GAME 02: Things You Should Know

• The Purdue men's basketball team has a quick turnaround after a season-opening win, playing its second game in three days on Sunday, Nov. 16, as IUPUI makes the short drive to West Lafayette for a 3 PM (ET) tip. Tickets are available by calling 1-800-49SPORT or at the Mackey Arena ticket office before the game.

• The Boilermakers are coming off a dominating victory in the season opener, doubling up Samford, 80-40, in Mackey Arena on Friday night. The Boilermakers shot 66.7 percent in the first half to sprint to a 43-16 halftime lead and held the Bulldogs to just 22.7 percent shooting for the game to cruise to the easy victory.

• Purdue recorded 21 assists on 26 field goals, had four players score in double figures, outrebounded Samford by 11 rebounds and had seven players with at least two assists in the contest.

• Freshman **Vince Edwards** led Purdue with 13 points, eight rebounds and two assists in just 17 minutes, while junior **Rapheal Davis** also tallied 13 points with three assists and two boards. The tandem of **Isaac Haas** and **A.J. Hammons** totaled 16 points, 11 rebounds, six blocked shots and four assists in 38 minutes while dominating the interior.

Previewing IUPUI

• For the second straight game, Purdue will face a first-year head coach in IUPUI's **Jason Gardner**. In their first game under Gardner, IUPUI was outscored 15-2 in overtime of a 79-66 home loss to Indiana State.

• The Jaguars boasted balanced scoring, as eight players scored at least six points, but IUPUI had just nine assists against 16 turnovers and shot just 35.0 percent in the setback.

• **Marcellus Barksdale** led the Jaguars with 12 points, but was just 2-of-12 from the field in 37 minutes. **Mason Archie** added 11 points and **DavRon Williams** tallied six points with 11 rebounds. **P.J. Boutte** played 40 minutes off the bench and dished out a team-best six assists against just one turnover.

• In the loss to Indiana State, all five of IUPUI's starters stood at least 6-4, similar to Purdue's lineup.

• The Jaguars went 6-26 a year ago, and return two starters (**Khafu Najee**, **Barksdale**) from that squad.

Boilers Own Season Openers

- Purdue improved to 9-1 in season openers under **Matt Painter**. Purdue is averaging 80.3 points per game in season openers, while allowing just 54.7 points per game under Painter.
- Under Painter, Purdue has held foes to 40 or fewer points five times in the season opener.
- Purdue's 40-point margin was the program's third largest in school history in a season opener (62 vs. Northern Illinois in 2011-12; 46 vs. Southern Illinois in 1973-74).
- Purdue has won 32 of its last 38 openers, dating back to 1977-78.
- Just three times in the Painter era (2006, 2013, 2014) have the Boilermakers allowed opponents to score 70 points in a season opener.
- In fact, Purdue has held foes to 40 or fewer points the same amount of times its allowed opponents to score 60 points in the season opener (4).

Boilers Dominate on Defense vs. Samford

- Purdue pieced together its most-dominating defensive performance in a few years in Friday's season-opening win over Samford. It harkened back to the days when Purdue would stifle its opponents.
- Samford's 22.7 field goal percentage was the fourth lowest for a Purdue opponent in school history.
- Samford's 20.0 field goal percentage in the first half equaled the eighth lowest in a half since the 1969-70 season.

- Samford's 40 points tied for the 10th fewest in a game since 1951-52, and it marked the first time Purdue held an opponent to 40 or fewer points since Eastern Michigan scored 36 points on Dec. 10, 2011.
- Purdue held Samford to 0.57 points / possession on Friday, which tied for the fifth-lowest mark in school history.

Sharing is Caring

- One area that Purdue really struggled in last year was sharing the ball. However, the win over Samford showed that Purdue has changed drastically for the better in that category.
- Through Friday night according to Ken Pomeroy, Purdue's assist rate of 80.8 percent was second in the country (American - .833).
- Seven players recorded at least two assists and 11 players scored for the Boilermakers.
- Purdue had 21 assists on 26 made field goals, an assist percentage of 80.8 percent, the highest percentage since Dec. 21, 2010 against IPFW (26 assists; 31 field goals -- .839). It marked the fifth-best assist rate in a game during the **Matt Painter** era.

- Last season, Purdue had just four games with 20 or more assists, including just one in Big Ten, and that came in a triple-overtime win over Minnesota on Feb. 5.
- To show you the new "emphasis" on sharing, Purdue center **A.J. Hammons** tied for the team lead in assists with three. It marked the first time in 66 career games that he has led the team in assists.

Purdue is 12-0 all-time against the Summit League, winning the previous 12 meetings by an average of 20.5 points. Painter is 6-0 against the league.

■ H&H Block

- Purdue's powerful inside tandem of junior **A.J. Hammons** and freshman **Isaac Haas** had a strong exhibition season and will give the Boilermakers a rather formidable interior attack.
- The duo played 38 minutes in the win over Samford, accounting for 16 points, 11 rebounds, six blocked shots and four assists.

