried.


