The Scene Setter

- The Purdue men's basketball team returns to Mackey Arena to continue its early-season gauntlet by hosting No. 17-ranked Louisville in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge on Tuesday. Tip is scheduled for 8 p.m. ET, on ESPN.
- The Boilermakers are coming off a disappointing showing in the Battle 4 Atlantis, but a win over Louisville would go a long way to easing some of that pain.
- **Dave Flemming, Dan Dakich and Jeff Goodman** will have the call for ESPN, while **Larry Clisby, Rob Blackman and Ralph Taylor** will handle the Purdue Radio Network broadcast. The game will be available on the Watch ESPN app as well as nationally on SIRIUS / XM Satellite radio.
- Live stats will be provided on PurdueSports.com and as always, fans can receive Twitter updates from the official account (@BoilerBall).
- The game will be a rematch of last year's challenge, won by Louisville 71-64.

LOOKING BACK

- Purdue salvaged a victory in the Battle 4 Atlantis, blasting No. 2-ranked Arizona 89-64 Friday night. The Boilermakers had fallen to Tennessee (78-75, OT) and Western Kentucky (77-73).
- The 25-point victory was the second-largest win ever against a ranked team, only behind a 27-point victory over No. 2 North Carolina in the 1969 Final Four.
- The 89 points were the most scored against a ranked team during the **Matt Painter** era.
- Purdue averaged 79.0 points and shot 44.8 percent from the field during the three games in Atlantis. Foes averaged 73.0 points and shot 42.3 percent from the field.
- Five players averaged in double-figures for the event, led by **Carsen Edwards'** 17.3 average. **Isaac Haas** averaged 15.7 and **Dakota Mathias** averaged 14.7 points, 5.7 rebounds and 5.3 assists.
- Purdue is now 13-3 in its last four in-season tournaments, dating to the 2014 Maui Invitational.

► Success in the Challenge

- Purdue owns a 9-7 record in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge, the best mark for a Big Ten conference team. Minnesota and Wisconsin are both 9-9 in the event, matching Purdue for the most Big Ten wins in the Challenge.
- Purdue saw its seven-game winning streak in the event end last year to Louisville. It had been the second-longest streak in Challenge history behind Duke's 10-game run (1999-08).

► Razing Arizona

- In the last calendar year, Purdue has played two games against teams from the state of Arizona. In those two games, Purdue has defeated Arizona State (97-64) and No. 2-ranked Arizona (89-64), winning by an average of 29.0 points per game.
- In the two games, Purdue shot 58.5 percent from the field and 26-of-49 (.531) from 3-point range.

► Streak Stopper

- Virtue of Purdue's upset losses to Tennessee and Western Kentucky in the Battle 4 Atlantis, the Boilermakers saw their streak of 41 consecutive weeks being ranked in the AP Top 25 poll snapped. It had been the sixth-longest streak in the country. Arizona also fell out after being ranked in 100 straight weeks.
- Purdue was ranked in three straight preseason polls for just the third time in school history. The others came in 2008-09 (11th), 2009-10 (7th) and 2010-11 (14th) and 1997-98 (9th), 1998-99 (16th) and 1999-00 (23rd).
- The school record for most consecutive weeks ranked is 64 from the 13th poll of the 2007-08 season to the final poll of the 2010-11 campaign.

► Block Party

- Purdue already has 41 blocks through its first seven games, after having just 87 in 35 games last year.
- Purdue has had at least three blocks in every game this year.
- Freshman **Matt Haarms** has 21 blocks in seven games, having at least five in two games. He joins **A.J. Hammons** and **Joe Barry Carroll** as the only Purdue freshmen to have multiple games of five or more blocked shots.

► Purdue's Seniors off to Dominating Start

- Purdue's senior class is averaging 55.1 points per game, accounting for 59.8 percent of Purdue's scoring.

► Centers of Attention

- Purdue's two primary centers, **Isaac Haas** and **Matt Haarms**, have been outstanding so far this season. The duo is averaging a combined 20.7 points, 9.4 rebounds, 4.3 blocks and 1.6 assists in 38.7 minutes per game, while shooting 50-of-81 (.617) from the field.

► Taking Care of the Ball

- Purdue's primary guards of **P.J. Thompson**, **Dakota Mathias**, **Carsen Edwards** and **Ryan Cline** have combined for 84 assists against 31 turnovers for an assist / turnover ratio of 2.71.
- Thompson and Mathias own the top two career assist / turnover marks in school history at 3.39 and 2.81, respectively.