■ Sniping From The Perimeter

- It's quite obvious that head coach **Matt Painter** has upgraded Purdue's perimeter attack and it was put on display on Friday night. The depth allows Painter to be able to offset a tough shooting night from any of several players.
- Wing players **Kendall Stephens**, **Dakota Mathias** and **Vince Edwards** combined to go 7-of-11 from long distance, while P.J. Thompson went 0-of-2.
- However, in exhibition play, Thompson went 5-of-8 showing his long-distance prowess.

■ November Reign

- Purdue has dominated the opposition at home during the month of November, going 31-1 (.969) under head coach **Matt Painter**. The lone loss was on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65). The average margin of victory in those games is 23.2 points (743 points).
- Going back further, Purdue is 66-7 (.904) all-time at Mackey Arena during the month of November. Legendary coach **Gene Keady** owned a 35-6 (.854) record in home games during the month.

■ Home-Streaking

- Purdue has won nine straight games at Mackey Arena against non-conference foes, by an average of 18.8 points per game.

■ Hello, World

- Purdue had five players make their Division I regular-season debut on Nov. 14 against Samford as **Vince Edwards**, **Isaac Haas**, **Dakota Mathias**, **Jacquil Taylor** and **P.J. Thompson** all saw action in their first official collegiate contest.
- Before Friday, no current player had scored more than six points or played more than 16 minutes in their first career game. On Friday, four players played more than 16 minutes and scored at least six points.

- The group also had just four of Purdue's 16 turnovers on Friday.

■ Freshmen Starters

- Just 16 players (true or redshirt) in school history have earned the starting nods in a season opener. Eleven of them have come during the Painter era.

- **Vince Edwards** became the newest member of that group on Friday, when he earned the nod against Samford.

■ The Sultan of Swat

• **A.J. Hammons** knows what is ahead of him and that the success of Purdue basketball rests largely on his wide shoulders. If the preseason is any indication, the Boilers may be in good hands.

• Hammons has had an outstanding preseason and is Purdue's leading returning scorer (10.8 ppg), rebounder (7.4 rpg) and shot blocker (3.1 bpg).

• Hammons needs just eight blocked shots to move into a third-place tie with **Russell Cross** (1981-83; 175) on the Purdue career rejections list.

• Hammons has had five games (in 66 career games) where he has recorded six or more blocked shots. By comparison, **Joe Barry Carroll** had eight games of six or more blocks in 123 contests.

• The Boilmakers received big news in early October when Colorado State transfer **Jon Octeus** announced he will be attend Purdue and be eligible immediately via the NCAA's graduate-student transfer rule.

• Octeus, who will seek his master's degree in the school of technology, averaged 13.4 points, 4.7 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game at Colorado State, while starting all 32 games.

• Octeus averaged over 20.0 points per game against ranked opposition, scoring 27 points against Gonzaga and 24 against San Diego State. Over the last 13 games of the season, Octeus averaged 16.6 points per game.

• The most-telling statistic of Octeus' game is his ability to get to the free throw line. Octeus had seven games where he attempted at least 10 free throws. Last year, Purdue's team had just 10 such instances.

■ Sophomores Coming Off Big Rookie Campaigns

• This year's sophomore class is coming off a strong rookie campaign and has hopes of helping return the Boilmakers to the NCAA Tournament.

• The group scored 726 points (22.7 points per game) a year ago, the sixth most by a freshman class in school history. All three players reached some sort of accolades during the year.

• **Kendall Stephens** earned All-Big Ten Freshman team accolades after making 64 three-pointers, the second most by a freshman in school history.

• **Basil Smotherman** shot 58.0 percent from the field, the third-best percentage by a freshman in school history (min. 100 attempts).

• **Bryson Scott** became the first Boilmaker freshman in school history to be named Big Ten Freshman of the Week twice.

■ Protecting The Rim

• Purdue's 168 blocked shots were the second most in a season in school history, while its 5.3 blocked shots per game average was the highest mark in school history. Purdue led the conference in blocked shots per game for the first time during the **Matt Painter** era.

• Purdue is now 68-5 under **Matt Painter** at home against non-conference opponents.

• Through Friday, the Boilmakers were second nationally in defensive effective field goal percentage, according to KenPom.com(.)

• Since the start of the 2012-13 season, **Matt Painter** has started 25 different starting combinations in 67 games.

• Purdue shot 65.4 percent from inside the three-point line on Friday, the 13th-best percentage nationally.

• Purdue held Samford to 26.1 percent shooting inside the arc on Friday, to rank ninth nationally.

• 51.5 percent of Purdue's minutes on Friday came from the bench to lead the country on Friday night. Iowa was second at 48.2 percent.

• It's early, but **Dakota Mathias** is 54th nationally in Offensive Rating according to KenPom.com(.)

Boilers' Defense Struggles

• Meanwhile, the Purdue defense struggled allowing 71.7 points per game, the highest average for opponents since the 1997-98 season (72.3 points per game). Purdue allowed opponents to reach 70 points in 19 games, posting a 6-13 record when opponents reached that mark. Purdue was 9-4 when holding foes to 69 or fewer points.

