►►► **THE NUMBERS (AS OF MARCH 2):** A look at Purdue's numbers entering the UCLA contest.

►►► **THE FINAL TIME:** Purdue ends its home season on Tuesday night, hosting Rutgers on Senior Day.

- The Boilermakers are 13-2 at home this season and 29-2 at home over the last two campaigns.
- During the senior class' career at Mackey Arena, Purdue owns a 59-5 (.922) record.
- With a win over Rutgers, the Class of 2025 can become the fifth class in school history with 60 home wins (2019, 2018, 2011, 2010).

►►► **WELCOME TO THE BIG TEN:** With its win over UCLA on Friday night, Purdue went 4-0 this season against the West Coast teams, one-of-two teams to be undefeated against Oregon, UCLA, USC and Washington (Michigan is the other).

►►► **WE SHALL CALL IT A DOZEN:** Purdue won its 12th Big Ten game of the season on Friday night, now having won at least 12 league games for the 10th time in the last 11 seasons. The Boilermakers went 9-11 during the 2019-20 season for their lone season of not having 12 wins.

- Purdue has won at least 12 league games in five straight seasons.
- Purdue (2015-25) and Wisconsin (2007-17) are the only programs in Big Ten history to have had 10, 12-win seasons in an 11-year span.
- Purdue's is also the only program in league history to have had two different, 5-year spans of 12-win seasons (2015-19; 2021-25).

THE BIG NUMBER

Trey Kaufman-Renn needs 25 points to become the third Boilermaker this season to reach 1,000 career points.

►►► **THE LEADERS:** Purdue's has shot at least 50.0 percent from the field in 12 of 18 Big Ten contests. In league games only, Purdue leads the Big Ten in field goal percentage (.499), while USC is second at 48.4 percent.

- Purdue leads the Big Ten (league games only) in 3-point percentage (.373) and steals (7.6) and is second in turnover margin (+2.94).
- In league games only, **Trey Kaufman-Renn** is first in the Big Ten in scoring, while **Braden Smith** leads in assists again and is second in steals.
- **Braden Smith's** 8.6 assists per game average in league play would rank as the highest in Big Ten history (2019 - **Cassius Winston**, 7.9).

►►► **THE RECORD-SETTERS:** Purdue players have set long-standing career records in the three major statistical categories during the last two seasons.

- **Zach Edey** broke a 54-year scoring record a year ago, previously set by **Rick Mount** in 1970.
- **Zach Edey** broke a 44-year rebounding record a year ago, previously set by **Joe Barry Carroll** in 1980.
- And on Friday, **Braden Smith** broke a 48-year assists record, previously set by **Bruce Parkinson** in 1977.

►►► **ON THE CUSP:** Point guard **Braden Smith** needs just four assists to become the first player in NCAA history to have scored at least 1,250 points, dish out 700 assists and grab 500 rebounds by the end of his junior campaign.

►►► **500-POINT PACE:** **Trey Kaufman-Renn** (567) and **Braden Smith** (465) are on pace to become the first Purdue teammates since 2017-18 (**Carsen Edwards**, **Isaac Haas**) to both have at least 500 points in a season, on pace for almost 1,300 combined points.

• **Fletcher Loyer** is on pace to surpass 475 points. Purdue hasn't had three 475-point scorers since 2017-18 (Edwards, Edwards, Haas).

▶▶▶ INSIDE THE SERIES		
• Purdue and Rutgers meet for the 24th time in school history with Purdue holding a 17-6 advantage. The Boilermakers have won four games in a row in the series for the first time since the 2017-18 to 2018-19 seasons.		
• It has been a series of streaks. The Boilermakers won 10 straight from 1982 to 2019, but then Rutgers won four in a row from Jan. 2020 to Dec. 2021. Purdue's current run of four straight was preceded by a Rutgers streak of the Knights winning five of six games.		
• Purdue hasn't lost against Rutgers when scoring at least 77 points, posting a 12-0 record when reaching 77 points.

►►► **GIVE ME 30:** The duo of **Trey Kaufman-Renn** and **Braden Smith** became the first Purdue duo to both have 30 points in a game in the same season since **JaJuan Johnson** and **E'Twaun Moore** both surpassed 30 points during the 2010-11 season.

►►► **TRIO PICKS UP THE PACE:** The trio of **Braden Smith**, **Fletcher Loyer** and **Trey Kaufman-Renn** are averaging 54.5 points per game over the last nine games, accounting for 70.0 percent of Purdue's scoring in that span (545 of 779 points).

►►► **THE RUN TRACKER:** Purdue is 66-4 in its last 70 games when owning a run of 10-0 or larger, with losses to Fairleigh Dickinson (2023), Auburn, Wisconsin and Indiana (2025).

►►► **GIVE ME 20:** Purdue has now won at least 20 games in 15 of **Matt Painter's** 20 seasons at Purdue, the most 20-win seasons in school history (Painter - 15; **Gene Keady** - 14; **Lee Rose** - 2).

►►► **THE CENTURY MARK:** **Braden Smith** and **Fletcher Loyer** have started every game of their career becoming the sixth and seventh players to have started 100 consecutive games in school history and only one, **Bruce Parkinson**, started the first 100 games.

►►► **HIS CURRENT PACE:** At his current averages of 16.0 points, 8.7 assists and 4.5 rebounds, Smith will finish the season (36 games) with 577 points, 312 assists and 163 rebounds. Just one player in college basketball history, **Ja Morant** (2018-19), has had at least 500 points, 300 assists and 150 rebounds in a season.

- Smith has roughly 43 career games left (based on 36-game seasons; seven this year, 36 next year). Should he average his **current junior year average NEXT SEASON**, he would finish his career with **1,962 points, 1,068 assists and 698 rebounds**.
- Duke's **Bobby Hurley** holds the all-time NCAA assists record with 1,076 helpers from 1990-93 (140 games).

▶▶▶ HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

- ▶ **Record at Purdue:** 467-212 (.688) / 20th year | **Career Record:** 492-217 (.694) / 21st year
- With 16 NCAA Tournament berths, seven Sweet 16 appearances, five Big Ten regular-season championships, two Big Ten Tournament titles, two Elite Eight appearances, a trip to the Final Four, an appearance in a National Championship game and an international gold medal on his résumé, 20th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
 - Painter was named the 2019 and 2024 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to nine straight NCAA Tournaments – the fourth-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in five of the last seven tournaments.
 - Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
 - Painter will enter the 2024-25 season second on the school's all-time wins list (447) behind legendary mentor **Gene Keady** and ahead of **Ward “Piggy” Lambert**, both of whom have been inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame.
 - Has averaged over 23 wins a season in his 19 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.3 wins per year over the last 18 seasons.
 - Has won at least 25 games in 12 of his 20 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
 - Painter has averaged 11.9 wins per year in conference play, the third-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
 - He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
 - Coach Painter's 16 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2024 – Painter is 53 years old).
 - Purdue has finished first, second or third in Big Ten play in 11 of the last 17 years, including in eight of the last 10 years.
