THE SCENE SETTER

• The Purdue men's basketball team looks to get back on track Saturday at Mackey Arena when Chicago State visits as part of the Emerald Coast Classic. Tip will be at 2:05 p.m. ET, and will be streamed online only at BTNPlus.com. **Mike Foltz** and **Liam Archer** will handle the call courtside. On the radio dial, the game will be broadcast on the Purdue Radio Network and online at Tuneln.com, with **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** handling the duties, beginning with the Purdue Basketball Pregame Show at 1 p.m. ET. Live stats will be provided on PurdueStats.com, and Twitter updates available at @BoilerBall.

THE MAIN TALKING POINTS

- Purdue is looking to bounce back after consecutive defeats to Texas and Marquette. The Boilermakers haven't lost three straight non-conference games since Dec. 13 to 22, 2014 (Vanderbilt, Notre Dame, Gardner-Webb).
- Purdue saw an 18-game home winning streak end in its last Mackey Arena appearance, a 70-66 setback to Texas. The Boilermakers haven't lost two straight home games since Feb. 20 to March 9, 2014 (three straight losses to Michigan State, Michigan and Northwestern).
- Among teams ranked in the KenPom top 100, Purdue (Texas, Marquette), Ohio State (Cincinnati, Villanova) and Michigan State (Kentucky, Seton Hall) are the only teams in America to play two top-25 squads.
- Since the 2014-15 season, Purdue is 16-4 in games played that are part of in-season tournaments. Saturday's game is part of the Emerald Coast Classic. The Boilermakers are looking for their first tournament title since the 2016 Cancun Challenge.
- Over the last two games, Purdue is averaging just 60.5 points per game and shooting 37.5 percent from the field. The Boilermakers are just 31 of 80 (.388) from inside the 3-point line in the last two games.
- Over the last two games, Purdue has 33 offensive rebounds resulting in just 27 second-chance points.
- Purdue is outscoring foes 107-78 (9.7 points per game) in the first half, but is getting outscored 114-93 (7.0 points per game) in the second half.
- **Matt Haarms** needs one block to tie **John Allison** for fifth on Purdue's all-time blocked shots list with 165. Haarms (164 blocks) has played in just 76 career games.

THE SERIES

- Purdue owns a 3-0 series advantage against Chicago State, last facing the Cougars on Nov. 12, 2017.
- The game is part of the Emerald Coast Classic, which will bring all eight teams to Destin, Florida, during Thanksgiving week.
- Purdue's three wins have come by an average of 33.3 points per game. The Boilermakers won on Dec. 6, 2003 (75-57), Dec. 6, 2005 (69-56) and the previously mentioned 2017 game (111-42).
- Purdue is just 3-1 all-time against current members of the Western Athletic Conference. The Boilermakers are 3-0 against Chicago State and 0-1 against New Mexico State.

- Purdue is 21-3 when **Matt Haarms** scores in double figures.
- Purdue is 150-16 under **Matt Painter** when shooting 48.0 percent or better from the field.
- Purdue is 21-1 since the start of last year when shooting a higher percentage from the field than its opponent. The lone loss was to Virginia in the Elite Eight.
- Purdue is 102-9 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponent, including 18-2 since the start last season.
- Purdue is 29-5 since the start of the 2017-18 season when making 10 or more 3-pointers in a game.
- Purdue is 116-12 under Painter when winning both rebound and turnover battles.
- Purdue is 117-12 under Painter when scoring at least 80 points, including 31-2 since the start of 2017-18 (both losses last year).

BIG MAN PRODUCTION

- There are three players on the roster shooting at least 45.0 percent from the field. Two of the three are Purdue's centers.
- Matt Haarms** and **Trevion Williams** are a combined 21 of 33 (.636) from the field. The rest of the team is a combined 55 of 148 (.372) from the field.

NO CHARITY

- Purdue is making just 56.0 percent of its free throw attempts, having converted on just 28 of 50 from the charity stripe.
- Purdue's 42.1 percent free throw shooting against Marquette was its lowest when having at least 20 attempts since Feb. 5, 2014, vs. Minnesota (9 of 23; .391).
- Purdue currently ranks 319th in free throw percentage.

HAARMS HAS PERSONAL BLOCK PARTY

- Purdue center **Matt Haarms** had a monster game in the season opener. Some noteworthy facts about it.
- With 16 points, 7 rebounds, 7 blocks, 3 assists and 2 made 3-pointers, he became the second player nationally since the 2010-11 season to reach those marks in the same game.

- With The Paint Crew in attendance, Purdue is 56-3 (.949) at home over its last 59 games (losses to Villanova, Ohio State, Texas).
- Purdue is 42-4 at home against Big Ten opponents since the start of the 2014-15 season (losses to Maryland, Iowa, Minnesota, Ohio St.). The record is the best in the Big Ten during that stretch by 4.5 games (Michigan State is 37-8).

WHAT COULDA BEEN

- Even in Purdue's five losses at home over the last five years, Purdue can play the what-if game.

► **Jan. 2, 2016 vs. Iowa (L, 70-63)** ... Purdue had a 17-point halftime lead (37-20) and led by as much as 19 late in the first half. Iowa used a trapping full-court press to get back in the game.

► **Nov. 14, 2016 vs. Villanova (L, 79-76)** ... Purdue just could not get over the hump late in the second half of its loss to the defending national champion. Villanova never trailed, but Purdue was within one point five different times in the final five minutes.

► **Jan. 1, 2017 vs. Minnesota (L, 91-82; ot)** ... Purdue led by seven with 13:40 left, but couldn't hold on in regulation, falling in overtime.

► **Feb. 7, 2018 vs. Ohio State (L, 64-63)** ... Purdue led by 14 with 10:17 to play, but Ohio State completed a rally with a last-second tip-in by Big Ten player of the Year Keita Bates-Diop.

► **Nov. 9, 2019 vs. Texas (L, 70-66)** ... Purdue led by five with three minutes to play, but three straight turnovers helped the Longhorns to the comeback victory.

EVERY LOSS HURTS

- Purdue hasn't lost by double-figures at Mackey Arena since Feb. 20, 2014, a 94-79 loss to Michigan State. Its last 10 home losses have come by a total of 51 points (5.1 points per game).

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 322-161 (.667) / 15th year | **Career Record:** 347-166 (.676) / 16th year

- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his resumé, 15th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter enters the 2019-20 season third on the school's all-time wins list (321) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 14 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year (9-19 record), the average balloons to 24.0 wins per year over the last 13 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in nine of his 15 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.3 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just two active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 13 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 11 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Through last year, Painter's 346 wins were the second most nationally for a coach nationally in under 15 years of coaching.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2020 -- Painter is 49 years old).
- Has produced draft picks in each of the last four years, one of only four programs nationally that can say that.
- Purdue is one of five teams to have a Naismith position award finalist in each of the last four years.
- Purdue has finished first or second in Big Ten play in seven of Painter's last 12 years.