Tracking the Returnees

• Purdue returns three starters from last year's team that went 15-17 overall. The three starters (Hammons, Smotherman, Stephens) combined for 57 starts among them while **Rapheal Davis** (15) and **Bryson Scott** (2) added 17 starts between them for a total of 74 starts returning.

• The 74 returning starts from the previous year are the fourth fewest for a Painter-coached squad at Purdue. The only years that had fewer returning starts were 2012-13 (53), 2007-08 (59) and 2006-07 (55).

• This marks the fourth time under Painter that the team returns fewer than 75 starts from the previous year. The combined record of those three squads is 63-38 with a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances (2007, 2008).

• Purdue led the Big Ten in offensive rebounds per game in all contests (13.9) and conference games only (13.6). The 13.9 offensive rebounds per game were the most for a season during the Painter era.

• Purdue's plus-3.5 rebound margin was good for fourth in the Big Ten, its highest finish in the Big Ten during the Painter era. The plus-3.5 rebound margin was the second-best total during the **Matt Painter** era.

• In league play only, Purdue boasted a plus-4.9 margin, good for second in the league.

Turnovers The Major Difference

• In the four years from 2009 to 2012 that Purdue made the NCAA Tournament, the Boilermakers' yearly NCAA ranking in turnover margin were 24th, 4th, 14th and 9th, an average placing of 12.8. In the last two years, the Boilermakers ranked 257th and 230th, an average ranking of 238.5.

• From 2007 to 2012, Purdue never ranked lower than third (once in 2007) and led the Big Ten in 2008, 2010 and 2012 in turnover margin. In the last two years, Purdue has ranked 12th and 11th, respectively.

• From 2008 to 2012, Purdue ranked 53rd, 17th, 15th, ninth and first in turnovers per game, an average national ranking of 19th. Over the last two years, Purdue has ranked 116th and 178th, an average of 147th.

Protecting the Rock

• It may have appeared that Purdue struggled with turnovers last season, but actually Purdue finished with its sixth-fewest turnovers in school history (393) and sixth-lowest turnover average (12.3 per game).

Dialing Long Distance

• Sophomore **Kendall Stephens** ended last season second on the school's freshman three-pointers made list with 64, leading all Big Ten freshmen. He earned All-Big Ten Freshman team accolades after averaging 8.0 points per game, and now that he is 100 percent healthy, Stephens could be ready to break out in 2014-15.

• However, Stephens accounts for 64 of the team's 80 returning three-pointers made from a year ago. Just one other returning player, **Rapheal Davis** (9), made more than six three-pointers in 2013-14. All told, the program returns just 90 career three-pointers made.

• Painter is hoping that incoming freshmen **Dakota Mathias**, **Vince Edwards** and **P.J. Thompson** will be able to strengthen the team's perimeter attack as all three players enter their collegiate careers regarded as strong perimeter shooters.

• The Boilermakers are hoping they can contribute immediately. Over the last two seasons, Purdue has made just 321 three-pointers in the 66 games played (4.86 per game), the fewest in a two-year span since 2005 and 2006 (288 three-pointers). From 2007-12, Purdue made 1,422 three-pointers in 209 games (6.80 per game).

• Over the last two years, Purdue is 321-of-991 (.324) from three-point range. From 2007-12, Purdue was 1,422-of-3,983 (.357) from long distance.

Have We Met Before?

• Purdue will face four first-time opponents this year in Grambling, IUPUI, Gardner-Webb and Arkansas State, but if past records against the respective leagues mean anything, Purdue can expect success.

• Against the four respective leagues (Big South, SWAC, Summit, Sun Belt), Purdue is a combined 28-0 entering the 2014-15 season.

Road Warriors

• Purdue's 37 "true" road wins since the 2007-08 season are the fourth most in the Big Ten (Michigan State, Wisconsin, Ohio State). These four programs are the only Big Ten schools with a winning percentage greater than 40.0 percent on the road during that span.

• With a pair of Sweet 16 appearances, six NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 10th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.

• Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season.

• Painter has averaged over 21 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 20 victories in six of those seasons.

• Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last eight years have seen six 20-win seasons and NCAA Tournament berths, two Sweet 16 appearances, a regular-season Big Ten title and a Big Ten Tournament crown.

• The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.

• Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.

• The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.

• Painter has also resurrected Mackey Arena as one of the country's best home-court advantages, piling up a 123-28 (.815) record at home over the last nine seasons, including a remarkable 67-5 (.931) record against non-conference opponents.

• Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times in the last six seasons, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.

• Painter has seen a total of 21 players earn a combined 38 Academic All-Big Ten honors during his tenure as head coach. Painter has also mentored an Academic All-American, as Moore earned second-team honors during the 2009-10 season.

• In addition, the program has received the NCAA Public Recognition Award for posting a multi-year academic progress rate among the top 10 percent. Purdue has had an APR of at least .985 in each of the last three years, one of two schools in the Big Ten that can stake that claim (Michigan).
