### THE SCENE SETTER

- The Purdue men's basketball team returns home for the first time in 13 days as Maryland visits for the Big Ten home opener on Thursday in Mackey Arena.
- The contest will be televised on BTN with **Kevin Kugler** and **Jon Crispin** calling the action courtside, beginning at 7 p.m. ET.
- On the radio waves, the contest will be available on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com, with **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** on the call, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show at 6 p.m.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com, and as always, Twitter updates will be available on Purdue's official account (@BoilerBall).
- Purdue is looking for its first Big Ten win of the season and aiming to snap a two-game losing streak in the process.
- Purdue returns to the road for its next two games as the gauntlet continues at Texas on Sunday and Notre Dame on Dec. 15.

### THE TWO TEAMS

- Purdue is 5-3 having suffered back-to-back losses to No. 15 Florida State and No. 7-ranked Michigan. The Boilermakers are now facing a ranked team in their third consecutive game for the first time since Feb. 26 - March 5, 2014 (Michigan, Iowa, Wisconsin).
- Purdue has struggled offensively the last two games, shooting just 38.9 percent from the field and averaging 64.5 points. It has, however, come against defenses ranked in the top 13 (Michigan - 1; Florida State - 13).
- **Carsen Edwards** and **Ryan Cline** combine to average 39.6 points per game, making the duo the third-highest major-college scoring duo in America (Duke, Gonzaga).
- Maryland enters with a 7-1 record with the lone loss coming to No. 4-ranked Virginia.
- The Terrapins boast perhaps the league's best inside punch in **Bruno Fernando** (15.4 PPG, 10.0 RPG) and **Jalen Smith** (12.6 PPG, 7.3 RPG).
- Maryland shoots 60.1 percent from inside the 3-point line, good for seventh nationally.

### THE TALKING POINTS

- There have been 29 NBA scout tickets distributed for Thursday's game, coming from 21 teams.
- Purdue is looking to avoid an 0-2 Big Ten start for the first time since the 2013-14 season (Ohio State, Minnesota).
- According to KenPom.com, Purdue's schedule currently ranks as the 19th-most difficult in America. Among teams in KenPom's top 20, only Kansas, Duke and Wisconsin have played tougher schedules.
- Purdue and Wofford are the only schools in America to have two players with 25 or more 3-pointers. **Ryan Cline** has 31 triples while **Carsen Edwards** has 29 trifectas.
- Purdue is 32-4 in Big Ten play at home since the start of the 2014-15 season. The record is the best in the league by 2.5 games (Michigan State; 30-7).
- **Ryan Cline** is 27 of 53 (.509) from 3-point range in the last six games.
- **Carsen Edwards** has scored at least 19 points in every game this season.

### THE SERIES

- Purdue leads the all-time series with Maryland by a 4-2 margin, having won four straight in the series.
- The two teams had never met prior to Maryland joining the Big Ten before the 2014-15 season.
- Despite trailing in the series, Maryland has outscored Purdue by two points (434-432). Five of the six meetings have been determined by single-digits and the last four Purdue wins have come by a combined 18 points (4, 1, 5, 8 points).
- In six of the seven games, at least one team has entered the contest as a ranked opponent. Maryland is 23rd this year.

- After starting the season with a 5-1 record and scoring at least 79 points in all six games, the Purdue offense has come back to Earth some. The Boilermakers haven't scored more than 72 points in either of its last two games.

### TRIPLES COME IN BUNCHES

- Purdue has opened the season by making 93 3-pointers in the first eight games, the most in the first eight games in school history.
- Based on a 35-game schedule, Purdue is on pace to make 407 3-pointers. The Big Ten record is 361 set by Michigan in each of the last two seasons.
- A deeper dive reveals that Purdue has taken 48.9 percent of its field goal attempts from behind the arc, good for 13th nationally and second among power schools (Villanova). The next power-6 team after Auburn at 46.8 percent (29th).

• The loss snapped a streak of 27 straight games of winning when winning 48.0 percent from the field.

• Purdue is 138-15 under Painter when over 48.0 percent shooting.

• Purdue has won nine straight games against in-state foes, last losing to a team from the state on Indiana on Feb. 20, 2016 (Indiana, 77-73).

- **Sasha Stefanovic** has made a 3-pointer in six straight games, shooting 9 of 20 (.450) during that span.

## HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 300-152 (.664) / 14th year | **Career Record:** 325-157 (.674) / 15th year

- With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 13 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year, the average balloons to 23.8 wins per year over the last 12 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
- Purdue's four Sweet 16 appearances in the last 10 years are the ninth most nationally.
