▶ HEAD COACH JEFF BROHM

- Is now 55-38 in his eighth year as a head coach overall
- Is now 25-28 in his fifth year as Purdue's head coach
- Is now 18-21 in Big Ten Conference play
- Is now 14-15 in games played at Ross-Ade Stadium
- Is now 10-12 in Big Ten home games
- Is now 5-7 against top-25 opponents and 3-0 against top-five teams as Purdue's head coach
- Is now 1-1 against Michigan State as Purdue's head coach

▶ PURDUE RECORDS

- Is now 626-582-48 in its 134th season
- Is now 386-242-25 in home games all-time
- Is now 293-198-13 all-time at Ross-Ade Stadium
- Is now 59-195-5 all-time against teams ranked in the top-25 of the Associated Press poll and 7-9 against teams ranked No. 5
- \cdot Is now 29-36-3 all-time against Michigan State

▶ SERIES HISTORY VS. MICHIGAN STATE

- Purdue trails the all-time series, 29-36-3
- Purdue is 17-14-3 at home
- Purdue is 6-13 against a top-25 Michigan State team and 5-6 when MSU is ranked in the top-5
- Purdue is 26-34-2 against Michigan State as Big Ten opponents, since the first conference matchup in 1952
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ This is the third meeting since 2015 and the first at home since 2014
- The win snapped an eight-game losing streak in the series

▶ PURDUE TEAM NOTES

- Purdue defeated an AP top-5-ranked team for the second time this season (24-7 at No. 2 Iowa on October 16), and the Boilermakers have three-straight top-five victories, along with the 2018 triumph over No. 2 Ohio State (49-20 on October 20)
- The last time Purdue beat two AP top-5 teams in a season was 1960, with wins over No. 3 Ohio State (24-21 on October 15) and No. 1 Minnesota (23-14 on November 12)
- The last time Purdue beat two or more top-25 teams in a season was 2018, with three, and the last time Purdue upended two top-10 teams was in 1984 (No. 8 Notre Dame, 23-21 and No. 2 Ohio State 28-23)
- Purdue has 17 wins against AP top-5 foes as an un-ranked team, the most in the country by six, ahead of Illinois and USC's 11 and Michigan State's 10
- The Boilermakers have at least two takeaways in four consecutive game and 12 in the last four games after recording a total of two in the first five games
- Purdue had 500 or more passing yards for the first time since a 509-yard game vs. Vanderbilt on September 7, 2019, and quarterback Aidan O'Connell's 536-yard game is third-most all-time and the most since David Blough's school-record 572 on September 15, 2018, against Missouri
- Purdue won its sixth game for the third time under coach Jeff Brohm, and first since $2018\,$
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ The Boilermakers are bowl eligible for the 20th time in team history
- Today's attendance was 57,748, the second-largest home crowd of the season

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

OFFENSE

- · Led the team with 217 receiving yards on 11 catches with a touchdown
- · 217 receiving yards is fifth-most in school history
- ... With a 240-yard game at Iowa on October 16, is the second player in program history with multiple 200-plus-yard receiving games, along with Brian Alford (215 and 209, both in 2017)
- Breaks the school record with his 15th career 100-yard receiving game
- ... Breaks a tie with John Standeford, from 2000-03
- ... Has 100-plus yards in 15 of 26 career games
- Has 2,663 career receiving yards, which continues to rank No. 5 in team history, and 1,003 this season, No. 14 all-time
- ... In a career, sits between Brian Alford's 3,029 from 1994-97 and Vinny Sutherland's 2,370 from 1997-00
- \dots In a season, moves into the top-15 and is between Vinny Sutherland's 1,014 in 1980 and Bart Burrell's 1,001 in 1980
- Has 203 career receptions, tied for No. 5 all-time, and 64 this year ... Moves up one spot into a tie with Greg Orton, from 2005-08
- Has 20 career receiving touchdowns, tied for No. 7 all-time, and five this season
- ... Moves up one spot into a tie with Greg Orton, from 2005-08
- · Had two catches of at least 50 yards, and has four this year
- Against eight ranked teams in his career, has 1,081 yards on 79 catches with seven touchdowns

