THE OPENING TIP

The Purdue men's basketball team looks to rebound from its first road loss in a month when Northwestern visits Mackey for the lone meeting between the two teams during the 2020-21 season. Brandon Gaudin, who will announce the game in a robe and slippers, will be joined by former Maryland great and Indiana Pacer Len Elmore.

The Boilermakers fell to Elmore's alma mater, Maryland, on Tuesday 61-60. The Boilermakers led virtually the entire game, but the Terrapins used a 6-0 run over the last 90 seconds to steal the victory. With just eight games left, Purdue looks to make one last surge in the Big Ten.

THE KEY TALKING POINTS

- Purdue leads the series with Northwestern by a 132-46 advantage, having won eight straight games by a combined 78 points. The 132 victories are the most for the Boilermakers against an opponent. Four of the last eight wins have come by eight or fewer points.
- According to KenPom.com, Purdue ranks 328th (out of 347 teams) in experience (1.06 years). The total is 14th in the Big Ten. Indiana is the next least-experienced team in the league at 1.35 years (288th nationally).
- Purdue has had its full arsenal of rotation players for just 10 of its 19 games this year, missing key personnel for nine games this year. Purdue went 7-3 in those 10 games with a full roster, all coming against power-conference teams.
- Purdue will welcome back Sasha Stefanovic to the lineup after missing three games (CoVid-19). The Boilermakers shot 14-of-44 (.318) from 3-point range in the three games without him. Stefanovic is the Big Ten's leader in 3-point percentage (.456), ranking ninth nationally.
- Matt Painter needs one win for 350 in his 16th year at Purdue and one win for 175 victories in Big Ten play.
- Four freshmen have earned Big Ten Freshman of the Week honors, the most in league history. Michigan (2012-13) and Ohio St. (2010-11) had 3.
- Brandon Newman was named the Big Ten's Freshman of the Week for the second time this season, now 1-of-2 freshmen with multiple awards.
- With Purdue entering the AP Top 25 this week, the Boilermakers have been nationally-ranked in six straight seasons, the longest streak in school history. Since the start of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has been ranked in 71-of-109 Associated Press top-25 polls.
- Over the last five years since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue has the most wins in the Big Ten (61). Michigan State is next at 58.
- Purdue owns a 52-9 home record in Big Ten play since the 2014-15 season. Since that year, just one team, Michigan, has beaten the Boilermakers twice at Mackey Arena. Michigan State, Indiana, Wisconsin, Nebraska and Northwestern are the five teams to not win in Mackey.

ABOUT THE BOILERMAKERS

- Beginning its stretch run, Purdue owns a 7-5 league record and a 12-7 overall record. The Boilermakers opened Big Ten play with a 2-3 record, but have won five of their last seven contests to put themselves in position for a double-bye in the Big Ten Tournament.
- Never satisfied with the defense, Coach Painter's squad has held eight straight opponents to 72 or fewer points.
- In Big Ten play, Purdue has made all the right halftime adjustments, outscoring opponents by 45 points, while being outscored by 39 points in the opening 20 minutes.
- Purdue has six players averaging between 7.5 and 15.8 points per game. Eight different players have scored at least 10 points in a game three times this season.

POLL POSITION

- With its No. 24 ranking this week, Purdue has appeared in the Associated Press Top-25 poll for the sixth straight season, the second-longest streak in school history behind eight straight years from 1968 to 1975.
- Since the first poll of the 2015-16 season, Purdue has been ranked in 71-of-109 top-25 polls.

VANQUISHING RANKED FOES

- With the win over Minnesota last Saturday, head coach Matt Painter has now won 53 games over ranked teams while at Purdue. His record is 53-87 (.379) during his career at Purdue against ranked teams, but since the start of the 2016-17 season, Purdue is 23-23 in such games.

- Purdue is eighth nationally with 23 ranked wins over the last five years.

A DEEPER DIVE INTO ANALYTICS

- Purdue has positioned itself nicely to make a run to another high seed in the NCAA Tournament with some nice wins under its belt.
- Purdue's four wins over nationally-ranked teams are tied for the second-most nationally behind Ohio State's five (Purdue, Baylor, Gonzaga, Iowa, Kansas, Maryland, Minnesota, Oklahoma, Virginia Tech).

► Purdue has now been ranked in the AP Poll in six straight seasons.

► That is the longest yearly streak in school history.

► Last time ranked: 2019-20 Preseason poll (#23)

- Purdue's nine Quad-1 and Quad-2 wins rank tied for second nationally behind Alabama (10).
- Purdue's 15 Quad-1 and Quad-2 games played lead the country.
- Purdue's seven top-50 wins against the top 50 on the Sagarin ratings are third nationally (Illinois, Wisconsin - 8). Purdue's 13 games are tied for the most nationally (Illinois - 13).
- Purdue's strength of schedule ranks 5th in the Sagarin ratings, 6th in the NCAA Net rankings, 6th in ESPN BPI rankings and 7th in KenPom.

CARDIAC KIDS

- Purdue has won four games this year when trailing by 11 or more points, tied for the most 11-point comebacks in school history (1982-83 season – 4). Three of the comebacks came against ranked teams.

A LOOK AT THE PERIMETER

- Purdue has found a way to win five of its last seven games, despite struggling from the perimeter.

- Over the last seven games, Purdue is shooting just 39-of-137 (.285) from long distance. That includes an 11-of-17 performance against Indiana and an 8-of-15 showing against Minnesota. In the other five games, Purdue is 20-of-105 (.190) from deep.

- Foes are scoring just 44.3 percent of its points from 2-point field goals against Purdue, ranking 32nd nationally. However, from 3-point range, 37.4 percent of opponents' points are coming from long range, good for 21st nationally.

FRESHMAN CLASS SHINING BRIGHT

• Through 19 games, Purdue's freshman class has accounted for 550 (28.9 PPG) of the team's 1,336 points (41.2 percent). It has accounted for over 50.0 percent of the team's scoring in five of Purdue's 19 games (Liberty, Clemson, Miami, Maryland, Minnesota).

• The duo has recorded a combined double-double in every game but one and has significantly cut down its turnovers since the start of the season. In the first seven games, the pair had 40 turnovers (5.7 per game). In the last 12 games, just 34 turnovers (2.8 per game).

- Record at Purdue: 349-181 (.658) / 16th year | Career Record: 374-186 (.668) / 17th year
- With five Sweet 16 appearances, 11 NCAA Tournament berths, three Big Ten regular-season championships, a Big Ten Tournament title, an Elite Eight and an international gold medal on his résumé, 16th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest young minds in all of college basketball.
- He was voted by his peers as the NABC National Coach of the Year after leading a team that started with a 6-5 record to the 2019 Elite Eight.
- Painter was named the 2019 Big Ten Coach of the Year and has led Purdue to three straight Sweet 16 appearances.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in October of 2018, agreeing to a two-year extension that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2023-24 season. The deal features five, one-year extensions that go into effect through the 2028-29 season. Following the 2029 season, Painter will still only be 58 years old.

- Painter's four Big Ten Coach of the Year honors are the third most in league history (Gene Keady - 7; Bobby Knight - 5; Bo Ryan - 4).
- Painter has averaged 11.1 wins per year in conference play, the fifth-best average in Big Ten Conference history.
- Is one of just four active coaches to have won a Big Ten championship.
- Painter's 11 NCAA Tournaments in the last 14 years are the eighth most in the country.
- Purdue's five Sweet 16 appearances in the last 12 years are the ninth most nationally.
- Coach Painter's 12 NCAA Tournaments are the most for a coach nationally under the age of 55 (as of April 1, 2021 – Painter is 50 years old).
