• The Big Ten baseball schedule may be a conference-only slate this season, but there will be a bit of a non-conference feel to the opening-weekend series between Purdue and Nebraska at the Triple-A stadium near Austin. That's because the Huskers and Boilermakers have only played four games against each other dating back to April 2016. They're also led by a pair of second-year head coaches in Will Bolt and Greg Goff. Purdue was scheduled to host Nebraska in April of last season before the shutdown. The Boilermakers were also originally scheduled to play at Dell Diamond last weekend for the annual Round Rock Classic, a four-team tournament that ultimately featured Auburn, Baylor, Oklahoma and Texas A&M this season.

# HEAD COACH GREG GOFF

Greg Goff joined Purdue baseball as an assistant coach in July 2017 and was promoted to head coach in June 2019. The 2020 season will be his 15th as a collegiate head coach.

Previously a head coach at four universities, Goff succeeded his friend and longtime colleague Mark Wasikowski, who returned to the University of Oregon as the Ducks' new head coach in June 2019.

Goff has previously served as the head coach at Campbell University (2008-14), Louisiana Tech University (2015-16) and the University of Alabama (2017) as well as Division II University of Montevallo (2004-07). He also helped lead the Boilermakers to a memorable 38-win season in 2018, punctuated by the program's third NCAA Regional bid in program history. Purdue finished second in the Big Ten standings and was also the runner-up at the Big Ten Tournament in Goff's first year with the program.

Along with bringing an upbeat personality to the dugout and contagious energy to his role as the first-base coach, Goff helped numerous Boilermakers develop offensively the last two years. He played a leading role in coaching the base running and outfield defense. He also filled in as the program's pitching coach for a few games during a 2018 home sweep of Michigan while Steve Holm was with his wife for the birth of their second child. Purdue has compiled a 28-15 record at Alexander since Goff joined the coaching staff, headlined by a program-record 13-game home win streak to close the 2018 campaign. That represents Purdue's best two-year mark at home since 2011 to 2012.

In his first two years at Purdue, Goff helped develop and organize new community events for the program like the preseason fan fest and first pitch dinner. Both events proved very popular and helped generate preseason interest going into the new campaign. He has also served as the director of Purdue baseball camps.

Twenty-six Boilermakers registered a grade-point average of 3.0 or better during the 2019 fall semester. During the 2016-17 school year, Alabama's 3.259 team GPA established a program record.

Over 40 Purdue players completed at least 10 hours of community service during the 2019 fall semester as part of the program's increased emphasis in that aspect of the student-athlete experience. As a team, Goff's team logged over 450 hours of community service during the first half of the 2019-20 school year.

Goff and his wife, Tina, are the parents of four daughters: Kara, Kiley, Kolby and Kenzie. Kara plays softball at Louisiana Tech and Kiley joined Purdue softball for the 2020-21 school year.

## SIX 40-WIN SEASONS

- As a head coach, Goff's teams have won over 40 games six times. Campbell was one of only eight Division I programs to win 40-plus games for three straight years from 2012 to 2014, posting 131 total victories during that span. The Camels enjoyed a historic 49-10 campaign in 2013.
- He also won 42 games in his final season at Louisiana Tech, helping lead the Bulldogs to an NCAA Regional bid.
- Montevallo was a DII College World Series qualifier in 2006 under his guidance. As an assistant coach at Delta State, the Statesmen also qualified for the DII College World Series in 1994 and 1996.

## ENDED NCAA REGIONAL DROUGHTS AT CAMPBELL & LOUISIANA TECH

- In Goff's final season at Campbell (2014), the Camels qualified for their first NCAA Regional in 24 years. Two years later, he led Louisiana Tech to its first Regional bid in 29 years. The 2014 Camels and 2016 Bulldogs both won at least one game in their Regionals, with La Tech coming through the loser's bracket to reach a Regional final at Mississippi State.

