THE SCENE SETTER

- The Purdue men's basketball team puts its six-game win streak on the line as Minnesota visits for a Super Bowl Sunday showdown.
- The contest will be televised on BTN with **Kevin Kugler** and **Jon Crispin** calling the action courtside beginning at noon ET. On the radio waves, the contest will be available on the Purdue Radio Network and TuneIn.com with **Larry Clisby**, **Rob Blackman** and **Ralph Taylor** on the call, beginning with the Purdue Basketball pregame show at 11 a.m. **Wes Scott** will produce the radio broadcast.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com, and Twitter updates will be available on Purdue's official account (@BoilerBall).

THE MAIN TALKING POINTS

- 1) Purdue has won a season-best six straight games entering Sunday's tilt with the Golden Gophers. It marks the seventh season under Painter that Purdue has had at least a six-game Big Ten winning streak. In the previous six years, Purdue has finished 2nd, T-2nd, T-1st, 2nd, 1st and T-2nd.
- 2) Purdue has won 12 straight home games dating to last year, ranking as the 16th-longest streak in America and third longest in the Big Ten. In games that The Paint Crew is in attendance at Mackey Arena, Purdue has won 50 of its last 52 games.
- 3) **Matt Painter** won his 150th Big Ten game Thursday, becoming the 14th coach in league history with 150 regular-season Big Ten wins.
- 4) Purdue is back in the national rankings for the first time since Nov. 27, when it was voted 17th this week. The ranking is the highest of the season. Since 2015-16, Purdue has spent 61 of 70 weeks in the AP poll, including 51 weeks inside the top 20.
- 5) During Purdue's six-game winning streak, the Boilermakers are shooting 72 of 156 (.462) from 3-point range. Purdue is averaging 10.9 made 3-pointers per game this year to lead the Big Ten. Michigan State is second at 8.6 per game.
- 6) Purdue continues to excel on the offensive end, ranking second nationally in offensive efficiency. Purdue finished second a year ago behind National Champion Villanova.
- 7) Sunday's game marks a 3-game in 7-day stretch for the Boilermakers. Following Sunday's contest, the Boilermakers are off for six days.
- 8) Under **Matt Painter**, Purdue has been one of the best offensive teams in America. The Boilermakers have ranked in the nation's top 25 in offensive efficiency in six of the last nine seasons (lone years not in top 25: 2014-15, 2013-14, 2012-13).
- 9) **Carsen Edwards** ranks fifth nationally in scoring (24.9 PPG). Since the 1992-93 season, just two other Big Ten players (Purdue's **Glenn Robinson** 2x, Michigan State's **Shawn Respert** 2x) have averaged at least 24.0 points per game in a season.
- 10) **Ryan Cline** has sparked Purdue's recent surge, making 30 of 53 (.566) of his 3-pointers over the last eight games.

THE SERIES

- Sunday's meeting marks the 187th meeting all-time between Purdue and Minnesota with the Boilermakers holding a 103-83 series advantage, having won two straight games and five of the last seven contests.
- The 186 meetings make the series the eighth-most frequently-played rivalry among Big Ten teams. Purdue's 103 wins are the fourth-most against a single opponent, while Minnesota's 83 wins are also the fourth most against Purdue.
- Purdue is 39-7 all-time against Minnesota in Mackey Arena, including 9-1 under head coach **Matt Painter**. The lone loss was a 91-82 overtime setback on New Year's Day in 2017.

SO MANY THINGS HAPPENED VS. PENN STATE

- So many things happened in the win over Penn State, it was hard to keep track.
- **Carsen Edwards** scored 38 points and tied a school record by making eight 3-pointers (**Robbie Hummel**, **Ryne Smith**, **Cuonzo Martin**).
- Edwards and **Ryan Cline** combined for 14 3-pointers, the most by a duo in a single game in school history.
- There have been just 20 games nationally this year (none by major-college team) that a team won a game when its opponent had 20 or more free throw attempts. Penn State had 41 attempts, Purdue had 21.
- Purdue's 16 3-pointers were a season high and the fifth most in school history for the Boilermakers.
- It marked the 13th nationally this year where one team made at least 16 3-pointers (Purdue) and the opponent made at least 12 (Penn State). The two teams were a combined 28-of-58 from long distance.

