• Purdue begins the second half of the regular season with another trip north, visiting the Twin Cities for the third time in the last four years for a three-game series at Minnesota.

• The Boilermakers have won five of their last seven games at Siebert Field – taking 2 of 3 to end the 2017 regular season and 3 of 4 in the penultimate weekend of 2021. Prior to 2017, Purdue had gone without a series win in Minneapolis since 2000. The Boilers also played at Minnesota's six-team tournament inside U.S. Bank Stadium two weeks before the shutdown in 2020.

• Purdue scored 46 runs over the four games at Siebert Field two years ago. **Jake Parr** hit the first of his two career grand slams, **Cam Thompson** connected for a three-run homer and **Mike Bolton Jr.'s** .526 on-base percentage led to five stolen bases and nine runs scored. Parr finished the series 6-for-15.

• Three of Purdue's first six Big Ten games this season have been one-run affairs, with the Boilers managing to win a pair of them. **Khal Stephen** and **Aaron Suval** have teamed up to lead Purdue to consecutive series-opening wins over the first two weekends of conference play, combining for 22 strikeouts over 20 2/3 innings. The Boilermakers rallied for their Friday victories – overcoming a 4-0 deficit entering the fourth inning at Michigan State and a 2-1 deficit entering the seventh inning vs. Northwestern.

HEAD COACH GREG GOFF

Greg Goff joined Purdue baseball as an assistant coach in July 2017 and was promoted to head coach in June 2019. The 2023 season is his 18th as a collegiate head coach.

Previously a head coach at four universities, Goff succeeded his friend and longtime colleague Mark Wasikowski, who returned to the University of Oregon as the Ducks' new head coach in June 2019.

Goff has previously served as the head coach at Campbell University (2008-14), Louisiana Tech University (2015-16) and the University of Alabama (2017) as well as Division II University of Montevallo (2004-07). He also helped lead the Boilermakers to a memorable 38-win season in 2018, punctuated by the program's third NCAA Regional bid in program history. Purdue finished second in the Big Ten standings and was also the runner-up at the Big Ten Tournament in Goff's first year with the program.

A national-best 15-0 start, program records for strikeouts and stolen bases, and a return to the Big Ten Tournament highlighted Purdue's resurgent and successful 2022 season. The Boilermakers raced out the best start in program history as the final unbeaten team nationally and recovered from a rough patch in April to return to the conference tournament, navigating a challenging back half of the league schedule. Purdue eclipsed its program benchmark in steals behind the first trio of Boilermakers ever with 20-plus steals each. Curtis Washington Jr. (31), Mike Bolton Jr. (28) and Evan Albrecht (22) teamed up to account for 81 of the 116 stolen bases (70%) as Purdue led the Big Ten and ranked sixth nationally in steals per game. CJ Valdez was a first-team All-Big Ten performer as a full-time DH; Cam Thompson also enjoyed a breakout season with 13 home runs and a 1.031 OPS.

Along with bringing an upbeat personality to the dugout and contagious energy to his role as the first-base coach, Goff helped numerous Boilermakers develop offensively in 2018 and 2019 as an assistant coach. He played a leading role in coaching the base running and outfield defense.

In his first two years at Purdue, Goff helped develop and organize new community events for the program like the Preseason Fan Fest and first pitch dinner. Both events have proved very popular and are well attended, helping generate preseason interest going into a campaign.

The Boilermakers also continue to expand their community outreach, exceeding 600 combined hours of service for the 2021-22 academic year. During the 2019 fall semester, over 40 players logged at least 10 hours of community service as Purdue completed over 450 hours of community outreach as a team.

Goff and his wife, Tina, are the parents of four daughters: Kara, Kiley, Kolby and Kenzie. Kara (Louisiana Tech & LSU) and Kiley (Maryland, active) both played collegiate softball.

SIX 40-WIN SEASONS

- As a head coach, Goff's teams have won over 40 games six times. Campbell was one of only eight Division I programs to win 40-plus games for three straight years from 2012 to 2014, posting 131 total victories during that span. The Camels enjoyed a historic 49-10 campaign in 2013.
- He also won 42 games in his final season at Louisiana Tech, helping lead the Bulldogs to an NCAA Regional bid.
- Montevallo was a DII College World Series qualifier in 2006 under his guidance. As an assistant coach at Delta State, the Statesmen also qualified for the DII College World Series in 1994 and 1996.

