The Scene Setter

- The No. 20-ranked Purdue men's basketball team continues its busy opening stretch, hosting Chicago State in Mackey Arena on Sunday, Nov. 12, tipping off at 4 p.m. ET.
- It marks the middle game of a three-game in five-day stretch to begin the 2017-18 season.
- Tickets are available online at PurdueSports.com or at the Mackey Arena ticket office.
- The game will be televised on the Big Ten Network with **Cory Provus** and **Robbie Hummel** on the call. On the radio waves, **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will handle the call on the Purdue Radio Network.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com and fans can receive in-game updates via Twitter at @BoilerBall, or on the Purdue Sports App.
- Purdue is looking to start 2-0 for the 11th time in the 13-year era of **Matt Painter**. But it has started 2-0 just three times in the last five seasons (2013-14, 2014-15 and 2015-16).

LOOKING BACK

- Purdue's offense clicked at a high rate in Friday's season opener, shooting 59.0 percent from the field and having 24 assists against 11 turnovers en route to a 105-74 victory over SIU-Edwardsville.
- Purdue's seniors scored 54 points with 16 rebounds and eight assists, while shooting 16-of-27 (.593) from the field and 5-of-9 (.556) from long distance.
- Five players scored in double figures, led by **Dakota Mathias'** 18 points and four assists. Mathias led the team in scoring for just the third time in his career as he went over 700 career points.
- Purdue scored 50 points in both halves for the first time since Nov. 13, 2013, vs. Central Conn. St.
- Purdue did give up 24 offensive rebounds, the fifth most in a game in school history and the second most by an opponent in Mackey Arena history.
- SIU-Edwardsville's 74 points were the most by an opponent in an opener since the 2013-14 opener.

► Eastern With One of Best Debuts in School History

- **Nojel Eastern** scored eight points with eight assists and five rebounds in just 21 minutes against SIU-Edwardsville.

- Purdue is 19-3 when **Carsen Edwards** gets the starting nod and 15-3 when he scores 10 or more points.
- **Ryan Cline** needs 12 3-pointers to become the fourth active player with 100 or more career 3-pointers.

► Automatic From the Field

- Since the start of last year, **Grady Eifert** is 10-of-11 from the field. He went 4-of-4 from the field against SIU-Edwardsville and was 6-of-7 from the field a year ago.

► Twin Towers

- Purdue is one-of-seven teams with a pair of 7-footers on its roster. It is the only team in America with two players 7-2 or taller.

► November Reign

- Purdue has dominated the opposition at home during the month of November, going 41-2 (.953) under head coach **Matt Painter**. The lone setbacks were on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65), and Nov. 14, 2017, to defending national champion Villanova (79-76). Ironically, Villanova's head coach **Jay Wright** graduated from Bucknell.
- Going back further, Purdue is 76-8 (.905) all-time at Mackey Arena during the month of November.
- Painter owns a 57-15 (.792) record during the month of November.

► Big Margins at Home

- With a trio of Sweet 16 appearances, nine NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 13th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 22 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 25 victories in six seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last 10 years have seen six 25-win seasons and eight NCAA Tournament berths, three Sweet 16 appearances, two regular-season Big Ten titles and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
- Painter has seen a total of 26 players earn a combined 49 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored a pair of Academic All-Americans in E'Twaun Moore (2010) and Caleb Swanigan (2017)