## HISTORY OF TURNAROUNDS

- Goff's teams have had a losing record only five times in his 14 years as a head coach. Four of those five seasons were his first at a respective university. He has led his teams to some impressive turnarounds.
- In just two seasons, Louisiana Tech went from 15-35 the year before Goff's arrival to 42-20 in 2016, ending a 29-year NCAA Regional drought in the process. At Campbell, he inherited a team that was 11-45 in 2007. But under Goff, the Camels posted a winning record (27-24) in his second season and won 40 games by his fifth year (2012).
- Purdue's win total also jumped from 29-27 in 2017 to 38-21 in Goff's first year on the staff in 2018.

## COACHING HONORS

- Goff was named the South Central Region Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association at both Louisiana Tech (2016) and Montevallo (2006). He was the 2013 Big South Coach of the Year at Campbell after leading his team to a school-record 49 wins and a conference title. Montevallo won a combined 100 games over his final two seasons, posting a new single-season record both years.

## BEFORE BECOMING A HEAD COACH

- Goff has coached 10 future big leaguers and over 50 MLB Draft picks, highlighted by Cy Young award winner Brandon Webb while he was the pitching coach at Kentucky (2000-03). Longtime big leaguer and World Series champion Joe Blanton also pitched for Goff at Kentucky.
- Along with his years as the pitching coach at Kentucky, Goff served as an assistant at Southeast Missouri State (1998-99) and his alma mater Delta State (1994-97) before becoming a head coach for the first time in the summer of 2003 at Montevallo. It was at SMO in the late 1990s where he first worked with Wasikowski. They helped lead the Redhawks to an NCAA Regional in 1998.

- **Greg Goff** on Purdue's veteran lineup: "We preach it all the time – eliminate doubt and fear. Play at your best, let your instincts take over. Experience and age is something you can't put a price tag on. Those are some of the reasons why we'll be better."
- **Trent Johnson** on how he stayed sharp and worked to improve during the shutdown: "You've got to look at your own game and think 'where can I improve.' I worked a lot on my changeup, trying to add that third pitch I can throw in any count. Be able to reliably throw it for a strike."
- **Cory Brooks** on his battles with the Purdue hitters this school year: "We've got some guys that have some serious juice in their bats. And we've got guys returning like **Skyler Hunter** and **Ben Nisle** that are gamers. They're going to get hits when it matters and have good long at-bats."

## NOTABLES FROM THE 2020 OPENING WEEKEND

- Purdue was victorious in three of four in the series with Hofstra, winning a four-game set for the first time since sweeping Santa Clara on the 2017 spring break trip. The 2020 team joined the 2003, 2012 and 2018 Boilermakers as those this century to win at least three games during a season-opening weekend. After sweeping its three games as the champions of the Campbell Invitational the following weekend, Purdue started the season 6-1.
- The Boilermakers scored four-plus runs in an inning four times vs. Hofstra, accomplishing the feat once in each game. The last time Purdue pulled that off in one weekend was April 2017 vs. Indiana.
- In the series finale, the Boilermakers gave up five-plus runs in an inning and still won for the first time since beating Northwestern 8-7 in May 2018 at Alexander Field.
- All three of Purdue's wins in the series were in comeback fashion. The Boilermakers scored five times in eighth inning Friday, nine times over the seventh and eighth innings Saturday night, and responded with a four-run rally Sunday after Hofstra scored eight in the top of the frame. Purdue had not won three games in which it trailed in the same weekend since March 2012 at Murray State.
- **Kyle LaPlante** delivered the three-run double to give Purdue the lead in the eighth inning of the season opener. The following day, he hit the Boilermakers' first home run of the season. In doing so, he became the first newcomer to account for the team's first homer since **Ben Nisle** did it as a freshman in 2018.
- **Miles Simington's** first hit as a Boilermaker was a grand slam in game 3 of the series. He connected for Purdue's first grand slam since Nick Dalesandro in April 2017 vs. Indiana.
- Fellow newcomer and transfer **Mason Gavre** also started the season opener. He delivered an RBI single in his first at-bat as a Boilermaker, accounting for Purdue's first hit and RBI of the season.
- **Jett Jackson** and **Jackson Smeltz** both made their collegiate debuts as starting pitchers, taking the ball for each end of Saturday's doubleheader. They became the Boilermakers' first pitchers since 2013 to debut as part of the rotation during the season-opening weekend.
