

PURDUE BASKETBALL POSTGAME NOTES

Purdue (19-6, 8-4 Big Ten) vs. Iowa (17-10, 6-7 Big Ten)

GAME NOTES

- With the loss, Sharon Versyp's all-time record at Purdue is 155-76 and 272-141 overall in 13 years as a collegiate head coach.
- Purdue started KK Houser, Courtney Moses, Dee Dee Williams, Drey Mingo and Sam Ostarello for the 19th time this season. The Boilermakers are now 14-5 with this lineup.
- Purdue leads the all-time series against Iowa 35-28. The Hawkeyes broke a 12-game losing streak in Mackey Arena that dated back to 1998 and have won four of the last six games against Purdue.
- Samantha Logic's three-pointer with 5:39 remaining in the first half gave Iowa a 21-19 lead. The Hawkeyes wouldn't relinquish the lead for the rest of the game.
- There were 10 lead changes and two ties in the ballgame, all in the first half. Iowa held a 32-27 halftime lead and four was the closest Purdue would come in the second half.
- Early in the second period, a three-pointer by KK Houser cut the Hawkeye lead to four, but Iowa went on a 12-5 run over the next 5:21 to stretch the lead to 48-37 with 11:55 to play.
- Purdue went on a 7-2 spurt over 2:14 to get within six points, with the score 62-56 in favor of the Hawkeyes with 8:05 to play.
- Iowa ended the game on a 20-6 run over the final 7:46 of play.
- This is the first time the Boilermakers have won the rebounding battle and lost the game. They were 17-0 in such games heading into today's contest.
- Iowa's 50.0 percent (27-54) field goal percentage was the most by a Big Ten foe this season.

GAME HIGHS AND LOWS AND CAREER/SEASON RECORDS

- Sam Ostarello led Purdue with 15 points and 11 rebounds, her ninth double-double of the season and the 14th of her career. She is now tied with Camille Cooper for sixth place at Purdue for career double-doubles. With nine this season, she is tied with three players for fifth on the season charts.
- Drey Mingo added 14 points and KK Houser had 12 points.
- Samantha Logic led the Hawkeyes in scoring with a career-high 26 points. Junior Theairra Taylor recorded the second double-double of the season, and her career, for Iowa. She scored 15 points and tied a career-high with a team-high 11 rebounds.
- Dee Dee Williams tied her career high of six rebounds. It was her third time reaching the mark, most recently against Indiana on Jan. 30, 2011.
- Courtney Moses was held scoreless for only the fourth time in her career and the third time this season. The most recent occurrence was against Indiana on Jan. 31.
- Ostarello has recorded double-digit rebounds in eight of Purdue's 12 conference contests this season.
- It was the first time since Feb. 21, 2010, that KK Houser failed to record an assist in a game, breaking a streak of 64 consecutive games.