BIG TEN WIN NO. 150 FOR PAINTER

- The win over Penn State was **Matt Painter's** 150th in Big Ten regular-season play, tying Ohio State's **Thad Matta** for 13th on the wins list.
- Entering the season, Painter was averaging 10.9 wins per season, the fifth-best average in league history.

DURING THE STREAK

- During Purdue's six-game winning streak, the Boilermakers have trailed for just 19:23 with just 3:34 coming after halftime.
- The Boilermakers have led by double-digits for 87:36 of a possible 250:00 during the streak.

THE POWER OF MACKEY ARENA & THE PAINT CREW

- Mackey Arena has been a special place to play basketball and Sunday's atmosphere vs. Michigan State rivaled anything the building has seen.
- With the Paint Crew in attendance, Purdue has won 50 of its last 52 games (losses to Villanova in Nov. 2016, and Ohio State in Feb. 2018).
- Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue's .935 winning percentage (58-4) in Mackey Arena is the second-best home winning percentage in America, behind just Kentucky (.937).
- Purdue is 37-4 at home against Big Ten opponents since the start of the 2014-15 season (losses to Maryland, Iowa, Minnesota, Ohio St.). The record is the best in the Big Ten during that stretch by 3.5 games (Michigan State - 33-7).
- Purdue has won 12 straight games in the arena by an average of 18.6 points per game. Just three games have been decided by single-digits during that span (Penn State last year - 3; Ball State - 9; Maryland - 2).
- The arena reached 115.7 decibels in the win over Indiana last Saturday. The reading did not crack the top six (since readings started in 2009-10). The record is 122.3 dB set against Indiana on Feb. 28, 2017 -- equivalent to a chain saw or oxygen torch. The average human pain threshold for sound is 110 dB.

STREAKING TOWARDS THE TOP OF THE BIG TEN

- Purdue has won six games in a row in the Big Ten, which usually means a good sign under Coach Painter.

THE SHOT VOLUME INDEX

- Thanks to ESPN's analytics guru **John Gasaway**, Purdue has found a model of success this year, based on low turnover percentage and high offensive rebounds percentage, which equals Shot Volume Index. Purdue is second in the country behind Virginia.

SHOOTING WINS

- Purdue is 143-15 under Painter when shooting over 48.0 percent, including 7-1 this season. The lone loss came to Virginia Tech (.508).

ONE OF THE NATION'S TOUGHEST SCHEDULES

- Purdue has played one of the nation's most-difficult schedules to date and could rise even higher thanks to a rigorous Big Ten slate.
- According to ESPN BPI and the NCAA NET, Purdue's schedule currently ranks 2nd in the country behind Kansas. The Boilermakers are followed by Big Ten friends Michigan State, Illinois and Wisconsin.
- In Big Ten play only, Purdue will face a team that was ranked at the time of the game or ranked in the Dec. 31, poll in eight of its first nine league games.
- Purdue has played 16 teams ranked in the KenPom top 100, posting a 10-6 overall record. Every Big Ten team is ranked in the top 90.
- The strength of schedule has helped Purdue to a No. 11 NET rating. The next closest six-loss team not in the Big Ten is Auburn (25th; 12-6).

HEAD COACH MATT PAINTER

► **Record at Purdue:** 310-155 (.667) / 14th year | **Career Record:** 335-160 (.677) / 15th year

- With four Sweet 16 appearances, 10 NCAA Tournament berths, two Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title and an international gold medal on his résumé, 14th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.
- Painter entered the 2018-19 season third on the school's all-time wins list (295) behind legendary mentors, Gene Keady and Ward "Piggy" Lambert, both of whom have been inducted into the College Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Has averaged almost 23 wins a season in his 13 years at Purdue. If you don't include the first transitional year, the average balloons to 23.8 wins per year over the last 12 seasons.
- Has won at least 25 games in eight of his 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- Painter's three Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the fourth most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 10.9 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just three active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 10 NCAA Tournaments in the last 12 years are the ninth most in the country.
- Purdue's four Sweet 16 appearances in the last 10 years are the ninth most nationally.
