THE SCENE SETTER

- The Purdue men's basketball team opens the 2019 calendar year with the resumption of Big Ten play as Iowa visits Thursday.
- The contest will be televised on BTN with **Dave Revsine** and **Stephen Bardo** calling the action courtside, beginning at 7 p.m. ET.
- On the radio waves, the contest will be available on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com with **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** on the call, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show at 6 p.m.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com, and Twitter updates will be available on Purdue's official account (@BoilerBall).
- Purdue is looking for its third straight win and for a 2-1 record or better in Big Ten play for the fifth straight year (last year was 3-0).
- The Boilermakers are also looking for their second straight win against a ranked league squad, defeating Maryland on Dec. 6.
- Purdue will hit the road for its next two games at Michigan State and Wisconsin.

THE TWO TEAMS

- Purdue enters Saturday's contest with the Hawkeyes with an 8-5 overall record and a 1-1 mark in league play.
- The Boilermakers found their defense in the last outing, holding Belmont almost 30 points below its average in a 73-62 victory on Dec. 29.
- Meanwhile, Purdue has also found its offensive footing in the last three games, averaging 82.7 points during the current stretch.
- Carsen Edwards** continues to play at a high level, averaging 25.8 points and 3.5 assists, ranking second nationally in scoring.
- Ryan Cline** averages 13.1 points per game and is 34th nationally in 3-pt's made (40).
- Iowa is 11-2 overall and enters Thursday's game as winners of five straight games by a combined 106 points. The Hawkeyes went 11-0 against non-conference opponents.
- Tyler Cook** leads a potent Iowa attack by averaging 16.8 points per game. Six other players average at least 7.0 points per game and Iowa averages 83.2 points per outing.

THE TALKING POINTS

- Purdue is 8-1 under Matt Painter against Iowa at Mackey Arena.
- Of Purdue's first nine Big Ten games, eight are against ranked teams (Maryland, Michigan, Iowa, MSU 2x, Wisconsin, Indiana, Ohio St.).
- Purdue has won eight straight home games dating to last year, winning by an average of 18.5 points during the eight games. Just three of the wins have come by single-digits.
- In the last three games with Iowa, Purdue is 43 of 90 (.478) from 3-point range.
- Carsen Edwards** needs 18 points for 1,400 in his career, four steals for 100 and four 3-pointers for 200.
- Carsen Edwards** is one of two active juniors to have 1,300 career points, 200 assists and 190 3-pointers (**Markus Howard**).
- Ryan Cline's** 2.91 career assist/turnover ratio is the second best in school history (**P.J. Thompson** - 2.94).
- Since Dec. 1, **Aaron Wheeler** is the team's third-leading scorer (7.2 PPG) and second-leading rebounder (4.2 RPG) in 15.8 MPG.

THE SERIES

- Purdue holds an 89-76 series advantage against Iowa, having won 14 of 22 meetings with the Hawkeyes during the **Matt Painter** era.
- However, over the last 12 meetings, each team has won six games.
- Nine of the last 12 meetings (6-6 record) have been decided by 10 or fewer points.
- Purdue is 8-1 over the last nine meetings with Iowa at Mackey Arena. The one loss was on Jan. 2, 2016, when Iowa overcame a 17-point second-half deficit.
- In last year's lone meeting, Purdue set a Big Ten record by making 20 3-pointers. **Carsen Edwards** had 22 points and eight assists.

ONE OF THE NATION'S TOUGHEST SCHEDULES

- Purdue has played one of the nation's most-difficult schedules to date and with the strength of the Big Ten, it could rank as the nation's hardest at the end of the season.
- According to KenPom.com, Purdue has faced just four teams outside his top 100 (Fairfield, Appalachian State, Robert Morris and Ohio) and no teams ranked below 300.
- The rest of the way, Purdue has two games outside top-100 foes (Rutgers, Illinois) and two more outside the top 50 (Minnesota twice).
- Purdue's next three games are against 41 (home), 5 and 14 (both on the road).
- Purdue's nine top-100 foes so far are the most among any major-conference program. Oklahoma and Illinois are next with eight.
- Purdue has won four games against the KenPom top-100, good for third in the league (Michigan, Indiana - 5). Purdue's four top-100 wins by New Year's Day are the fourth most of the Painter era (2018, 2011, 2007 - 6).

KICKING OFF THE NEW YEAR

- Purdue owns just a 6-7 record under **Matt Painter** during the first game of the new calendar year.
- In each of the last four-plus seasons, Purdue has posted an 8-1 Big Ten record, good for a league-best record of 33-4 during that span. However, two of the losses have come in the first game of the new calendar year.
- This marks the fifth straight year Purdue opens the new year at home.

THE EXTRA POSSESSION GAME

- During the Painter era, Purdue is 106-9 when committing fewer turnovers and outrebounding its opponents in the same game.
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 23-4 when that happens, having won 23 of its last 24 games when doing so (lone loss: Notre Dame).

SHOOTING WINS

- For the first time since a Feb. 2017, loss to Michigan, the Boilermakers lost when shooting at least 48.0, when it shot 50.8 percent from the field against Virginia Tech on Nov. 18.
- The loss snapped a streak of 27 straight games of winning when winning 48.0 percent from the field.
- Purdue is 139-15 under Painter when over 48.0 percent shooting.

PURDUE HIGH ON THE 3-POINTER CHART

- Purdue ranks eighth nationally in 3-pointers made per game at 10.8 trifectas per game. The Boilermakers are third among major-college programs.

BUT SUCCESS FROM DEEP IS NOTHING NEW

- The narrative is that Purdue is a plodding, inside-driven program, but as the numbers suggest, that simply isn't true.
- Over the last three years, Purdue is 809 of 2001 from 3-point range, good for the fourth-best percentage in the country.
- Purdue's 809 3-pointers during the last three years are the 12th most nationally and fourth among major-college teams.

ROAD WARRIORS

- Since the start of the 2007-08 season, Purdue owns a 60-57 record, the third-most wins in the Big Ten during that span. Only four teams (Wisconsin, Michigan State, Ohio State, Purdue) have even won at least 40.0 percent of their road games during that span (not counting Maryland).
- Over the last 12 years, there have been just 10, 8-win road seasons by all the teams in the Big Ten (MSU - 3; Wisc. - 3; Purdue - 2; OSU - 1; Md. - 1).

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 303-154 (.663) / 14th year | **Career Record:** 328-159 (.674) / 15th year

- With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 13 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year, the average balloons to 23.8 wins per year over the last 12 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.

- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
