#### THE OPENING TIP

- The No. 3-ranked Purdue Boilermakers look to end the Crossroads Classic in style when it travels to Gainbridge Fieldhouse in Indianapolis for a non-conference matchup with the Butler Bulldogs. In its 11th and final season, the Crossroads Classic has been the state's premier college basketball event and Purdue is looking for its second straight victory after beating Notre Dame a year ago 88-78.
- Purdue enters the contest with a 9-1 record while Butler is 7-3, but has won four straight games.
- The contest will be televised on FOX with **Tim Brando** and **Jimmy Jackson** on the call. On the radio waves, **Rob Blackman** and **Bobby Riddell** will be courtside on the 22-station Purdue Radio Network and online on the Varsity Sports Network (app). Live stats will be provided on StatBroadcast.com and updates will be provided on Purdue's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).

#### THE NOTES TO KNOW

- Purdue is 9-1 for just the fourth time under head coach **Matt Painter**, also reaching 9-1 (or better) in 2015-16 (10-0), 2010-11 (9-1) and 2009-10 (10-0). It marks Purdue's 11th start of 9-1 or better since the 1982-83 season.
- Purdue's 16 overtime points vs. North Carolina State tied for the seventh most in an overtime period in school history. It was Purdue's first win in a single-overtime game since a 99-94 decision over Tennessee in the 2019 Sweet 16 (5-game streak).
- Trevion Williams** won his fourth career Big Ten Player of the Week honor, tied for the fifth most in school history (**Glenn Robinson** - 7; **Caleb Swanigan** - 6; **Brad Miller** - 6; **Carsen Edwards** - 5).
- Trevion Williams'** stat line of 22 points, 12 rebounds, 9 assists, 4 blocks and 2 steals vs. North Carolina State makes him the only player in America in the last 15 years to reach those marks in a single game.
- Purdue has outscored its opponents by 80 points at the free throw line, the second-best total in the country (Weber State +88). Purdue has made 174 free throws this year, while opponents have shot just 128.
- Purdue is 1-of-4 teams nationally to shoot at least 50.0 percent from the field, 40.0 percent from 3-point range and 70.0 percent from the free throw line (Colorado State, South Dakota State, Loyola).
- Purdue's 50 points in the paint against North Carolina State were its most since Dec. 21, 2016 (52 vs. Norfolk State).
- Purdue owns four wins against the KenPom top 40, the most in the country.

- Over its last 101 games at Mackey Arena, Purdue is 91-10.
- Purdue has won 11 straight games at Mackey Arena.
- With the Paint Crew in attendance, Purdue is 78-8 at Mackey Arena since the 2014-15 season.

## ELITE SHOOTING AT ALL LEVELS

- Purdue is one of four teams nationally to shoot over 50.0 percent from the field, 40.0 percent from 3-point range and 70.0 percent from the free throw line.
- Over the course of an entire season, no team has shot 50-40-75 since South Dakota State during the 2018-19 season and just five teams have done that since the 2010-11 campaign.

## PURDUE'S BIG THREE MAKING BIG IMPACT

- Purdue's big three of **Jaden Ivey**, **Trevion Williams** and **Zach Edey** are making a huge impact this season.
- The group is averaging 45.2 points, 21.7 rebounds, 7.2 assists, 2.9 blocks and 3.2 steals per game, shooting 172-of-290 (.593) from the field.

## DUO DOMINATES THE GLASS

- Through Wednesday's games, **Zach Edey** and **Trevion Williams** rank 3rd and 6th nationally in offensive rebounding percentage.

## DOUBLE-DOUBLE TIMES 3

- In the win over Wright State, Purdue had three players (**Zach Edey**, **Caleb First**, **Trevion Williams**) record double-doubles. It marked the first time since Nov. 21, 1977, that three players recorded double-doubles in the same game (**Walter Jordan**, **Wayne Walls**, **Joe Barry Carroll**). It has now happened 19 times in school history.

## 20 TIMES 3

- In the win over North Carolina, Purdue had three players score at least 20 points in the same game for the first time since Nov. 24, 1997. **Sasha Stefanovic** had 23 points, **Jaden Ivey** had 22 points and **Trevion Williams** tallied 20 points.

## INSIDE MORE NUMBERS

- Purdue is 129-15 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents.
- Purdue is 162-7 when under Painter when holding foes to 59 or fewer points. Three of the seven losses came during the 2012-13 season.
- Purdue is 136-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 50-2 (losses to Notre Dame and Virginia Tech in 2018-19 season) since the start of the 2017-18 season.
- Purdue is 257-50 under Painter when scoring at least 70 points.
- Purdue is 44-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game, winning 14 straight games.
- Purdue is 133-14 under Painter when winning the rebound and turnover battles in the same game.
- Purdue has won 25 straight games when shooting a higher field goal percentage than its opponent.

## BEST THING ABOUT FRESHMEN IS THEY BECOME SOPHOMORES

- Purdue sophomores **Jaden Ivey** and **Zach Edey** have taken a massive leap this season after good freshman campaigns.

## THE CENTER OF EFFICIENCY

- Purdue's two-headed center monster of **Zach Edey** and **Trevion Williams** is averaging 27.9 points, 15.9 rebounds, 3.4 assists and 2.0 blocked shots per game, in 37.6 minutes per game.
- Over the last two games, Purdue's centers have "struggled", averaging just 19.5 points and 17.5 rebounds per game while shooting 16-of-32 (.500) from the field and 6-of-12 (.500) from the free throw line.

## IVEY SHOWS PLAYMAKING ABILITIES

- One area that many people wanted to see **Jaden Ivey** expand his role was his playmaking abilities.
- Don't look now, but Ivey is 15-of-34 (.441) from long distance in his last six games after starting the year 3-of-12.
- Ivey is one of six players nationally to average 16.0 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.4 assists and shoot 50.0 percent from the field and 37.5 percent from 3-point range.

## INSTANT PRODUCTION

- Averaging 14, 9 & 3 is not a huge deal in itself. Doing it in under 30.0 minutes per game is a bit of a bigger deal. Doing it in 21.1 minutes per game is absurd - but that's what **Trevion Williams** is doing.

## HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 364-185 (.663) / 17th year | **Career Record:** 389-190 (.672) / 18th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 12 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 17th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to six straight NCAA Tournaments – the seventh-longest active streak in America. Included in that stretch are Sweet 16 appearances (and beyond) in three of the last four tournaments.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2021-22 season third on the school's all-time wins list (355) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 16 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 15 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 17 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (**Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4**).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Painter's 12 NCAA Tournament appearances in the last 14 events are the eighth most in the country.
- Coach Painter's 13 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2022 – Painter is 51 years old).
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 14 years.
- Has had 68 Academic All-Big Ten honorees in his 16 previous years at Purdue.
- Lastly, the five winningest classes in school history have come during the Painter era (2019, 2018, 2012, 2011, 2010).
