The Scene Setter

- The No. 16-ranked Purdue men's basketball team closes out its pre-Holiday portion of the schedule as Tennessee State visits Mackey Arena on Thursday for a 6 p.m. ET tip.
- The game will be televised by the Big Ten Network with **Brandon Gaudin** and **Robbie Hummel** on the call. **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** will handle the radio broadcast on the Purdue Radio Network and live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com. Fans can receive in-game updates on Purdue Basketball's official Twitter account (@BoilerBall).
- Purdue is looking for its eighth straight win and to head into the Holiday break with a victory for the 12th time in 13 games under head coach **Matt Painter**.
- The Boilermakers will close out non-conference play when they return from break with a Dec. 30, matchup against another opponent from Tennessee, Lipscomb, for an 8 p.m. tip in Mackey Arena.

LOOKING BACK

- After going winless in its first five appearances in the Crossroads Classic, Purdue won its second straight game in the annual, in-state tradition, defeating Butler 82-67 last Saturday.
- Purdue snapped a five-game losing skid to Butler with the victory. Prior to Saturday, Purdue's last win over Butler came on Dec. 19, 1998.
- Purdue has won six straight games against in-state opponents and hasn't lost to a team from Indiana since Feb. 20, 2016 (a span of 670 days).
- Purdue's starting five scored in double-figures for the third time (Maryland, Tennessee, Butler).
- The Boilermakers shot 52.9 percent from the field and after starting the game 2-of-9 from deep, finished the contest making seven of their last 12 3-point tries.
- **Carsen Edwards** led the Boilermakers with 18 points, four assists and four rebounds.

► Busy Schedule, but now a Long Break

- Purdue has had one of the nation's busiest schedules, having already played 13 games. No high-major program in America has played more games than Purdue (through Monday).
- However, Purdue now enters a stretch where it has nine days off following Thursday's contest, the second-longest, in-season break during the Painter era (2012-13; 11 days).
- After its win over IUPUI on Dec. 10, Purdue will play just three games in 20 days from Dec. 11 to 30 (Butler - Dec. 16; TSU - Dec. 21; Lipscomb - Dec. 30).
- Purdue opened the season playing 12 games in the season's first 31 days (Nov. 10 to Dec. 10).

► The Jinx is Over

- After going 0-5 in the first five Crossroads Classic, Purdue has won two in a row in the event, now owning the longest win streak in the annual event between the four major Indiana institutions.

► Making Our Statement

- Last Saturday's game with Butler marked the final contest of a three-game set against in-state, non-conference opponents (Valpo, IUPUI, Butler).
- With the win over Butler, the Boilermakers have won six straight games against in-state foes and haven't lost to a team from Indiana since Feb. 20, 2016 (670 days).
- Since the start of the 2014-15 season, Purdue has defeated six different in-state teams (Butler, IUPUI, Fort Wayne, Notre Dame, Indiana, Valparaiso) and is 11-3 against in-state teams.
- Since the start of last year, Purdue is 20-4 against teams from the state of Indiana and bordering states, including 7-1 this year. The four losses are to Louisville, Western Kentucky and Michigan (twice).
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue is 30-9 against Indiana and bordering states.
- Just one Indiana school, Evansville (one game; last game in 2005), now holds a winning streak against the Boilermakers.

► Surpassing a Legend

- With Purdue's win over Valparaiso on Dec. 7, head coach **Matt Painter** moved into fourth place on the school's career win percentage list, passing **Gene Keady** in the process.
- Painter coached in his 450th career game in Saturday's win over Butler. He now owns a 301-149 career record.

- With Purdue's win over IUPUI on Dec. 10, head coach **Matt Painter** won his 300th career game. He is just 1-of-15 coaches (10 active) in NCAA history to have won 300 games by the end of their 14th year.

► 2-0 Big Ten Starts are Hard to Come By

- Following its win over Northwestern, Purdue is now 2-0 in Big Ten play for the first time since the 2014-15 season, and for the fifth time under Coach Painter (2017-18, 2014-15, 2010-11, 2009-10).
- Purdue had lost its second game of the conference season at home during the previous two seasons, suffering their only home conference loss of those respective seasons. Purdue lost to Iowa (70-63) in 2015-16 and to Minnesota in overtime (91-82) in 2016-17. Purdue also lost its third home game of the conference season in 2014-15 (Maryland, 69-60).
- The Boilermakers' best league start during the Painter era came in 2010-11 when the Boilermakers started 4-0.

