THE OPENING TIP

• Purdue (7-5) wraps up non-conference action Saturday when Central Michigan visits Mackey Arena for a noon tip. **Kevin Kugler** and **Ben Brust** will handle the broadcast on the Big Ten Network. On the radio, **Rob Blackman**, **Larry Clisby** and **Ralph Taylor** will have the call courtside on the Purdue Radio Network and Tuneln.com, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 11 a.m. ET. Live stats will be available on StatBroadcast.com.

• Purdue owns a 6-1 record all-time against Central Michigan, having won two games in a row. The Boilermakers have faced Central Michigan just once during the **Matt Painter** era, a 64-38 decision in Mackey Arena in November 2009.

• **SOMETHING TO WATCH:** A complete contrast in styles will be showcased in Saturday's game vs. Central Michigan.

• Purdue's 20-day layoff between home games is the longest layoff during **Matt Painter's** 15-year tenure. Purdue last played at home on Dec. 8, against Northwestern. The previous longest layoff came in the 2009-10 season (15 days; Nov. 13-28). Coincidentally, Purdue ended that span with a game against Central Michigan on Nov. 28, 2009.

• The Boilermakers are 57-16 all time against the MAC, having defeated Ohio 69-51 already this season. Head coach **Matt Painter** is 13-1 all-time against MAC schools.

• Purdue is hoping a return to Mackey Arena is what is needed. The Boilermakers are averaging 74.3 points per game in six home games this year, but is averaging just 60.0 points per game in six games away from Mackey Arena. Purdue is shooting 46.9 percent at home, but just 36.1 percent away from Mackey.

• Purdue hasn't scored 70 points in a game since Nov. 23, 2019, against Jacksonville State, a span of seven games. It's Purdue's longest stretch since Jan. 24 to Feb. 16, 2013 (8 games).

• Purdue has held its first 12 opponents to 70 or fewer points, the longest streak since the 2010-11 squad held its first 19 opponents to 70 or fewer points.

• Purdue is 7-0 this year when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. The Boilermakers are 0-5 when allowing 60-plus.

• Purdue is 6-0 this year and 26-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent. The lone loss came to Virginia in last year's Elite Eight.

• Purdue is 6-0 this year and has won 17 straight games when attempting more free throws than its opponent.

• Purdue is 12-2 during the Painter era in its final non-conference game of the season, having won four straight games by a combined 102 points.

• Purdue has had six different players lead the team in scoring already. Last season, just four players (in 36 games) led the team in scoring.

- Matt Painter** won his 350th career game with the win over VCU.
- Purdue is 24-4 when **Matt Haarms** scores in double figures.
- Purdue is 153-16 under **Matt Painter** when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the field.
- Purdue is 26-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher percentage from the field than its opponent. The lone loss was to Virginia in the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Purdue is 107-9 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponent, including 22-2 since the start last season.
- Purdue is 31-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game.
- Purdue is 119-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 33-2 since the start of 2017-18.
- Purdue is 151-5 when holding foes to 59 or fewer points during the **Matt Painter** era.

IS THE SHOOTING COMING AROUND?

- Purdue has struggled shooting from deep this year, but is starting to show signs of coming around.
- Over the last two games, Purdue is 16 of 38 (.421) from long distance, a two-game stretch that was preceded by an 11 of 57 (.193) effort.
- In the six games combined that Purdue shoots 20 or fewer three-pointers, the Boilermakers are a combined 42 of 109 (.385) from deep. In six games that it shoots 21 or more trifectas, the Boilermakers are 46 of 174 (.264).

ANYONE, ANYWHERE

- Purdue and Illinois are the only Big Ten teams to play a road game at a team outside the "Power-6" conferences, when the Boilermakers traveled to Ohio last Tuesday night.
- Illinois played at Grand Canyon on Nov. 8.

GAMES OF PERFECTION

- Matt Haarms** recorded a perfect shooting game against Florida State, going 6 of 6 from the field, 1 of 1 from long distance and 3 of 3 from the free throw line. It ranks sixth in school history for points scored with 100 percent efficiency.
- Haarms is the only player in school history with two games of 15 or more points on perfect shooting.

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 328-164 (.667) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 353-169 (.676) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
- Has had 58 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 14 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