ENDED NCAA REGIONAL DROUGHTS AT CAMPBELL & LOUISIANA TECH

- In Goff's final season at Campbell (2014), the Camels qualified for their first NCAA Regional in 24 years. Two years later, he led Louisiana Tech to its first Regional bid in 29 years. The 2014 Camels and 2016 Bulldogs both won at least one game in their Regionals, with La Tech coming through the loser's bracket to reach a Regional final at Mississippi State.

HISTORY OF TURNAROUNDS

- Goff's teams have had a losing record only five times in his 14 years as a head coach. Four of those five seasons were his first at a respective university. He has led his teams to some impressive turnarounds.
- In just two seasons, Louisiana Tech went from 15-35 the year before Goff's arrival to 42-20 in 2016, ending a 29-year NCAA Regional drought in the process. At Campbell, he inherited a team that was 11-45 in 2007. But under Goff, the Camels posted a winning record (27-24) in his second season and won 40 games by his fifth year (2012).
- Purdue's win total also jumped from 29-27 in 2017 to 38-21 in Goff's first year on the staff in 2018.

COACHING HONORS

- Goff was named the South Central Region Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association at both Louisiana Tech (2016) and Montevallo (2006). He was the 2013 Big South Coach of the Year at Campbell after leading his team to a school-record 49 wins and a conference title. Montevallo won a combined 100 games over his final two seasons, posting a new single-season record both years.

BEFORE BECOMING A HEAD COACH

- Goff has coached 10 future big leaguers and over 50 MLB Draft picks, highlighted by Cy Young award winner Brandon Webb while he was the pitching coach at Kentucky (2000-03). Longtime big leaguer and World Series champion Joe Blanton also pitched for Goff at Kentucky.
- Along with his years as the pitching coach at Kentucky, Goff served as an assistant at Southeast Missouri State (1998-99) and his alma mater Delta State (1994-97) before becoming a head coach for the first time in the summer of 2003 at Montevallo. It was at SEMO in the late 1990s where he first worked with Wasikowski. They helped lead the Redhawks to an NCAA Regional in 1998.

- Purdue's first sophomore to be the Opening Day starter since 2016.
- Pitched in a team-high 23 games in 2022 as Purdue's first freshman to lead the team in appearances since 2001.
- Averaged 10.16 strikeouts per nine innings, moving into ninth place on Purdue's single-season list (minimum 30 innings).
- Struck out five of the six batters he faced in the May 10 vs. Butler, posting the best clip (83%) of batters struck out with a minimum five Ks since 2005.
- Also fanned six of 12 batters faced in the game 2 win at Iowa, including four in a row.

BEST STRETCH OF THE SEASON ON THE MOUND

- Khal Stephen, Aaron Suval and Jonathan Blackwell teamed up for 13 innings of one-run ball over the first half of the Michigan State series, accounting for a combined 12 zeros from the third inning of game 1 through the sixth inning of game 2. Considering it came on the road against a potent lineup that scored 16 runs over the final 10 innings of the series, it certainly ranks as Purdue's finest stretch of the season on the mound.
- Friday in East Lansing, the Boilermakers overcame a four-run deficit of its own for the first time since an 11-inning win vs. Longwood in the finale of the eight-game North Carolina road trip last season. Purdue did it in conference play for the first time since the 2021 season finale vs. Minnesota.
- The 13 innings of one-run ball is a feat the Boilermakers have now accomplished five times under head coach Greg Goff (2020-present). Purdue did it twice last year and also achieved a stretch of 15 innings of one-run ball vs. Michigan State in 2021. Calvin Schapira led the way in 2021 with eight innings of one-run ball in a 2-1 pitcher's duel Purdue won on an 11th-inning walk-off in Champaign.
- In the Akron series the first weekend of March, Kyle Iwinski's seven-inning complete-game shutout buoyed a stretch in which Purdue had 10 consecutive scoreless innings and allowed just two runs over 14 frames.