► These Guys Can Shoot

- Dakota Mathias** and **P.J. Thompson** are both 20-of-35 (.571) from 3-point range on the season.
- Since the start of last year, the duo has made 165-of-361 (.457) from beyond the arc.
- Throw in **Carsen Edwards** into this year's number and Purdue's starting backcourt is 57-of-110 (.518) from long distance.

► **Dynamic Senior Duo**

Purdue's senior duo of **Vincent Edwards** and **Isaac Haas** have scored 2,367 points between them, the eighth-most nationally among returning teammates.

► **Automatic Victory**

- With the win over Fairfield, Purdue has now won 89 straight games when scoring 90 or more points, dating to Nov. 24, 1987, against Iowa State (L, 104-96).
- Entering the game with Louisville, it will have been 10,962 days since Purdue lost when scoring 90 points.
- The average price of gas the last time Purdue lost when scoring 90 points was \$0.96 and **Ronald Reagan** was the President. The price of a stamp was 22 cents.

► **Comparing Power Forwards**

- Caleb Swanigan** won Big Ten Player of the Year honors last year after a dominating sophomore season.
- While not quite to the same level, **Vincent Edwards** is having a strong season.

► **Some Numbers to Know**

- Purdue is now 32-4 when **Ryan Cline** has at least two assists in a game.
- P.J. Thompson** has had one or fewer turnovers in 92-of-107 games, including in all seven games this year.
- Dakota Mathias** has had at least two 3-pointers in 53-of-111 career games. He has at least four 3-pointers in 10 of them.
- Purdue is 23-5 when **Carsen Edwards** gets the starting nod and 19-4 when he scores 10 or more points.

► **Big Margins at Home**

- Purdue has won 10 straight home games by an average of 26.9 points per game with all of them coming by double-digits. Its closest games during the streak has been 11 points twice (Wisconsin, Indiana).

► **November Reign**

- Purdue has dominated the opposition at home during the month of November, going 43-2 (.956) under head coach **Matt Painter**. The lone setbacks were on Nov. 9, 2012, to Bucknell (70-65), and Nov. 14, 2017, to defending national champion Villanova (79-76). Ironically, Villanova's head coach **Jay Wright** graduated from Bucknell.
- Going back further, Purdue is 78-8 (.907) all-time at Mackey Arena during the month of November.
- Painter owns a 61-17 (.782) record during the month of November.

► **Boilers Hot at Home**

- Purdue will enter Tuesday's game against Louisville having won 10 straight games at Mackey Arena, the fifth-longest streak during the Painter era.
- With eight non-conference home games on the slate, an undefeated non-conference schedule will give Purdue 15 straight home wins, which would be the fifth-longest home winning streak in Mackey Arena history.

- With a trio of Sweet 16 appearances, nine NCAA Tournament berths, Big Ten regular-season and tournament titles and an international gold medal on his résumé, 13th-year head coach Matt Painter is widely regarded as one of the brightest minds in all of college basketball.
- Painter affirmed his long-term commitment to Purdue in March of 2011, agreeing to a new eight-year contract that will keep him in West Lafayette through at least the 2018-19 season. He then followed that up in August of 2016, signing a three-year extension good through the 2021-22 year.
- Painter has averaged over 22 wins per season during his tenure at the helm of the Purdue program, including at least 25 victories in six seasons.
- Painter's tenure has seen Purdue basketball restore its status among the upper echelon of college basketball programs. The last 10 years have seen six 25-win seasons and eight NCAA Tournament berths, three Sweet 16 appearances, two regular-season Big Ten titles and a Big Ten Tournament crown.
- The three winningest classes in program history are the classes of 2011, 2012 and 2010, respectively, and five of the 10 winningest individual players Purdue has ever seen have come from the Painter ranks. Success, however, didn't happen overnight.
- Painter officially became the 18th head men's basketball coach in Purdue history on April 1, 2005, and immediately set about laying the groundwork for a dramatic reversal in the program's fortunes.
- The Boilermakers were at their best during the 2009 postseason run, rattling off double-digit victories over Penn State and Illinois to reach the Big Ten Tournament final, where they dispatched Ohio State, 65-61, to earn the first conference tournament crown in program history.
- Painter has been named Big Ten Coach of the Year three times, earning the consensus award in 2008 and 2011, and winning the coaches' vote in 2010. He is one of only six men to win the award more at least three times since its inception in 1974.
