PURDUE FACES AUBURN IN CANCUN CHALLENGE TITLE GAME

- The No. 17-ranked Purdue men's basketball team battles Auburn in the Cancun Challenge title game Wednesday night at the Hard Rock Hotel in Riviera Maya, Mexico. Tip is scheduled for 8:30 p.m. ET, and the contest will be televised by the CBS Sports Network.
- This will be the third meeting between the two teams. Auburn won in the 1985 NCAA Tournament (59-58), while Purdue returned the favor in the 2001 NIT Tournament (79-61). Purdue is 12-4 all-time against the state of Alabama and 38-25 all-time against the SEC.
- Auburn guard **Ronnie Johnson** played for Purdue during the 2012-13 and 2013-14 seasons. He averaged 10.9 points and 3.9 assists in 66 career games with 59 starts.
- Purdue has won eight straight, in-season tournament games dating to the 2014 EASports Maui Invitational. In the 2014 event, Purdue won its last two games vs. Missouri and BYU, won all four games in last year's Hall of Fame Tipoff Classic (North Carolina A&T, Vermont, Old Dominion, Florida) and two this year in the Cancun Challenge (Georgia State, Utah State).
- Purdue is also searching for its second straight, non-conference tournament title after winning the Hall of Fame Tipoff Classic last year. A win tonight would be Purdue's third tournament title under Coach Painter, having defeated Tennessee, coached by **Bruce Pearl**, in the 2009 Paradise Jam.
- Over the last 54 games dating to 2014-15, Purdue is 39-15 (.722), after starting the 2014-15 season with an 11-8 record.
- In last night's win over Utah State, Purdue recorded runs of 7-0, 8-0, 9-0 and 10-0. In four games this year, Purdue has already had runs to 10-0, 16-0, 17-0 and 20-0. Opponents have had zero runs of 10-0 or longer.
- The Boilermakers had two players score 25 points in the same game for the first time since Nov. 21, 2010, vs. Oakland (26 by **E'Twaun Moore**, 25 by **JaJuan Johnson**). **Isaac Haas** scored 26 points and **Dakota Mathias** had 25 points in the win over Utah State -- both career highs.
- Purdue's junior class accounted for 64 of its 85 points last night against Utah State and is now averaging 51.3 points per game combined. The group is accounting for 61.4 percent of the Boilermakers' scoring.
- For the first time this season, Purdue won both the rebounding (+4) and turnover (+5) margins when it accomplished it against Utah State. Purdue is now 90-8 under **Matt Painter** when doing so.
- Purdue has made 22 more free throws (79) than opponents have shot (57). Purdue is outscoring foes at the free throw line by an average of 9.5 points per game.
- Purdue made a season-high 11, 3-pointers against Utah State. Purdue is now 38-8 under Painter when making 10 or more trifectas in a game, having won 10 straight games.
- Purdue is 117-4 under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the losses came during the 2012-13 season.
- Purdue is now 54-14 under Coach Painter in the month of November.
- Purdue is 99-13 under **Matt Painter** when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the field. When foes shoot 48.0 percent or better, Purdue is 16-55 (1-1 this year).
- Purdue's bench is averaging just 15.5 points per game, while shooting just 19.2 percent (5-of-26) from 3-point range. The Boilermakers' reserves have been outscored 75-33 (25.0 to 11.0) over the last three games.
- **Caleb Swanigan** and **Isaac Haas** have combined to score 158 points this year, averaging 39.5 points per game and shooting 51-of-79 (.646) between them. The duo has also shot 77 (19.3 per game) free throws between them. The duo also has five combined 20-point games between them, after having just four among them entering this year.
- **Caleb Swanigan** recorded his third double-double in four games against Utah State, totaling 15 points and 10 rebounds. He now has 11 career double-doubles. When he has a double-double, Purdue is 10-1 during his career. When Swanigan leads the team in rebounding during his career, the Boilermakers are 16-4. Swanigan is fifth nationally in rebounding (12.3) and is 1-of-4 players nationally to average 15.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg and 3.0 apg.
- **Isaac Haas** leads the Boilermakers in scoring at 20.3 points per game and is shooting 28-of-36 (.778) from the field, ranking sixth nationally in field goal percentage. In the win over Utah State, Haas scored a career-high 26 points in 26 minutes, the ninth time in his career that he has averaged at least 1.00 point / minute in a single game. So far this year, Haas has scored 81 points in 91 minutes (35.6 points / 40 minutes). Last year, he led the Big Ten in points / 40 minutes (27.4).
- **Dakota Mathias** recorded career highs in points (25), rebounds (6), minutes played (35) and 3-pointers made (6) in the win over Utah State. Since the start of February 2016, Mathias is 31-of-62 (.500) from long distance during that span. For this season, Mathias is 1-of-9 players nationally to have had 20 3-point attempts and shot at least 57.0 percent from deep.
- Purdue is 24-8 when **Vincent Edwards** scores at least 10 points in a contest. He scored 10 points in the win over Utah State, going 2-of-3 from long distance. He is now 7-of-16 (.438) from long distance this season and is shooting 53-of-129 (.411) from deep since the start of last season. Edwards is the only junior in America to have recorded 700 career points, 350 rebounds, 200 assists and made 75 3-pointers.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 241-135 (.641) / 12th year | **Career Record:** 266-140 (.655) / 13th year

- With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, eight NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 12th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in eight seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 24 players earn a combined 44 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.
