THE OPENING TIP

- The No. 4-ranked Purdue Boilermakers aim for their fifth win in a row as the Michigan Wolverines come to Mackey Arena for the team's first of two meetings in a span of six days. The Boilermakers enter the contest just one full game behind Illinois in the Big Ten regular-season title race and the events of the next eight days will go a long way toward determining Purdue's status among the league favorites.
- Purdue enters with a 19-3 mark, while Michigan is 11-8. The Wolverines own top-50 wins over San Diego State and Indiana on the road.
- The contest will be televised on FOX with **Tim Brando** and **Nick Bahe** on the call. On the radio waves, **Rob Blackman** and **Bobby Riddell** will be courtside on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on StatBroadcast.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

THE NOTES TO KNOW

- A win would give **Matt Painter** his 400th career victory (25 at Southern Illinois, 374 at Purdue).
- The Boilermakers have already surpassed last year's win total with nine regular-season games remaining (18-10 last season).
- Since Feb. 1, 2021, Purdue is the only team nationally without a double-digit loss. Purdue's seven losses in that span have come by 1, 3, 9 (ot), 9 (ot), 2, 5 and 3 points. In regulation games only, Purdue's five losses in that span are 1, 3, 2, 5 and 3 points.
- Zach Edey** and **Jaden Ivey** were named to the Wooden Award late-season top-20 list. Ivey was tabbed one of 10 finalists for the West Award given to the nation's best shooting guard, while Edey is one of 10 finalists for the Abdul-Jabbar Award given to the nation's top center.
- Purdue needs just one win for 1,000 in Big Ten regular-season games. It would be the first program to reach that mark.
- Michigan is the lone team that the senior class (Hunter Jr., Stefanovic, Williams, Wulbrun) has not defeated.
- Purdue leads the Big Ten in scoring, field goal percentage, 3-point percentage, 3-pointers made, rebound margin and assists.
- Saturday's game marks the 150th at Mackey Arena against Big Ten opposition under **Matt Painter**. The Boilermakers are 116-33 (.779).
- Purdue leads the country in offensive efficiency (125.7) and has been held under 1.00 points / possession just once (Indiana - 0.98).
- Purdue has trailed by double-digits in just three games this year (Villanova, North Carolina State, Indiana) and won two of them.
- Since 2014-15, Purdue is 34-15 (.694) during the month of February, having won four straight games in the month, all by double-digits.
- Purdue's six quad-1 victories are the sixth most in America and its 6-2 (.750) record is the fifth-best percentage.

• Going further beyond the 10 games listed, Purdue is just 5-12 in the last 17 meetings against Michigan. However, a ranked Purdue team hasn't lost at home to an unranked Michigan squad since 2003.

• Coach Painter's teams at Purdue are 47-0 when reaching the three shooting levels.																																		

BEST SHOOTING TEAM IN SCHOOL HISTORY?

- Purdue has never had a season where it shot 50-40-70 from the three levels, but is trying to do that this year.
- Purdue's 50.7 field goal percentage is currently the program's best since shooting 52.2 percent during the 1989-90 season. It has shot over 49.0 percent just once since 1989-90 (2017-18 season; .493).
- Purdue's 41.6 percent from long range currently ranks third in school history (1987-88 was at .440; 2017-18 was at .420).
- Purdue is the only power-conference team to rank in the top 20 in the NCAA in field goal percentage and 3-point percentage.

SNIPERS UNITE

- Purdue has a lethal frontline, but has surrounded that frontline with some serious 3-point arsenal. Purdue has seven players that are over 40.0 percent from long distance and another, **Brandon Newman**, that definitely has the capability.

- Purdue has shot at least 40.0 percent from 3-point range in 15-of-22 games, the second-highest total nationally (South Dakota State - 16; **Purdue** - 14).

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
 - He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
 - Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
 - Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
 - Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
 - Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
 - Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
 - Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
 - Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
 - Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
 - Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
 - Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
 - Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
 - Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