► Automatic Victory

- With the Nov. 18 win over Fairfield, Purdue has now won 89 straight games when scoring 90 or more points, dating to Nov. 24, 1987, against Iowa State (L, 104-96).
- Entering the game with Tennessee State, it will have been 10,985 days since Purdue lost when scoring 90 points.
- The average price of gas the last time Purdue lost when scoring 90 points was \$0.96 and **Ronald Reagan** was the President. The price of a stamp was 22 cents.

► December Reign

- Purdue has won 14 straight games in the month of December, dating to the 2015-16 season. During the span, the Boilermakers have had victories against Vanderbilt, Wisconsin, Arizona State, Notre Dame, Maryland, Northwestern and Butler among others.
- Purdue's last loss in December came on Dec. 19, 2015 -- to Butler in the Crossroads Classic.

► Play Fast Then Grind You Down

- Purdue has an interesting analytic on both ends of the floor that is extremely rare. The Boilermakers rank 25th offensively in average possession length (15.2), but are 337th nationally in defensive average possession length (18.3), for a difference of 312 spots, the largest difference in the country.

► The 100-Start Man

- Vincent Edwards** became the 16th player in Purdue history to start 100 career games when he earned the nod against Maryland on Dec. 1. Edwards could finish as high as second on the career starts list (**E'Twaun Moore** - 136; **Brian Cardinal** - 125).

► The Run Tracker

- Purdue has already had 39 runs of seven points or more this year, compared to just 13 for opponents. Purdue has had 16 runs of 10 or more points to just three for opponents.

- Purdue is now 36-4 when **Ryan Cline** has at least two assists in a game after he had two vs. Northwestern.
- Dakota Mathias** has had at least two 3-pointers in 57-of-117 career games (47-10 record). He has at least four 3-pointers in 11 of them.
- Purdue is 29-5 when **Carsen Edwards** gets the starting nod and 24-4 when he scores 10 or more points.
- Purdue is 54-13 all-time when **Vincent Edwards** scores 10 or more points, but just 30-19 when he doesn't.
- Purdue is 32-6 all-time when **Dakota Mathias** scores 10-plus points.

Red-Hot Stretch

- Purdue has won seven straight games and despite boasting a high-powered offense, has excelled on the defensive end.
- During that stretch, Purdue has allowed just 63.3 points per game and foes are shooting just 29.6 percent from 3-point range and 38.5 percent from the field. Purdue has blocked 44 shots during that span.
- Meanwhile on the offensive end, Purdue has snapped out of a mini-funk, shooting 53.7 percent from the field in the last two games, while making 35-of-41 (.854) from the free throw line.

Cashing in on Freebies

- Purdue's five starters are all shooting at least 80.5 percent from the free throw line (Thompson - .923; V. Edwards - .909; C. Edwards - .814; Mathias - .806; Haas - .805).
- Purdue's five starters are shooting a combined 203-of-242 (.839) from the free throw line.
- Perhaps the most impressive stat is **Isaac Haas'** 80.5 free throw percentage. He shot 54.7 percent (76-of-139) as a freshman.
- It's a good thing that Purdue is so proficient at shooting free throws. The Boilermakers rank second nationally in free throws made (234) behind just South Dakota State (237) and have made more free throws (234) than opponents have shot (185).
- Purdue is 70-5 since the start of the 2014-15 season when attempting more free throws than its opponents, and 31-3 since start of last year.

Get to the Stripe

- Over the last four games, Purdue has shot 89 free throws to just 38 for opponents. Purdue is outscoring foes 68 to 26 from the free throw line over the last four games.

- With a trio of Sweet 16 appearances, nine NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 13th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 22 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 25 victories in six seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last 10 years have seen six 25-win seasons and eight NCAA Tournament berths, three Sweet 16 appearances, two regular-season Big Ten titles and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