▶ Aidan O'Connell

- Was 40-for-54 for 536 yards with three passing touchdowns and no interceptions
- ... Yards and attempts both are career-bests, completions and touchdowns both ties career-high
- Completion percentage of .741 is a school record with at least 50 pass attempts
- ... Bests previous record of .709 by David Blough vs. Missouri on September 15, 2018 (39-for-55)
- 40 completions is tied for second-most in program history
 ... Is behind only Drew Brees' 55 completions on October 10, 1998,
 at Wisconsin, and tied with Brees' 40 vs. Michigan State on October 10, 1998
- 536 passing yards is third-most in program history
- ... Is behind only David Blough's 572 yards on September 15, 2018, vs. Missouri, and Curtis Painter's 546 on December 26, 2007
- ... Is the eighth individual 500-yard passing game in Purdue history and the most by a Boilermaker in a Big Ten game, besting Drew Brees' 522 against Minnesota on October 3, 1998
- Continues to rank No. 1 in program history with a .674 career completion percentage and a .716 season completion percentage
- ... Is ahead of Robert Marve's .638 (294-461) from 2010-12 on the career list and David Blough's .660 (305-462) in 2018 on the single-season chart
- Has 385 career completions, 9th-most in school history, and 194 this season
- ... Moves up three spots, from 12th, and is between Eric Hunter's 422 from 1989-92 and Mike Phipps' 375 from 1967-69
- Has 571 career passing attempts, No. 12 all-time, and 271 this season ... Moves up one spot from 13th, and is between Bob Griese's 627, from 1964-66, and Billy Dicken's 570, from 1994-97
- Has 27 career touchdown passes, tied for No. 13 in team history, and 12 this season
- ... Moves up three spots, from 16th, and is tied with Dale Samuals, from 1950-52
- Has 4,104 career passing yards, which remains No. 13 in program history, and 2,087 this season
- \dots Is between Billy Dicken's 4,247 from 1994-97 and Brandon Kirsch's 3,532 from 2002-05

▶ Jack Anthrop

- · Had six catches for 80 yards with a touchdown
- ... Touchdown is the eighth receiving score of his career and second this season, and the 10th touchdown overall

▶ King Doerue

- Had 13 rushes for 32 yards with a touchdown and caught three passes for 60 yards with a long of 46
- ... 60 receiving yards and long of 46 are both career-bests

▶ Garrett Miller

· Had eight catches for 74 yards, both career bests

▶ Broc Thompson

- · Had three catches for 22 yards with a touchdown
- ... Touchdown is the first of his career

DEFENSE

▶ Jaylan Alexander

· Led the team with nine tackles, six solo

▶ Kieren Douglas

 Was second on the team with a career-best eight tackles, five solo, and had one tackle for loss, tied for a career-best

▶ Jalen Graham

· Had seven tackles, a team-high-tying six solo

▶ Marvin Grant

- Forced a fumble and had five tackles, four solo
- \dots Forced fumble is the third of his career and first in 2021

▶ George Karlaftis

- Recovered a fumble and had three tackles, one solo, with a tackle for loss
- ... Fumble recovery is the fourth of his career and second in 2021

▶ Dedrick Mackey

• Intercepted a pass in the fourth quarter, his fifth career pick and second this season

▶ DaMarcus Mitchell

· Had one sack, the third of his career and second this season

SPECIAL TEAMS

▶ Mitchell Fineran

- Was four-for-four in field goal attempts and four-for-four in PATs
- ... Four field goals is third-most in program history and the most by a Boilermaker since Carson Wiggs also had four against Indiana on November 26. 2011
- ... 16 points scored kicking is the most since Carson Wiggs had 15 against Indiana on November 26, 2011
- ... Is the 12th player in the NCAA with at least 16 point scored kicking this season

- Purdue is 15-40-2 all-time against the Buckeyes and 5-27-2 in Columbus
